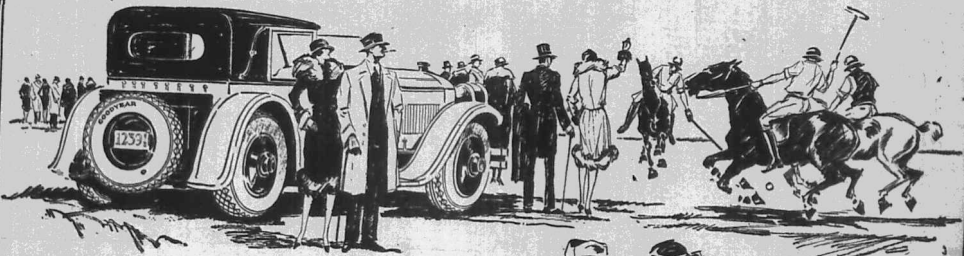

MOTURING TOPICS

MOTURING ON HILLS.

The Use of Gears and Brakes.

SAFEST METHODS.

Represented motorists who live in hilly districts are well aware that caution is necessary when taking a car down a steep incline, and have found that the most for first-class condition. Now, however, no motorist who habitually drives in that country, are apt to make mistakes in haste when first coming a town through a really hilly district. They do not realize the rapidly with which a car can gather speed on a steep slope, or the enormous increase in the stopping distance as compared with that which obtains on the level.

Downward gradients can be taken in a variety of ways. The simplest, and also the most widely used, consists of leaving the clutch and gear lever alone, releasing the accelerator pedal, and then applying whatever pressure may be required to maintain the rotation produced by the car in top gear. This is a course to be improved upon when the downward gradient is really severe—namely, deeper than one in eight—by engaging one of the intermediate gears, so increasing the engine speed and also the retarding effect.

Next there are two ways of coasting "downward" gradients—one of which consists of holding the clutch pedal against the floorboards, while in the other the gear lever is slipped into neutral. For the inexperienced driver the first plan is the safer, as by engaging the clutch the driver can at any time regain the braking of the engine. The practice is not to be recommended, however, because in the long run it results in considerable wear in the clutch with, of course, an increase in the stopping distance.

As regards the practice of taking down hills in neutral, this is really an unsafe proceeding, unless the driver knows the road well and is

DANGERS OF COASTING.

Furthermore, it is usually found that a car is not so steady or controllable when in neutral. It should hardly be necessary to mention that no driver should indulge in coasting in neutral unless he is sufficiently practiced to be able to carry out the operation of re-engaging top gear at an instant's notice without hesitation.

It is also wise to practice engaging the other gear at various speeds, by trying to engage the second gear at an speed up to 30 miles per hour, or obtaining a very useful braking effect in an emergency.

At a time when four-wheel braking systems were rare the driver was always advised to use the hand lever and the pedal alternately on long downward gradients in order to avoid overloading the drums, but caution in this respect is not now so necessary as was then the case. However, it is undoubtedly a good practice to pull the hand-brake on at the end of three or four notches, and then to use the pedal to produce the additional retardation required, thus dividing the work between the two braking systems.

It is exceedingly unlikely that the brakes will fail or even become ineffective, provided they are of certain amount of attention. (Exchange).

Highway Experiment.

RUBBER SURFACE IN LONDON.

A highway experiment is being tried in New Bridge Street, City of London. Rubber as a road surface is to be subjected there to a severe test. Although rubber has been used before, it has never been used in quite the same way as in this experiment. Heavy traffic will be allowed to pass over it in order to test its ability to hold a super-heated rubber cap. 5.8 of an inch in thickness.

This is a pull on to a groove, which, it is claimed, will withstand the pounding and speeding force of the heaviest traffic. The blocks with these rubber caps are laid on a 12 in. concrete bed, with a cushion of sand three-quarters of an inch thick. They are being set in by means of jacks, composed of a special bitumen and rubber mixture.

The British experiment will be the most drastic which could possibly be devised for the traffic to be met in the City, and probably in London. The rubber is a "chained" variety, a variation, and this of great importance both in relation to its properties. It is supposed to prevent skidding, and is expected to be more silent than either wood or asphalt.

Previously all dealers will carry these tyres to stock but in the demand for this new product will be very heavy. It is suggested that customers should order their requirements with their dealer as early as possible.

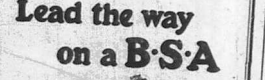

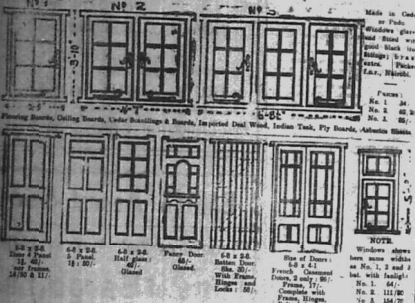

OUTSTANDING DEBTS BY TRADING SYSTEM.

(From THE LAWYER'S CONGRESS.)
London, April 6.
The short sentence remains an outstanding debt in the press system, and a difficulty in the prison management, and the Commission of Prisons and the Director of General Prisons in their report for 1928-29, issued this week.
They point out that the highest administrative and judicial authorities have drawn attention to the importance of the short sentence, and that the presence of men who are out on leave for a few days or so impediment to the development of a sound system of prison training.
With regard to proper alternative, the report states that the most helpful proposal is the development of a system of probation. A point may be made that many offences can be well supervised in the open, that if they had a period of custodial training of substantial length will be of great benefit.

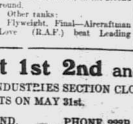

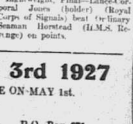
