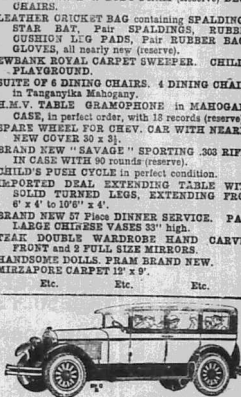

AGRICULTURE

POULTRY NOTES.

Egg Production for Table.

The production of eggs for table use in a branch of poultry farming which should receive the earnest consideration of every breeder of poultry. Poultry farmers in and around Nairobi, or Nairobi have a market for their produce at their very doors. People will go some distance from a centre here to secure fresh to order. Where there is freight to pay on eggs the profit will naturally be less on the actual price received for the eggs but the cost of production and the cost of freight being lower in the country should not matter even.

I find that by charging my regular customers at the rate of 2s. 7d. a dozen for eggs all the year round, and odd customers at the current market price, I can show a reasonable profit on my table.

To make poultry farming pay I find it is best to make a few special eggs at market rate. It is necessary to give a good deal of consideration to the purchase of feedstuffs. I have seen people buying concentrates in the Nairobi market for their birds at absolutely prohibitive prices. The birds are to show a profit. Everyone should plant at all events some green stuff for the birds.

RUFF will grow almost anywhere, and a patch of this will give a continuous supply of green stuff even in the driest weather. Apples and turnips are good substitutes when green feed is scarce.

MAIZE is the grain feed most easily prepared. Good even as "praga" it is not satisfactory as an entire grain feed system. Maize is good for stock with the maize, small have benefit of the deer, as well I have bought of the deer on stock on 1 acre with at 12: a 200 lb. bag.

WHEAT is a very valuable grain feed. The most economical way of having it is to deal direct with the producer and to buy the best quality which will still afford the wheat for stock has been removed.

WATER and GRASS are also very important items in egg production. The birds must have plenty of fresh water, and the water vessels must be placed in such a position that they cannot become heated by the rays of the sun. Great must stress be laid on the birds.

KENYA POULTRY CLUB NOTES.

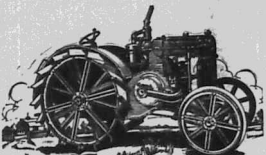

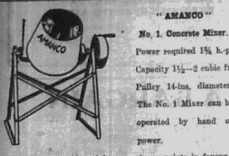
