THE E.A. OFFICE IN LONDON.
First Administrative Report of its Publicity Activities.

HANDICAPS TO SETTLEMENT.
Reliance of Pupils to Pay Premium Suggested by Farmers.

The First Administrative Report of the activities of the E.A. Office in London has been received in Kenya and lengthy extracts are given below.

From the point of view of Kenya it is interesting to note the criticisms of obstacles urged in the way of an early settlement. The Colony has a considerable number of pupils because the London Office had not been notified of openings. Another difficulty is that the Government has not yet decided to pay to the employing farmer a premium. This point out that in other parts of the world pupils get a small salary.

One of the most important handicaps to settlement is the absence of any official assistance in East Africa to send letters and the territories. In the absence of land settlement schemes assisted passages, etc. do not show up well against the other Colonies.

The Report says that detailed principles for the conduct of the office have been laid down by the Kenya Government and other territories are following suit.
