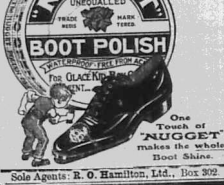

**The Publicity Office.**

The story of the five complete years in the history of the East African Trade and Information Bureau in London is told in the joint report recently issued by the Commissioner, Colonel W. H. Franklin and his Deputy Mr. J. W. Bridge who was assisted from the Department of Overseas Trade by the work of organizing the Office and to relieve Colonel Franklin until a permanent Deputy could be found. It is of value in approaching a study of the Report, which is published privately, 46 copies have been prepared for the benefit of the public. The Publicity Office was originally formed by the United Nations who suggested upon government the necessity for establishing in the East of the Empire some office which was in a position to supply accurate and up to date information to visiting writers. **VETERINARY WORK IN 1926.**  
The Unceasing War Against Cattle Diseases.  
EAST COAST FEVER.  
Conditions Demonstrate Need for Further Research.

The annual report of the Agricultural Department for 1926 deals with the work of the Veterinary Department and contains statistics having reference to the incidence of disease and measures taken to combat it. The total expenditure for the year was £23,027, an increase of £2,700 over 1925. The revenue was £20,000, an increase of £1,119 over the previous year. The 25th Annual Report of the Hon. the Chief Veterinary Officer of the Government includes laboratory products manufactured by the Research Institute and used by the field staff in the work of disease-control.

The maintenance of the rate of prevalence against disease as reported in a previous issue has been a condition of the establishment of the Government Veterinary Service. As shown in the report for the 1926 season, the rate of prevalence of East Coast Fever in the Colony, like the rest of East Africa, is peculiarly situated in respect of the major diseases causing economic loss and the natural immunities to widespread epidemics the widespread pneumo-pneumonia and East Coast Fever made information like the foregoing of more importance in annual reports than detailed reports of individual outbreaks.

**MINERPERIT.**  
There were 4,187 deaths from Minerperit during the year. The mortality of cattle was with (79,836) was a satisfactory indication of the permanency of the work of inoculation. The conditions under which the work is carried on compare unfavourably with other countries. As these improve it is hoped that the mortality figures will be reduced.

**PNEUMO-PNEUMONIA.**  
The year under review was particularly free from incident in connection with pneumo-pneumonia. However, however, continued to soil themselves of the vaccine which is issued gratis to Government, but it is to be regretted that the number of doses sold for shows a big reduction as compared with the number used by stock owners in 1925, approximately 20,000 doses less having been applied for during the year.

**EAST COAST FEVER.**  
The report of the Chief Veterinary Officer contains tabulated and

reliable statement of the position of the disease with regard to East Coast Fever and it should clearly be understood that the work of the Department. The subject is one that calls for active consideration and further research, to which attention is being given.

As compared with the Union of South Africa and Southern Rhodesia where attempts have, for many years been made to eradicate the disease, the conditions obtaining in the Colony under the aegis of the Government and the Veterinary Department to control the disease in the alienated areas and the spread of the disease into areas heretofore regarded as "clean" were satisfactory.

Here as Kenya the recorder indicates of the disease over extensive areas both in the native reserves and in "settled" areas, the Government has been successful in securing and the people of dipping tanks, together with the systematic movement of native-owned stock into the Veterinary Department in the native reserves, intensive use of various devices, and all measures to inhibit the progress of the cattle industry.

**IN THE RESERVES.**

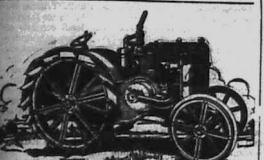

A Njenga returned to be treated, I sent him to the Nakuru Native Hospital. A week later he returned here with a note to say that he (Njenga) would like to stay in hospital for further treatment.

He has now completely had the sight of one eye and can hardly see with the other.

I wrote to the Senior Commissioner, Nakuru, and told him what had happened. I received in reply the attached letter from the District Surgeon.

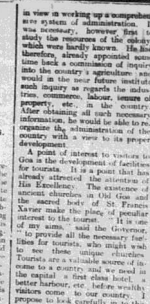

## THE UGANDA MISSION.

### History of its Great Work.

#### THE FOURTH DECADE.

The following is a further sketch of the history of the Uganda Mission, which celebrates its jubilee this year, the period dealt with being from July 1, 1907 to June 30, 1937.

Throughout the earlier pages of the dramatic story of the Uganda Mission, attention is concentrated in the Kingdom of Buganda, and interest centres in the formation of an isolated Mission, struggling for existence. As the story proceeds the horizon steadily widens. The Kingdom is merged in the Protectorate, and the Protectorate swept into the vortex of great world movements. The Mission expands into the Nyanza Church, and the Church itself takes its place in the larger Christian world.

If the story of the fourth decade is less exciting and less dramatic than that which has gone before, it is certainly no less important. All the Church and State the period was marked by steady development. Gradually the frontiers of civilization were pushed further and further afield, until the entire Protectorate, with the exception of the nomad tribes on the Arabian border, was brought under effective administration.

With no less energy the Uganda Church extended its borders. Missions were opened in the first Protectorate, and the first Kenyan converts were baptized in 1910. Great work was accomplished in the Protectorate, and in 1912, and in 1913 work in Kabaka, in what had hitherto been German

territory, was taken over from the German Lutheran Mission. By the end of this fourth decade Christianity had extended from the one corner, to a radius of 300 miles in every direction.

Even more momentous than this extension was the work of unification. The first Union of Churches was held from the first vanguard a Native Christian Conference succeeded, in 1900, in passing the Constitution of that Church. The Constitution was revised in the face of a very considerable opposition, many of the missionaries themselves feeling that the step was premature. It named the transfer of responsibility and authority from the European Mission to the Native Church; and many were frankly apprehensive of the result. Experience has, however, since then justified the venture. The handling of actual responsibility has brought out the latent powers of leadership which have made the Uganda Church a reality that they are, and the consequences that the Church in their own right, for the support of which they themselves are responsible, has created an interest and an enthusiasm which no foreign institution could have hoped.

#### COMING OF COTTON.

The beginning of commercial development of Uganda must be traced to this period. Cotton had been introduced by Mr. Burup, in 1899, but the first serious cultivation of the crop dates from 1908. The holding of two great East Africa, the British Empire opened in 1912, and the construction of the Uganda Railway, opened in 1915, which has made the transport of moderate loads in every part of the Protectorate, associated with the development of the country. The question of Native Education began during this period to assume larger proportions. In 1913 was held, with conspicuous success the first "Schools' Guild" Exhibition, and the competition

between the schools of the different countries did much to attract the work of education in every part of the Protectorate. The first Conference on Native Education, held at Budo in 1915, discussed many problems, the far reaching importance of which could only now being realized. Thereafter, but numbers more than in the Mission field, went to the work of education was left to the Government and the Native Education Council, representative of Government and the Native Education field, that what was done in the Church there might at any moment concern and involve the whole Church.

In 1915 there took place at Kampala, the Conference which was destined to drive the attention of the whole Church to the serious problem of Missionary personnel. The number of missionaries more than in the Mission field, went to the work of education was left to the Government and the Native Education Council, representative of Government and the Native Education field, that what was done in the Church there might at any moment concern and involve the whole Church.

A reader reminded of the same fact was affected when, in August 1914, War broke out in Europe and with the rapidity of a forest fire, spread to every part of the Empire. Uganda and the Church in Uganda played their part nobly in the great tragedy. The Church in Uganda, through Anglican and Roman alike, made a noble contribution to the war in East Africa, raising from among its members a number of Native Medical Corps and a Motor Transport Corps which rendered valuable service. Uganda for the first time in its history took its place as a unit of the multiracial empire of Africa, and the

mission of education was for ever fixed.

#### MEDICAL WORK.

The period witnessed a steady extension of the Medical work of the Mission. It was stated in the strictest measures of hospitals and staff, at one time as many as 400 in patients were being treated in the hospital alone. The Roseville block, near Point Mwanja, built in 1909 the "Anna Walker" block, in the same year, and in 1912, and the Indian Ward opened in 1913, the permanent mark of the Medical development during this decade.

The loss of the Cathedral, by fire, in 1910 was a very serious blow to the Church, the last serious event of the period under review, were concerned in the work of rebuilding, which was not completed until 1915. The High School (Chapel), and the Memorial Church of Nyanza, date from this period. Some of the best known and most trusted leaders of the Mission passed from the scene. Bishop Tucker, who had done so much to build up the Church in Uganda, retired in 1911, and died suddenly, in the presence of Westminster Abbey, three years later. The Church in Uganda lost two of its true friends in the retirement of Archbishop Walker in 1912, and the sudden death of Ernest Miles in 1917, while the death, in 1919, of Henry Wood, the second one of the earliest converts and greatest leaders of the Native Church in Uganda.

The leaders pass. Each in his own generation served the cause of God, and thus falls on sleep, but his spirit remains. The leaves fall from the tree, but still the new trees and grass, and every year its branches spread further, and its roots strike deeper, and even the fallen leaves bear witness to the soil on which they fall. So, be it seen, so will be with the Church in Uganda.
