The Famine-Fighting Fleet

ANOTHER "Message to Garcia"—the log of the International fleet that trekked across the Mesopotamia wastes at the call of the Persian Government!

When famine threatened Teheran, the capital, last winter, the Persian administration ordered its first ten heavy-duty trucks from the International Harvester organization. Harvester world service placed the fleet at the nearest port on the Mediterranean Sea, Beirut in Syria, ahead of other trucks ordered from Europe.

Then began the test of truck quality, a trip of 1350 miles across trackless desert and over snow-bound mountains. On February 2 the cavalcade set out. The trucks, chauffeured by English, French, Italian, Syrian, Arabian and Druse, were laden with food and fuel and with tons of cement for the British at Bagdad, and they were accompanied by an escort of armored cars of the British Air Force.

Twenty-six days were consumed between Beirut and Bagdad, every truck axle-deep in mud and sand practically every mile of the way. Bagdad, ancient city of romance, gave the travellers a dinner in their honour and a night of rest, and transferred them from desert to mountain going. Motor fuel for the Persian government, and wheat, took the place of cement for cargo. The cavalcade foraged on both night and day, and entered Teheran the seventh day after Bagdad.

The entire fleet was in the pink of condition and every truck of the ten, on the morning of arrival, went out to Kavin, a hundred miles away, and began bringing back great loads of the precious wheat.

The Persian government, impressed by the stamina of International Trucks, immediately ordered twenty more of them, and these have since duplicated the travel history of the first fleet.

Topics Discussed by Chamber of Commerce.

HIGH COURT.

Kampala Building Estimated to Cost £25,000.

From Our Correspondent.

Kampala, June 14.

The rains were considered to be satisfactory and during the last week the plants, which have been well established in the East-ern Province. On the Uganda side, there is a great deal of ground being planted at all times. Food crops are enjoying the attention of the natives at the moment and should the rest of the month we should have a very good season.

The Uganda Chamber of Commerce had another long agenda to read last night. The agenda was well attended and it is interesting to note the increased interest that members are taking in the welfare of the public concerning the increasing volume of business done by the Chamber. We mention some of the important matters discussed—

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT.

The report of the sub-committee appointed to investigate the draft Kampala Bill was discussed. The Chamber agreed that in its present form it would appear to be rather long and if it could be presented in a shorter and more concise form it would be better. As a number of legal points arose the meeting called for the report to the next legal meeting for consideration and advice. It was agreed that a copy of the Bill of the nature was highly desirable.

REGULATIONS.

A letter from the Division Superintendent of the Railway was read stating that it was hoped that the opening of the railway to the north of Kampala at an early date. This will be a great advantage to the Kinyua planters, miners and other exporters, as well as to the rest of the Lake region, who can look to the goods direct to the coast and save all the bother of taking them across the lake, unloading them and then looking at them. A letter from a member was read complaining that it took a fortnight to receive a reply to a letter sent to Kampala. This is not a matter to be discussed in this column. It is a matter for the Chamber to consider.

KAMPALA—PORT BELL ROAD.

The Chairman called attention to this road which had caused many many accidents. Representatives had been made to Government on this matter before but nothing had been done. Last week a road accident occurred causing the death of an Indian woman and child. There would be very little expense incurred by the P.W.D. in straightening out these very dangerous curves. It is at present almost impossible to see more than a few yards in front owing to the high banks with slanting grass on the top and with the drainage ditches. We have in Uganda at present it is unsafe to drive a car, even if one uses a guide as he is in the correct side of the road. As a result of the discussion on this matter the Government are to be asked to take the matter in hand at once and make this short length of road safer for the ever-increasing traffic.

GREAT BRITAIN AND HER COLONIES.

Responsibilities of the Home Government. SCIENCE AND THE NATIVE.

The Colonial Office Conference is a very interesting reminder of the peculiar character of the British system of rule (says the Liverpool Post and Mercury). Up till a few years before the outbreak of the late war, dominions, colonies, and protectorates formed between them with the Empire beyond seas, with the country as centre and should. But with the emergence of the United States at Versailles into the full rank of Sovereign and Great States, the British Commonwealth came to the fore, and the late Imperial Conference set forth, in a momentous document, the principles on which that Commonwealth rests. The Commonwealth consists of the various British peoples and India; the "British Empire" is now limited to Crown colonies and protectorates and the mandated territories. Thus, in a sense, the Colonial Conference may be described as the only proper holder of the term Imperial. But of course, it is hardly conceivable that any change in the titles of the two agencies can arise as long as the London Government retains undivided responsibility for their management of the Colonies. Only in the emergency remote event of the Dominions voting to leave our fold might the Colonies be regarded as distinct elements of the Commonwealth at large, instead of mere parts of it. In view of the material assistance rendered by the United Kingdom.

TRUSTEESHIP. For the people in those islands the vital thing to bear in mind is

that they are satisfactorily through. Enforcement, for the just administration of the Colonies, especially in cases such as Kenya or Somaliland where we are in contact with an immense native population. It must be at their peril if our people ever let themselves forget that their position relative to the native is a trusteeship. The present conference is wholly a business affair, and, therefore, will not discuss questions of policy. But possibly, as our doubt it will, over the three years hence, circumstances may render attention to policy urgent. In Africa the real problem might not only be hereditary but of age moment, for reasons, that should be pointed to specially, who is an intelligent, well-trained, and energetic man in the Union and in Kenya.

Ann opening the Conference Mr. Amey stressed the importance of co-operation between the various departments of their scientific, research, and in encouraging scientific investigations of their scientific conditions. That it was crucial. Without the help of science the white man cannot expect to have progress in the Empire, where as Africans, with that opportunity, should be made free to express their views on the physical and material conditions, and have him liberally free to direct native effort.

But it should not be overlooked that even at the best, the Empire can never become a white man's home. Providence, it might almost be said, has decreed that if Africa is ever to be industrialized it must be chiefly by the free agency of its own sons and daughters. They, in all of course, have to be trained and directed by white experts, but, in the end, they must be our true staff and stay in the production of economic wealth. And to educate the natives to work of scientific lines is not to exploit the labor. It is not a confession of weakness that is to be made by any kind of man who is not to satisfy his own aim, that is, the good of a willing and friendly

population, sympathetically open to receive instruction in scientific techniques suited to its capacity, and to do so in a manner which will give us a large national administrative, high and long lived well known as a model, and the fact that they are well known to those should be a moral guarantee to the public that our traditional policy of trusteeship will continue to be carefully reviewed in the colonies and endorsed by the Colonial Office.

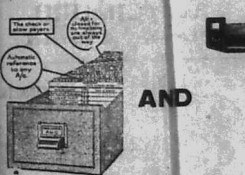

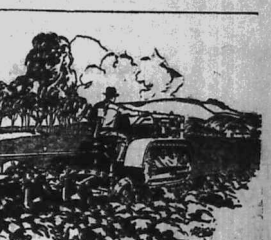

POULTRY NOTES.

Dipping Frogs.

These last few days have been very bright and warm. It is now known whether the bright sun is a good omen. The good news is that the ducks are now free to keep the broods clear of most pests.

The wise poultryman will take advantage of the warm sun and get his ducks out of the house today and have dipped the best part of two hundred, all size and sex.

It is a feeling very common with myself, as with every other, that I should have done this all at once, but as I have now got them clear of duck-ness I would, to disquiet the whole lot at once. Poultry farmers who are exhibiting at the coming show should dip their birds now if they are going to. Dipping does not improve the look of a bird and the sooner it is done the better so it will give plenty of time to get the plumage in good condition again, ready for the Show Pen.

REEDS OF DUCKS

Last week I gave some notes on duck farming, and I have had a letter from a correspondent asking for a few notes on the different breeds. There are a good many breeds and varieties of ducks but in this article I will only deal with the breeds I know are in the country. The various utility breeds of ducks can be roughly divided into two classes, namely, flesh producers and egg producers.

ANESHURE: This breed is undoubtedly the most famous. They should be some white in color if there is any creamation. It is probably due to the introduction of black blood. The back should be of a deep pink and yellow. The legs should be well set out on the body in almost deep yellow and the feet well webbed. The body should be rather long, broad across the shoulders and the neck moderately long and slender. The colour of the bill is most important and the least yellow tinge will show that it is foreign blood amongst the breeders of Aylesbury in this country.

DIPPING MIXTURE

Use Cooper's Milk Fat and add it very carefully. I mix it according to the directions given. Any good disinfectant will do, but it is preferable to use the instructions given by the makers as to the best and probably kill some of them.

The best time to do this dipping is in the morning. Keep the birds

about as they will then be more likely to handle and they will not be so dirty. Put out the covering soft bed ready, and then get a good food to cover them so that they have been dipped.

Because of all sorts are such a serious nuisance in commercial poultry farming it is necessary to safeguard the birds from electrical as much as possible, and dipping is one of the best ways. Birds which are kept penned should be dipped every few months, housed, poultry, and fed properly should keep long from any serious epidemic. To feed properly it is not sufficient to give good food, the birds must have plenty of green food, grit and loose culture.

The breast is rich deep steel with a fringe of leaves passing into delicate grey. The wings are greyish brown with a purple and white distinct face above. Legs a rich orange. The duck is a very downy parent in comparison with the brownish colour pencilled with black and has the same coloured bars across the wings. The value of the breed is great for table purposes but not ready as early as the Aylesbury.

I do not know any breeder of these, but these ducks must have been a good many in the country as the cross-bred ducks mostly about those Boman characteristics.

The Famine-Fighting Fleet

ANOTHER "Message to Garcia"—the log of the International fleet that trekked across the Mesopotamia wastes at the call of the Persian Government!

The entire fleet was in the pink of condition and every truck of the ten, on the morning of arrival, went out to Kasvin, a hundred miles away, and began bringing back great loads of the precious wheat.

THE HEART BEATS OF PLANTS.

An Indian Scientist's Discoveries.

NATURE'S MARVELS.

Sir Jagdish Chandra Bose the Indian scientist, who is a Master of Arts, a Doctor of Science, a Fellow of Literature, and a Fellow of the Royal Society, says in a recent paper published in the *Journal of the Royal Society*, that he has discovered that plants have hearts, although different from animal hearts, that they have nerves, that they sleep and wake, that they become tired and recover that they have memory, that some, at any rate, show signs that they may be expressing joy in life, that they may be angry, that they are a small alcoholic drink and made drunk by excess that they give up the ghost at death with a scream as real as that of a human being—marked spasms when young and vigorous, but all too imperceptible in old age.

They are explained in language that every one can understand, and Sir Jagdish, despite the vagaries of the thought processes which he has to make, a childlike humility, modesty and delight at the secrets he has drawn from what some people would call "still life."

It is a heart-ripping cry out when in a burst or stagger about when it is intoxicated or awed when it dies. Sir Jagdish has discovered how to enable it to write its experiences even in the moment of death.

DRINK.

The book is full of photographs showing the various kinds of apparatus Sir Jagdish invented in order to enable the plants to tell their story. By writing Sir Jagdish in the Calcutta laboratory, gave an alcoholic drink to a plant which up to that point, by means of delicate and extremely sensitive apparatus, had been writing up and down strokes with a marker on a smoked disk, in response to an electric current. Speed Boat.

ACROSS THE ATLANTIC IN 20 HOURS.

Signor Bugatti, the Italian motor-car manufacturer, whose works are in France, announces that his super speed boat, which is expected to be capable of crossing the Atlantic Ocean from New York to 20 hours, will be completed before the end of the year.

The boat will be of a semi-submersible type, 27 yards in length, and has two hulls, and it is thought will be something similar to a submarine. Like a submarine, it will be hermetically sealed.

The boat will be driven by four oil-fueled engines, each driving its own propeller, totalling 2,000 H.P. It is estimated that a speed of 50 knots will be attained, making it possible to reach the United States in 20 hours. It will be possible, however, to travel at a slower speed, it is stated, to carry eight passengers when fuel for a 60 hours' trip is stored on board, or 20 passengers when fuel for a 10 hours' voyage is carried.

Signor Bugatti claims that the boat will provide essentially the cheapest and most rapid means of travel. The oil consumption will be comparatively small and only a small crew will be required.

Banana Glue.

A SUCCESSOR TO THE CHARLESTON.

Paris experts declare that the Charleston is already "worn out," and that the "Black Bottom" glue had its day in the sun. All eyes are fast and shortly to be turned to the "Banana Glue," which is likely to be a great draw when its merits are explained and illustrated at the exhibition of Danes Teachers.

The new glue resembles the Charleston almost in its appearance, and is described as "making the movements of a couple slipping on a banana skin." To a fastidious or Charleston the canvas glue is preferred, and this glue is not so "black" as the old one, and is not so "sticky" as the other glue used six or eight times by a fastidious or the left or right.

NOTES ON APPLE PLANTING.

Possibilities in the Highlands.

Up to the present time but little interest has been taken in the growing of apples in Kenya. With the exception of the few established orchards in the country it is comparatively new to see apple trees about any of the Highlands. For this reason the following notes on planting by Mr. H. R. Terry, Cert. (London and South Africa), Lecturer in Horticulture, School of Agriculture, Pultenheaston which appeared in the *E. A. Standard* and *Standard* should be of interest to many farmers in this Colony.

Success in planting depends, firstly, on preparing the ground, and then carrying out the planting carefully in the soil and providing moisture regularly, and rain falls.

The first thing to do is to prepare patches for the trees before anything else. Wherever any trees are to be planted, deep, broad holes should be dug, the size of which should be large enough to accommodate all roots of whatever trees are being planted, without crowding them, but they may be larger than is actually required to be on the same side. It is also well to make the holes rather deeper than you think may be necessary, and a depth will not be excessive.

After the holes are dug out, a bucket of water can be poured into each to provide moisture at depth. The holes can then be packed with soil and more water added, this will maintain the soil well to some extent until spring is over with the roots, and be far more effective than applying it after planting on the surface only.

When trees are received from a nursery, they should be examined immediately on arrival, and if the roots are dry they can be soaked in a bucket of water for an hour or two, or a few minutes, before being planted with moist soil. Trees which have become badly dried out and shrivelled on the journey may usually be revived by burying them in a damp soil and allowing them to remain there for several days, leaving the soil constantly moist while they remain there.

When taking out trees to plant them in the various patches, it is best to bring them with their roots in a wet sack and do not leave them ex-

posed to the sun for even a short length of time. When the trees are being planted on mounds about 18 inches high, a little loose soil can very well be mixed with it, and the trees can have any bare or dried roots, such as are produced by turning in stubble or house manure, mixed with the soil, for newly planted trees. Mix up the soil of the bottom of the hole, when any tree is to be planted, and bring it to the surface of the hole, when any tree is to be planted in position in the soil, so that the roots will be covered with soil, and the depth to which they will be covered will be increased, so that from when they were removed from the nursery, they were previously grown in the soil.

It is important to see to it that the roots are covered with soil to the depth of the hole at the ground level. As the tree is held in position above the soil and among the roots and gently move the tree up and down a little so that the soil will become thoroughly mixed in with the roots. When the roots have been just covered, tread the soil, and after adding a little water if needed it is done. Firm planting must always be done, and of the soil around that is used for mixing ground, the roots will not be injured from their new circumstances and be able to do a certain amount of business to prevent any drying back. Fill up the holes to within an inch or two of the surface, and if necessary, give a bucketful of water to each tree, afterwards covering over the depression with fine, dry soil. A bucketful of water can be given them every seven or ten days, and each of these waterings should be followed with the use of loam to prevent drying out, and the soil should be kept moist, or even green, can be spread around the trees with the same object. After planting is complete, a plan made of the orchard showing where each tree stands, and its name clearly traced, should be made and kept in a safe place.

THE TYPE OF TREE TO PLANT.

Each year we are asked the question, "Is it advisable to grow these extra large trees in the form of standard trees?" The first answer would be the accepted one of the nursery, "No." It is not advisable to plant trees of the standard type for a number of years, and the common sense of opinion holds good even experience is that it is only possible to plant the best. Young growth can be checked by lifting a well-grown tree which has not received any great check by lifting from the nursery now. A tree of this kind that has attained a height of 6 to 8 feet in the nursery type to purchase, and when planted in the ground will invariably give satisfaction.

CARE OF TREES BEFORE PLANTING.

Generally speaking people do not realize the long distance trees have to be transported, consequently they do not grow the fact that sufficient time has elapsed for a good deal of drying out of the moisture on the trees and packing. When the trees are received it is advisable to place the trees in a dam, or tub of water for 12 hours before the plants to absorb some moisture to replace that lost during transit. If the time is not opportune for planting, immerse the trees in water. In the roots covered with soil under conditions is often the case, planting the trees to dry dry stems. It is important to see to it that the roots are covered with soil to the depth of the hole at the ground level. As the tree is held in position above the soil and among the roots and gently move the tree up and down a little so that the soil will become thoroughly mixed in with the roots. When the roots have been just covered, tread the soil, and after adding a little water if needed it is done. Firm planting must always be done, and of the soil around that is used for mixing ground, the roots will not be injured from their new circumstances and be able to do a certain amount of business to prevent any drying back. Fill up the holes to within an inch or two of the surface, and if necessary, give a bucketful of water to each tree, afterwards covering over the depression with fine, dry soil. A bucketful of water can be given them every seven or ten days, and each of these waterings should be followed with the use of loam to prevent drying out, and the soil should be kept moist, or even green, can be spread around the trees with the same object. After planting is complete, a plan made of the orchard showing where each tree stands, and its name clearly traced, should be made and kept in a safe place.

HAVING WORK AFTER PLANTING.

Cutting back to the height of a tree is recommended or lower as 12 inches, as this enables the grower to build up the trees on the "low-level" system, develop short, sturdy stems, and capable of carrying heavier crops of fruit without breaking down. It prevents the tree from becoming top-heavy, and the shortening back will check the growth before the shoot-buds begin to push out, and will give uniformity throughout the orchard. Sometimes the tree is too long in the nursery to give stability, do not back take to cut in back, trees usually young trees that have grown five to six feet of wood in the nursery now.

of native education requires careful
consideration and it is not
order to evolve a system which
will enable natives to be useful
citizens.

HEALTH

Your committee draws attention to
the high incidence of mortality
among the indigenous natives and
the prevalence of venereal disease
and syphilis, whose detrimental
effects, with a view to their
eradicating, should be the chief
object on the future, and the
first requirement is the provision
of medical officers in the native
reserves or, alternatively, industrial
prisons might be made of
medical missionaries.

It would be desirable that
also be established where most
needed, in the reserves and
in the large centres of population,
and especially for the treatment
of venereal disease.

The important question of
sanitation and water supply should be
left in the hands of the Native
Commissioners.

KAFIR FARMING.

The committee is unable only
to refer to the recommendations
of the Land Commission, but
it considers that all native squatters,
other than those under definite
labour contracts with European
employers, should at the
earliest possible date be transferred
to the native reserves, to which
they may be allocated to reside
there until such time as they wish
to seek work under European
employers.

Farmers should, however, see
encouraged in every way indigenous
natives to make their homes and
establish their families on their
farms. It is policy to carry out
and conditions are made attractive
to their men and daughters to
assist in the process. It is
to train the girls for domestic ser-
vice, to give them the best
young boys for the less ex-
cessive work of the farm. The present
practice, where in practice, of dis-
couraging natives from bringing
their women folk to their place
work is open to serious objection

INCREASE OF HUT TAX.

Your committee is not in accord
with the resolution passed by the
Government in 1923, and considers that
the hut tax on indigenous natives
should not be increased except for
revenue purposes.

SERVICE RECORDS.

The practice which has been
adopted by natives employed in
non-military occupations of carrying
books containing testimonials from
employers, and which has been
discouraged and, with advantage,
has been gradually abandoned
in all forms of employment, is
not desirable. It should be possible
to obtain service records from
the Native Department or ap-
provision by natives who desire to
obtain them.

FAMINE RELIEF.

The critical recurrence in
Southern Rhodesia as elsewhere,
of years of scarcity in alternation with
years of plenty may be regarded as
a fact of experience not yet estab-
lished in the minds of the Government
in the adoption of remedial mea-
sures. It is, therefore, suggested
that the Native Commissioners be
empowered to store quantities of
grain in the year of plenty for use
in the lean years. This procedure
would tend to encourage thrift
among the natives, and would
have the further advantage of re-
ducing the expenditure which the
Government would have to incur
in the year of scarcity for the
purpose of providing food for
natives suffering from food scarcity.
The cost of such storage might be
met from the reserve develop-
ment fund.

APPRENTICESHIP.

Your committee considers that
every employer should be made to
encourage natives to apprentice
their men and daughters to
native employers.

There is ample evidence that
large numbers of the native youths
of today are growing up in idleness
and under an ineffective control.

Under initial conditions the parents
expect some measure of support
from their children, and complaint
is numerous from the older men
that, owing to the weakening of
parental authority, the obligation
of their parents is frequently
evaded.

In an acceptable scheme of
apprenticeship safeguards should be
provided for the treatment of
the apprentices by their employers,



BREAK BRITH AT A MUNICIPAL ABATTOIR.



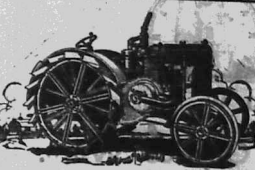
