A HINT TO KENYA.

In the course of an interesting discussion on taxation the Hon. Mr. Nyerere was asked:

"The question of Income Tax for a British Colony or Protectorate is a difficult one and has many economic and controversial points. But, assuming a hypothetical system of the kind Uganda has the advantage of being able to look round and observe the methods employed and the results obtained elsewhere. A tax on income is generally considered to be the fairest form of taxation, and it is the main source of revenue for the United Kingdom, and a considerable source of revenue for India, if that is not too far. In the Union of South Africa, it has been since 1923, a source of revenue for the Netherlands, and the Straits Settlements, and the Federated Malay States. It would appear, therefore, that it is a common and popular form of taxation, so far as so any taxation can be said to be popular."

We are informed that some time ago an Income Tax was tried in a certain British Colony in East Africa, and was abandoned owing to the inability of the Government to enforce their own laws in remote areas. We should say, at this juncture, that in such cases, it is not a matter of principle, but of practicality.

What is the present situation in East Africa with reference to taxation? The fundamental principle of taxation is that it should be imposed where it is best able to bear it. In the case of Kenya, we do not think that an attempt should be made to impose a general income tax in the present state of the country, but that the present methods of taxation should be improved by the introduction of a sales tax, which is a more equitable method of raising revenue, and which can be enforced more easily in remote areas. A tax on income is generally considered to be the fairest form of taxation, and it is the main source of revenue for the United Kingdom, and a considerable source of revenue for India, if that is not too far. In the case of Kenya, we do not think that an attempt should be made to impose a general income tax in the present state of the country, but that the present methods of taxation should be improved by the introduction of a sales tax, which is a more equitable method of raising revenue, and which can be enforced more easily in remote areas. 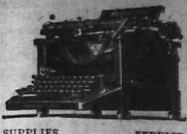

# OUR WOMEN'S PAGE.

### A Letter from Paris

From a Parisienne's Notebook.

As each of these will be used to trim dresses and hats worn by a tall, slim woman, with hair of some elaborate fashion with quite a few curls.

A good white cream which adheres and does not smudge, and a soft, delicate material for a girl's evening frock is, however, beautiful, and needs little or no extra decoration, but for a young girl, there are a few things to watch for in a dress. The material should be a deep cream, lace hard to beat, and makes the best of simple dresses, and keeps in beautiful folds and pleats. It is another material, too, which needs no ironing.

#### MODERN NERVES AND HEADACHES.

The woman who cries when things go wrong, or when she fails to get her own way, is about as common as Dodo. But women nature, requiring what is not feminine nature in particular being pretty much as ever has been, to what does a woman turn to in view of the "nervous system" of the Victorian?

When critics say hard things about the modern taste for cigarette smoking among the feminine sex, I wonder if they realize that these little indulgences are often the sedatives employed for over-wrought nerves. For emotional people, for worried women, for half a smoked cigarette which at one time called forth floods of tears, if there were by Madame either mental or her husband to have "a good cry" to forget or wipe the "broken down" on a pillow, and make sure and get her feet hot. It is no longer seen so difficult with good effect, so who she wipes the cigarette hand and that off for a good job. But these remedies are more expensive, and little more efficacious. Beside, culture has never before tolerated the emetics of emotion today, but women have turned to their own means for relief, for rectifying the balance on the verge of disturbance, and the modern method of relief is to smoke a cigarette. It may be that a more healthful method, but sometimes it needs a whole outfit to relieve the present cheerfulness.

The husband of a woman who has been in a very dry mood for this treatment, and he may be forgiven if he suggests, but he is not to be taken too seriously. May be a "good cry" will come back to her before long.

#### RESERVEIVE BATH SALT.

Reserveive bath salts are easy to prepare, and quite inexpensive. To prepare them, take four ounces of carbonate of soda and spread it out to dry in the open air for a day. Then put it in a tin and add half an ounce of oil of lavender and leave unremoved for an hour. Lock doors and see as to quiet. Reserveive bath salts make the bath refreshing and stimulating. To prepare them, take four ounces of carbonate of soda and mix it in a tin powder. To this add five ounces of tartaric acid and mix the two well together. Then add three ounces of rose-flower and thoroughly mix again. A perfume may be added, if desired. The salts may be kept in a tin or bottle having a well-fitting lid. When the bath is ready, add just before it is used, three to a few tablespoonfuls into the water.

Bath tablets which effervesce when placed in the bath are prepared with equal quantities of bicarbonate of soda and tartaric acid, and with the same amount of powdered starch, and perfume with lemon oil. This mixture makes a cheap and fragrant bath tablet.

#### TO MAKE JAVELLE WATER.

I can often asked how to make Javelle water which is a disinfectant and bleaching agent, so we say: Here is my recipe.

Take one pound of washing soda, one quart of boiling water, half a pound of chloride of lime and two quarts of cold water. Dissolve the chloride of lime in cold water and let it settle. Dissolve the washing soda in cold water and let it settle, pour the clear liquid into the soda water and stir well to settle. Bottle, cork and keep the mixture in a dark place.

To Use: For bleaching, use Javelle water mixed with an equal quantity of plain water, but do not use for permanent colors. In some cases more than half an hour time in several waters, and lastly, in some weak ammonia water. For removing stains from white linen and cotton, stretch the stained portions of the cloth in

#### STAINED FUR PUDDING.

1 cup butter or other fat, 1 cup sugar, 1 cup milk, 1 egg, 2 cups flour, 4 teaspoon Royal Baking Powder, 1 teaspoon salt, 1 teaspoon vanilla or lemon extract, 1 cup chopped figs.

Melt butter in a cream, add sugar slowly and beaten egg; add milk, mix well, add flour, baking powder and salt, which have been sifted together, add vanilla and figs. Pour into greased pudding mold; cover tightly and steam for two hours. Serve with cream or other sauce desired.

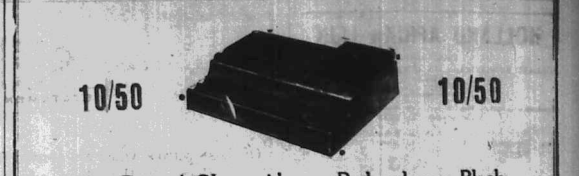

### The "Mission Boy"

If the Church conference which is now being held in Nairobi can find time to devote to a survey of some of the more important aspects of mission work in East Africa, it may perform a valuable service to the Church in the territories. The work of a complete survey, but so the search for an improved basis for co-ordination in church life and work some of the major lessons may be considered with very real advantage. It is a common belief throughout Eastern Africa, especially among the professional workers of the community, that mission influence upon the average African is not always completely beneficial. The position that in East Africa has hitherto been regarded as a mission field, the most general form of this work to subject affecting native life which we are directly within their presence. Among those subjects which are usually included. It should be primary duty of the state to accept responsibility for education but that has been shared with other bodies of whom the missionary societies form a chief and important part. While nothing can minimize or reduce the value of the spiritual education of the mission schools in Eastern Africa, there is little doubt of the evil effects, particularly in past years, of the lack of standardization, irregular grading and the lack of professional knowledge which has been allowed to diversify systems and principles. Yet there is an extreme spiritual apathy, superstition, and few resources available for the great task, to receive which are as yet only in process of mobilization. It is the policy of the Eastern African Standard to welcome and assist the cooperation of the missions. But while freedom in organizational development, complete equality of status and stimulation program, the effects upon the mind and spirit of the individuals African are sometimes abnormally diverse. At present official reports disclosed there are schools in which European standards make a definite call on African life, schools which are definitely separations from African customs and beliefs and yet others which aim definitely at utilizing African life, songs, customs and so on. An educational object of the Colonial Office Advisory Committee on Native Education reported in 1925. found that the results of education in Africa had been abnormally diverse and formulated broad principles which have since been the foundation of the official policy. The difficulty, especially in the reserves, is to avoid the danger of half-understood aims and ideals. Motivated by ill-regulated and ill-considered ideas, the State has been obliged to accept a wide range of educational material to the needs of the African and to generate the national individuality of the State. 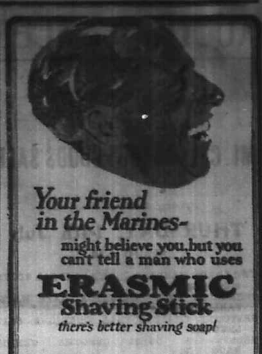
