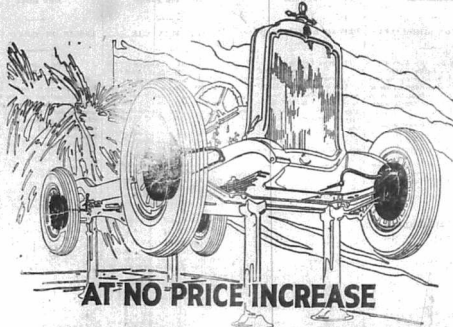

MONSABA TO NAIROBI.

Further Difficult Test on Tuesday Last.

A more difficult test could not be found anywhere, but the truck reached the top of the bank, being stopped once to demonstrate its braking power. Another journey was made up the steep gradient, and this time, at the top of the bank, the truck again arrived on top, and was stopped. It was found that the driver demonstrated his complete mastery of the truck.

It is understood that further demonstrations and tests will be undertaken, which the motor will be given.

LETTER FROM PARIS.

Reduction of Tax for Visitors.

AN INFORMAL METHOD.

(From Our Paris Correspondent.)

English visitors who come to Paris for a holiday longer than that of the regulation week or two, are doubtless rejoicing that visitors (unlike the natives of the Ile de France) and its attendant fee of 175 francs. With the reduction it is possible that far more bold proprietors will follow the example of the important ones who have already to save their guests trouble and annoyance, subjected themselves to the fine which is imposed upon those who do not comply with the law in respect of the identity card.

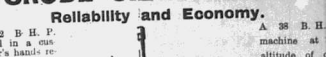

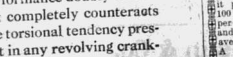
