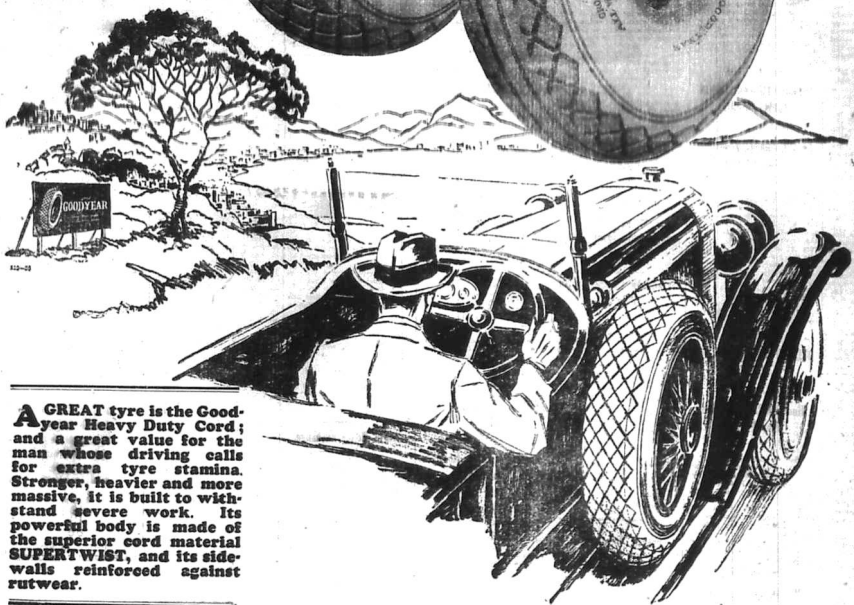
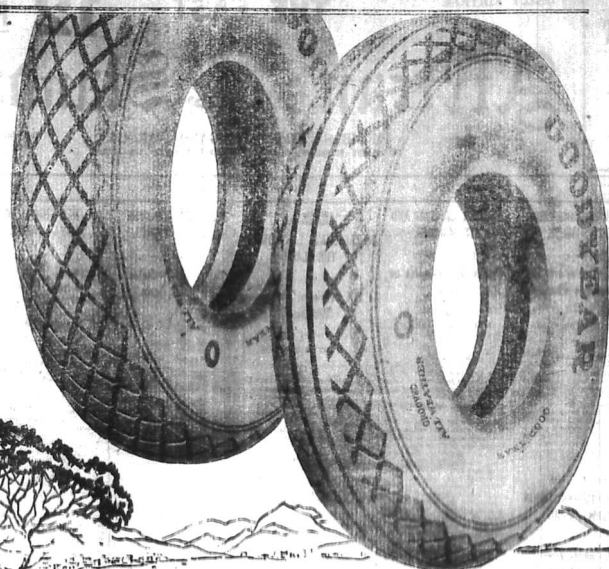

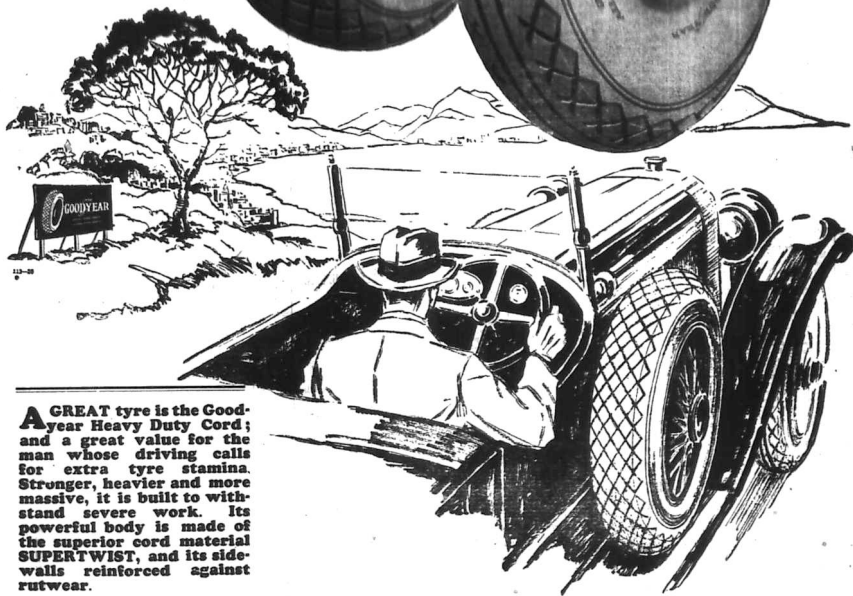

I have two letters asking for information as to how to become a member of the Kennel Club. Write to our Secretary, Capt. Taylor, Box 511, Nairobi, and the puppy literature is Sh. 20.

We have a pure dog enthusiast just come to Kenya in Mr. C. A. Thomson who is about to take up the show at Mide. This gentleman wishes to go in for bull-dog and writes to ask if I think the absolute would be too high for these dogs. I have known a good many bull-dogs in my time, but I have never heard that they suffer from weak hearts, but they do suffer from intense heat. If remember well one very hot summer in England when at the Richmond dog show, which is an outdoor show, that several of the heavy level of bulldog went down with heat, and had to be resuscitated with cold water-always over heat.

But these do not need to be rescued out here in the heat of the day. The early mornings and the evenings are always nice and cool and dogs can play for hours and still until the sun gets too intense when it is quite easy to shut them up in a cool shaded kennel. I think that anyone who imported a good bull-dog and put him in a cool shaded kennel with a dog house will find dog runs in their hunting dogs.

I should like to see a really good bull-dog again they are such delightful companions, and just would be sufficient for a high-class showing matter. Mrs. W. To write me from Turt about quite. Great Dane puppies that she thinks are sufficient for me. No averages is mentioned as I hope she will see my answer to her letter in my weekly "Notes". To start with the size of the puppies is not mentioned and a puppy means anything from 10 to 15 months old. For small puppies up

to 12 weeks old I should advise Blackspan puppy pups. Also that other Addresses given or shown. There is no reason because the mother had pups that she had pups before they were born and her issue had been properly cleaned and well conditioned. The litter before was a real good one. The last littering was done by a dog who was not put from the Proprietor of the Kenya Dog Club. I am responsible and very efficient. 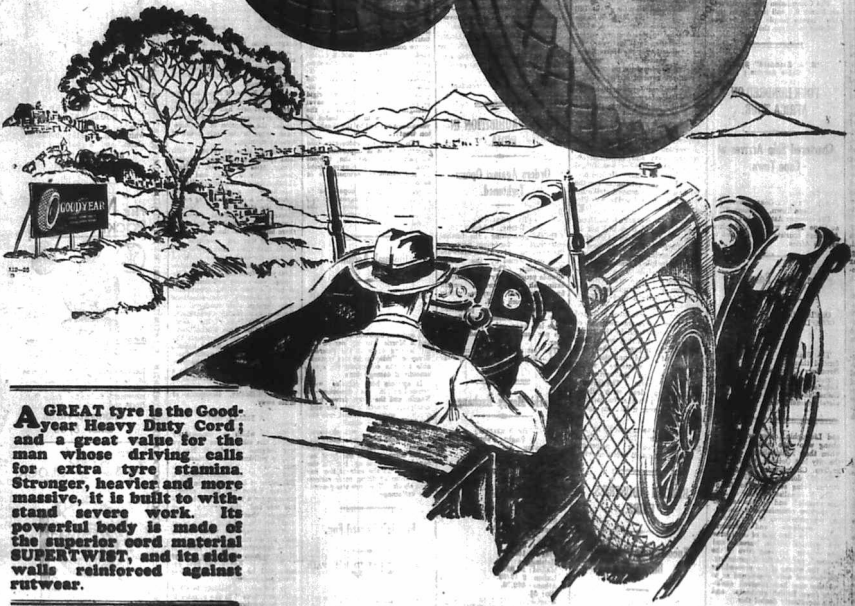
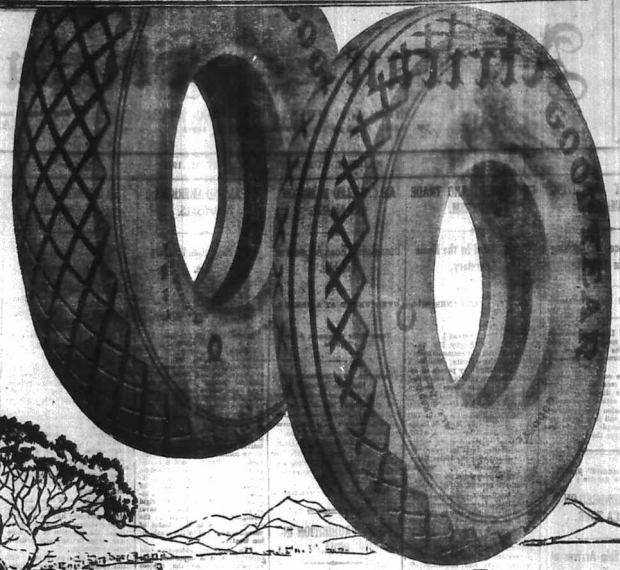
