The Famine-Fighting Fleet

ANOTHER "Message to Garcia"—the log of the International fleet that trekked across the Mesopotamia wastes at the call of the Persian Government!

When famine threatened Teheran, the capital, last winter, the Persian administration ordered its first ten heavy-duty trucks from the International Harvester organization. Harvester world service placed the fleet at the nearest port on the Mediterranean Sea, Beirut in Syria, ahead of other trucks ordered from Europe.

Then began the test of truck quality, a trip of 1350 miles across trackless desert and over snow-bound mountains. On February 2 the cavalcade set out. The trucks, chauffeured by English, French, Italian, Syrian, Arabian and Druse, were laden with food and fuel and with tons of cement for the British at Bagdad, and they were accompanied by an escort of armored cars of the British Air Forces.

Twenty-six days were consumed between Beirut and Bagdad, every truck axle-deep in mud and sand practically every mile of the way. Bagdad, ancient city of romance, gave the travellers a dinner in their honour and a night of rest, and transferred them from desert to mountain going. Motor fuel for the Persian government, and wheat, took the place of cement for cargo. The cavalcade forged on both night and day, and entered Teheran the seventh day after Bagdad.

The entire fleet was in the pink of condition and every truck of the ten, on the morning of arrival, went out to Kasvin, a hundred miles away, and began bringing back great loads of the precious wheat.

The Persian government, impressed by the stamina of International Trucks, immediately ordered twenty more of them, and these have since duplicated the travel history of the first fleet.

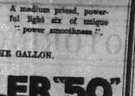

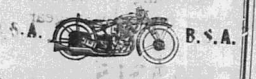

to-day in buildings quite suitable for the purpose, and indeed dangerous to health, will they that the need for a properly equipped Indian High School is a pressing job. Nevertheless, the urgency of adequate hospital provision for the Indian people is generally great and the Government can no longer evade the discharge of both responsibilities to the large and growing Indian population who demand for hospital and school accommodation facilities.

There is set out in some detail this morning in another column a history of the Combined Hospitals Scheme in so far as it relates to the work for a suitable site. But it is also clear from a study of the history of the movement that the factors which influenced the majority, and has indeed complicated the whole position, was not consideration of what is the best site for a central hospital but the fact that the Ngara Road area, extending to 500 acres, has been promised for some years in the Indian community by a Senator. The school of the Colonial has included the sum of £50,000 for that school and no one who is acquainted with the unsatisfactory conditions under which Indian children are educated

WOMEN LIVE LONGER THAN MEN.

Interesting Facts Revealed by a Census.

CENTENARIANS

The number of people who live to be centenarians is surprisingly large in the British House of Commons, the other day Sir John Gannon, Secretary for Socialism, in reply to a question, stated that the number of deaths of persons whose ages exceeded 100 years registered in Scotland, were—1921, 3 men, 2 women; 1922, 1 man, 14 women; 1923, 1 man, 16 women; 1924, 1 man, 17 women; 1925, 1 man, 11 women.

As these figures represent deaths, it is safe to assume that there were many other centenarians alive.

The South African census of 1923 showed seven Europeans who were at least 100 years old, and of these four were men. It would be useless to assume that because more women than men died at ages over 100 in England, women are longer lived than men.

Dr. A. D. Stammers, acting head of the Department of Physiology at the Witwatersrand University, told a large representation that the South African census shows one more male centenarian than female. It is a noteworthy fact, however, that during the years 1910-1921, for every 100 women who died in the Union, there were 118 deaths among men.

And more interesting still, the age of 90 averages, when the majority of men have married, the death rates for married men are lower considerably than for single men. In the case of women, on the same basis, the death rates of married women were higher than single women.

The census figures suggest that the longer they live, the better off the women are in an satisfactory indication of why that is so. It is argued that the longer a woman lives, the longer her husband lives, and that marriage is an important factor in prolonging life. One out of four life of the more active women would need to prolong her days.

TREATMENT OF CHOLERA AND PLAGUE.
 Experiments in a Tropical School.
COMBATING MICROBES.
 Important research work in connection with the treatment of infectious diseases the cholera and plague with the aid of a contagious disease caused by extra-ordinary minute parasites, is now gaining the attention of Dr. Felix Danciger at the California School of Tropical Medicine.
 Some time ago the Advisory Board of the Indian Research Fund Association requested Dr. Danciger, Director of the International Sanitary Council of Egypt, to carry out an investigation of the cholera and plague in cholera and plague. Dr. Danciger was formerly Chief of Laboratories at the Pasteur Institute of Paris and Professor at the University of London. He recently arrived in California and has taken up his investigations.
 With reference to the work he has been doing, he said: "You will understand that I cannot give you details of the study which I am now making, but I can tell you about the question of bacteriology in general. I have been working at this subject for 25 years and it is extremely complicated. One of the main points may be summarized as follows: We all know that infectious diseases of man and animals are caused by microbes, but I have found that microbes in their turn can be attacked by a contagious disease caused by ultra-microscopic parasites. This disease, I have called bacteriophage, and the parasite which causes it "the bacteriophage."

 The first disease I studied from this point of view was bacillary dysentery. I noticed that at certain stages in the disease there appeared in a patient a bacteriophage which had the power of attacking and destroying the microbes which caused the disease. The microbes die and the patient is cured."

...to convalescence. In those cases where bacteriophage is not applied, the patient died. Since these observations were made, I have carried out similar experiments on animals and in each of them I have found the same phenomenon. Recovery from an infectious disease results from the destruction of pathogenic microbes and this destruction is produced by the action of bacteriophage. Further experiments are being carried out to determine if it is possible to apply this phenomenon to other diseases.
 We have that bacteriophage is applicable to the case of the species of microbes which cause cholera and plague, and our observations indicate that in these cases bacteriophage is applicable. These microbes are extremely small and can only be seen with the aid of a microscope. Bacteriophages are still smaller. The same difference in size exists between bacteriophage and a microbe. In spite of their extremely minute size, I have succeeded in isolating this minute parasite in laboratory conditions which are variations of the microbes causing cholera and plague. The bacteriophage is a great deal smaller than a microbe. It is a single molecule, four or five hours after the introduction of a single bacteriophage into a tube containing several hundred of thousands of microbes, there will be only a single molecule left and the liquid will be found several times as clear as before. **BOOM TO RESIDENTS IN
TROPICS.**

The Principles of the Columbia system of tropical medicine prove to be a boon to the tropics in the tropics. It is anticipated that the benefits associated with sudden changes from a cool room to an overheated atmosphere have been found in fact it is found that a spell in a cool room raises the vitality to such an extent that the person who has spent four days in depression associated with high temperatures for several hours after leaving the room "it may be twenty or even fifty years before the advantages of artificial air cooling are realized in the tropics, hot or later it will be appreciated that mankind can secure a suitable environment in the tropics by adopting the well-known principle of air refrigeration," concludes the Principal.

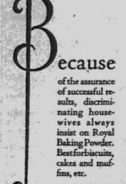
He said and expressed immediate regret that the new system, but he believed that ten or twenty years would prove that something had been done to make the natives in the scale of civilization benefiting both natives and whites, and that he was an incentive to the natives to seek work.

He strongly favoured white immigration but only when the country was ready, but when native reserves had been exhausted, and when it had been reasonable when crops would yield the fact that it was more important to progress surely than quickly.

The Famine-Fighting Fleet

ANOTHER "Message to Garcia"—the log of the International fleet that trekked across the Mesopotamia wastes at the call of the Persian Government!

When famine threatened Teheran, the capital, last winter, the Persian administration ordered its first ten heavy-duty trucks from the International Harvester organization. Bagdad, ancient city of romance, gave the travellers a dinner in their honour and a night of rest, and transferred them from desert to mountain going. Motor fuel for the Persian government, and wheat, took the place of cement for cargo. The cavalcade forged on both night and day, and entered Teheran the seventh day after Bagdad.

The entire fleet was in the pink of condition and every truck of the ten, on the morning of arrival, went out to Kasvin, a hundred miles away, and began bringing back great loads of the precious wheat.

The Persian government, impressed by the stamina of International Trucks, immediately ordered twenty more of them, and these have since duplicated the travel history of the first fleet.

WHEN MAN LIVES FOR EVER.

The Conquest of Disease by Science.

PROFESSOR'S FORECAST.

In the opinion of Professor R. A. Dart, Professor of Anatomy, University of Witwatersrand, the discovery of the Tanga skull, man is not only living longer than he did 100 years ago, but our knowledge of the human body and its composition and processes is growing so rapidly that it is not too far to expect that bodily immortality will ultimately be achieved.

Nothing that is conceivable is impossible. The existence of the body is a physico-chemical problem. The body is composed of chemical substances of bio-chemistry, and bio-physics or the study of the chemical and physical properties of the human body are, two of the most recently established sciences which have as their object the understanding of all physical and chemical processes.

At present we know that these processes are subject to many interferences. These interferences are called diseases. When we are able to understand the processes completely there is nothing so far as we know to prevent the prevention of the body living on indefinitely. A hundred years ago the average life expectancy of human life was about 37 years, and the average expectancy is about 65, which is the average man is now living longer than he did 100 years ago. The primary cause of this lengthening of life is the conquest of disease. The spread of infection is now more or less under effective control. We have now to combat malaria, typhoid, diphtheria, enteric fever, cholera and plague.

RECENT ADVANCES

We have made enormous advances in sanitation, hygiene, public health, and preventive medicine. There has been a tremendous change that has been made possible by the discovery in connection of Mottion and in anticipation by later work has led to the conquest of many of our most serious diseases. We are still without cures for cancer, tuberculosis, and the diphtheria.

Site Value.

JOHANNESBURG COUNCIL APPROVES A PENNY RATE.

The Johannesburg City Council recently adopted a proposal of the Finance Committee, which has been the subject of warm discussion. The proposal is to increase the rates to pay for a special penny rate on the value of the land for the purpose of the independent and one of the Nationalist members.

One of the Independents, Mr. M. J. Harris, contended that sufficient money has been spent on roads that there were grounds for increasing the rates, and it was about the proposition was considered by the provision of paved side walks.

While agreeing that some change in the municipality's policy for raising funds was necessary, he disapproved of the expedient now to be adopted for road construction, and suggested that a better method would be to adopt a special assessment system.

It is estimated that a penny rate will produce £200,000 annually.

Wholesale distributors announced a reduction of 2d. per gallon in respect of bulk and returnable packages. At a meeting of the South African Motor Trades' Association, the position was discussed, and it was decided to lower the retail price of petrol to 2s. per gallon. These appreciable reductions in the bulk quantities of the big oil companies, which enable the consumer to buy petrol at a much cheaper price than before.

DEMONSTRATION OF A NEW MOTOR PLOUGH

The "Stock" at Work.

BIG FUTURE IN KENYA

In Kenya, an invitation to witness the work of a new tractor or a new plough generally draws a large number of planters and farmers to the scene of action. And the invitation which appeared in the columns of the East African Standard recently to see the work of the new motor plough was equally successful, for it was realized that in this machine the tractor and plough are combined into one unit. In accordance with custom, a representative of the Agricultural Standard was present at a demonstration of the work of which was made up especially which took place on Mr. Kell's farm near Nairobi on June 20.

Before going into details of the machine itself or of the work which was accomplished it should be stated that the machine is a factory machine and overcame all the difficulties which were put before it.

ADVANTAGES.

One of the greatest and most cheap advantages of the Stock Motor Plough is that the tractor is the motor and the plough is the working part—the plough frame and bodies. The result of this is to give it unusual mobility combined with rigidity. The fact that it has not only two forward speeds, but also one reverse, permits of quite exceptional maneuverability. It can go into positions requiring a very small turning space, whilst in the ordinary ploughing of a field, where a furrow is completed, it is only necessary to raise the shares off the ground, reverse into position for a new furrow, and carry on. In other words the plough never leaves the field, and it is therefore possible to develop it right into the corners. All the levers are operated from the drivers seat, and the mechanism is simply but skilfully constructed. In its two forward speeds it travels at three or four miles per hour, and in its slightly over three miles per hour and two and a half miles per hour respectively, and in reverse at three miles per hour. It is claimed that it can plough 10 acres in a 10-hour day—an acre an hour. It is further claimed that it can turn over soil to a depth of 18 inches.

The big wheels are heavily flanged and glide easily over all obstacles. The three shares work the soil to any required depth, because they are forced into the

ground, whereas the shares of a plough drawn by a tractor or some other do not carry sufficient weight for this essential purpose.

THE DEMONSTRATION.

During the demonstration on Monday, three types of land were used. Land which had been three times ploughed, land which had been sown with steel and still had the strong fibrous roots in it, and rough grass the plough was still tackling. On all of these the plough proved its capabilities, and on all of them was there a hitch or pause of any kind. In some of the cases in which there was a formidable network of old roots and rough grass the plough went cleanly and deeply. Whilst in the last field which had previously been ploughed three times, it was noticed that the Stock Plough did not scrape tires over the top soil, but went three or four inches deeper than had been ploughed before.

On the large wheels are flanges or "spurs" some six and a half inches long. These give great adherence to the ground and, at the same time, as they bite into the soil they strain it in the most favorable way to be. There is no packing of the soil and this must be recognized as a very great feature of the machine.

The engine which is 40 h.p. is of the vertical type of four cylinders cast from a spinning pipe supplied with electricity from a magnet. Petrol is used for starting and petrol for running. The plough itself is just 18 feet in length, 6 feet wide in width. Throughout the trials on Monday, three shares were used, though it is possible to fit the same number of discs if they are desired.

INTEREST AROUSED.

The interest of all who were present at the demonstration—and some came from 20 and 40 miles—was marked and a good impression was left with those who saw the work which was accomplished. Everyone who knows the black cotton soil of the Athi Plains knows that it is a difficult problem to tackle, but the "Stock" came through its trials with all ease.

Already this motor plough has found favor in other countries. In Germany, the home, it is in use whilst during the last few months of the demonstration in Nairobi and other centers in the same future, after which the machine will be on view at the Eastern Africa Show in Nairobi in August.

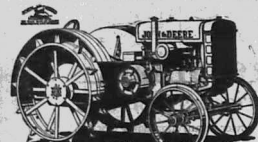
