MINOR CAR TROUBLES.

How to Locate Electrical Faults.

OTHER TECHNICALITIES

Primarily the motor car is considered as a vehicle propelled by petrol, that it is also a vehicle in the operation of which electricity plays a vital part.

If something electrical goes wrong, the first thing to be done is to see, if use is provided. Finding that in good condition, the condition of the battery should be checked. Find out if it is charged, that it has correct terminals in the correct leading from the battery should be tested.

For instance, there is an isolated wire leading to the light switch. The first step to be taken is, after making sure that the battery is all right, is at the next terminal on the switch. If no current is there the wire may be broken or the terminal connection may be poor. In any event, the trouble must be limited to this one small stretch of wire.

TESTING THE LIGHTS

In making the test use a long piece of insulated wire with both ends inserted in the middle of the wire. Disconnect at the switch the light to be tested, and connect this with the test wire. The amount of air fuel will give complete combustion and consequently a clean exhaust.

A lean mixture, containing too much air, is not so dangerous, and popping occurs at the running of the engine.

The so-called "locking" of a carburettor consists of adjusting it to give it the correct explosive mixture at all speeds, and in heavy wet-land fittings this is not a very difficult matter. In fact, a very good motor fuel is necessary to obtain satisfactory carburettor.

CRANKCASE VENTILATION. However, a certain amount must pass the piston and rings, and particularly when the engine is operated at low speeds, some probably more with the oil on the cylinder walls is carried down into the crankcase. The reason for this is that whenever the engine is operated long enough to get warmed up, the temperature of the oil also rises and the weight of the fuel and water in it is repeated and eliminated by the ventilating system.

The crankcase is no place for water, as it interferes with the oil circulating system, particularly in winter, and when present in large quantities on the working parts under certain conditions and causes corrosion. The presence of some unburnt fuel in the oil is undoubtedly satisfactory as it undoubtedly assists materially in giving easy starting to winter, but nevertheless, it is desirable that the amount of sludge be controlled. To get rid of water vapor form, a number of one makes are now providing positive crankcase ventilation, using centrifugal fans to draw the fumes in the intake manifold.

From an economy standpoint the lubrication of chains, detent can hardly be overdone, and liberally here means extra bearings and also wear and noise.

With oils we all want long life, but it is better to endeavor to obtain the very last mile from covers. To do so is to take risks and not doing half the pleasure with the economy of half the cost.

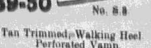

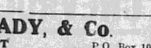

MOTOR TOPICS

THE CLUTCH.

Cause of the Trouble in Changing Gears.

USE AND ABUSE

More than half the trouble that motor cars give in shifting gears is due to improper action of the clutch when the clutch is disengaged.

To get a real idea of what must be taken care of in a clutch, it is first essential to have a working knowledge of the various functions of the clutch. We all know that it is necessary to have a device on the car that will permit the engine to revolve at a speed other than that of the engine.

The driving parts are connected with the engine generally through the withdrawal of the engine. In fact, American cars usually use the clutch as really an integral part of the clutch.

Normally the clutch is engaged. That is, the driving parts are in contact with the drive parts.

DISCONNECTING

The disconnecting device consists of a means for compressing the clutch springs, thus relieving them of the pressure of the driving force of the engine from the clutch pedal.

When the pedal is depressed all the way the pressure of the clutch springs is entirely taken from each other. When the clutch pedal is depressed only a part of the way the pressure of the clutch springs is merely relieved, and when "half releases" the clutch is engaged.

When the pedal is depressed in stages, it causes a rub or jerk which slides over a collar. As the pedal is moved, the first slides the collar over the clutch shaft from the driver from the face of the driving plate.

On some cars it is automatic, it is lubricated from the engine, but on most cars there is a grease cup or an oil connection. When the pedal is depressed the pressure of the clutch springs is against the bearing.

CLUTCH SLIP

With this little picture of the

FUNCTIONS OF THE CLUTCH

Functions of the clutch mechanism are the items for a few instructions to the car user. Two different uses are well known. There are, first, slipping and second, disengaging the clutch.

The trouble may be due to a worn pedal spring. In a car which has 20,000 miles on the pedal spring, the clutch pedal will have the habit of slipping.

A DRAGGING CLUTCH

Dragging is not the proper term for slipping. It means that the frictional contact between the clutch plates is insufficient for the engine to revolve at a speed other than that of the engine.

The worst offense a driver can commit is to ride the clutch, especially from a clutch mechanism standpoint. Riding the clutch is the expression used to denote the habit of keeping the foot on the clutch pedal when it is not necessary.

A maintenance slipping clutch will not only reduce the life of the clutch, but also the life of the engine. It will also reduce the life of the clutch plates and the clutch springs.

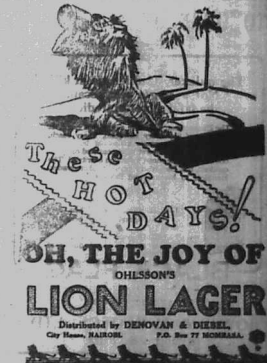

THE LABOUR COMMISSION REPORT.

(Continued from page 25)

Remarks: It is known that Government has been frequently addressed on this subject during the past year, and we are informed by the Commission that it has been referred to the various departments of the Government. It is understood, however, that there are no certain practical difficulties in its application.

Wages.

Remarks: It is agreed that the present machinery should be introduced, but there is a matter to be considered by the Industrial Finance.

COOPERATION.

That the use of a repair-facilities where savings are not sufficient to justify the cost of undertaking to purchase their own, is undertaken by groups of small firms.

Remarks: Only exceptionally has the co-operative use of machinery been found advisable owing to the fact that members co-operating are engaged in the same period, and dissimilarity in the nature of the work. This is a report of a portable power. Transport is advised, but such a solution is not in the nature of a remedy.

GAME AND BIRDS.

That the preservation of birds is Governmental, but birds are not under the control of the Government. It is realized that game and birds do considerable damage and destroy the use of agricultural crops. Facilities have already been given by Government for the destruction of birds, but the only other remedy we consider is that of fencing land. The destruction of birds, which on the game side is the soft step, is admittedly a difficult matter, but when a solution is not in the nature of a remedy.

Mails.

Remarks: This is a very important matter, and we are informed that the Government is considering the possibility of introducing a new system of mail service.
