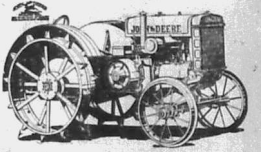

of public opinion in Britain and might there are dangers associated with too great haste in achievement, there are no dangers in a proper and sustained enthusiasm. MAGNET CURE

Mr. Dennis of Mochi, kindly writes me a long letter on the subject of snake bite, and the antidote. He had read in my "Notes" the beauty of my dog's teeth and has commented on a helpful one. Mr. Dennis is evidently well versed on the subject of snake poisoning. He tells me that Alder Verdon acts less on the nerves than on the blood, and that when used in small doses for some time on the nerves and death is averted by persistent use. But Alder does become deadly by itself and is a blood poisoner. I am informed that the drug of a pest Alder is 3/4 of an inch in length and the poison is injected into the tissue of the snake. The cutting of the wound should be very deep, and not only in one place, but around the perimeter as well. Mr. Dennis believes that the antidote is more effective and permanent than the antidote I have used. I should thoroughly applied that they are effective and save life, but that it is not possible to use or judge for certain that these have been properly applied. We should therefore have by us and ready to hand, the antidote which is a proved cure for all snake bites, even to that of the deadly Mamba. Mr. Platenberg is a member of the Museum and Snake Park of Port Elizabeth S. A. and he has made snake poison, life saving and produced a cure. It is given hypodermically and in case of a fresh attack intravenously.

THE SHOP HOURS ACT.
New Law Comes into Force a Week from To-day.
WHAT SHOPKEEPERS MUST DO

Regulations Regarding Working Hours and Holidays of Shop Assistants.

["E. A. Bessant" Special.]
 The Shop Hours Act comes into force in Nairobi a week to-day—Thursday, September 1.

In order that those who are affected by it in its practical application in Nairobi and its environs may be reminded of the duties and restrictions laid out briefly by this new legislation, the details are set out in the following article.

It will be seen that with certain exceptions all shops on Sundays and public holidays and all shops on weekdays by 8 p.m., on week days and all shops on public holidays and all shops on weekdays by 9 hours a day or half days a week. At the end of each year's service they are entitled to 12 days' holiday with pay.

A SOCIAL EXPERIMENT.
 The Shop Hours Ordinance now before the Legislative Council is an experiment in social legislation. It is an attempt to regulate the working hours of those who are not permitted to work more than 9 hours a day or half days a week. At the end of each year's service they are entitled to 12 days' holiday with pay.

Working Hours.
 Having fixed the hours of opening and closing, and the half-holiday, the provisions of the Act are as follows:—The shop assistant shall not be employed for more than 9 hours a day or half days a week. At the end of each year's service they are entitled to 12 days' holiday with pay.

AGRICULTURAL POSITION IN EAST AFRICA.

Large Increase in Trade of Nyasaland. KENYA LAND VALUES.

Mr. Thomas Peel, presiding at the annual meeting of the shareholders of the Standard Bank of East Africa in Nairobi recently made the following reference to conditions in the East African territories.

Agricultural prospects in 2010 districts are generally satisfactory; the main crop is expected to be very fair, and the season crop is excellent. Cattle farmers are also doing well, but in certain districts are handicapped by the prevalence of East Coast Fever. Business continues on second time, with the trade of the country showing a marked expansion.

Trade in Nyasaland showed a marked improvement during the year under review, despite the somewhat disappointing cotton crop, which was about 800 tons less than that of 1929. The 1929 tobacco crop was very satisfactory, and the new crop is expected to show a further large increase.

Notwithstanding a moderate rain fall in certain districts, the farming outlook in South-West Africa on the whole has improved. Some anxiety is being felt as to the effect of the increased production of silver demands in the Union may have on the prospects of the diamond industry in this territory, as it is open the industry that the

Insurance is largely dependent for its business.

As regards East African territories, which there has been some progress in Tanganyika, there has been a revival of Kenya and Uganda, while, as usual, trade figures show, though there is no change in net exports and imports. This is an entirely new departure for the territory, such as is bound to occur in the course of the development of agriculture, and to that, perhaps, the danger of agricultural overdevelopment may be attributed. The impression upon the mind is that, in the future, the danger of overdevelopment will be avoided, and that the trade of the territories will be brought to a level which will be of great benefit to the territories.

Lead values in East Africa have shown little change, and it is satisfactory to see that orders are being placed to realize some fully that the price of lead is now 200. The price is entirely on its average price level, and is also a mark of good and bad years.

The labour position is generally reported to be quiet, and the latest reports received from East Africa indicate the probability of a better season.

Railway Development.

There has been considerable railway development, which cannot fail to add materially to the prosperity of these territories, as the lack of transport has always been a great drawback to agricultural progress.

We shall follow with interest the proceedings of the Commission of Enquiry which the Government propose to send to Africa to consider and make recommendations as to the best means of securing more effective co-operation between the different portions of East and West Africa, and Eastern Africa in matters concerning other things of transport and communication and of East Africa and Central Africa.

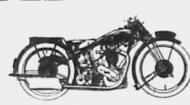

LABOUR IN KENYA.
CONSIDERATION OF AN OUTSTANDING PROBLEM.
No. 4
Labour Recruiting.
 (By An Old Member.)

This series of articles on aspects of the labour problem in Kenya has been conducted by one who has been associated with the active agricultural development of Kenya since 1914.

The different methods of labour recruiting are always a fertile subject of discussion, not to say argument, in any gathering of farmers. Possibly the problem of bringing it to some worthy of discussion. For the issue, who else has his labour to put the man who has much difficulty in recruiting them.

There has been much talk lately of government organizations for obtaining labour. It is "Government must do some-thing." Exactly what it should do is not apparent. But if you come down to details you find a painful impression that Govern-ment ought to be able to guaran-tee for at least this generation, possibly in perpetuity, a plentiful supply of cheap labour for the farmer to handle as he pleases. Surely this, if it is a possible solution. That Government en-couragement of native labour is such perfectly legitimate ways as deducting the annual collection of land tax at a time when farm labour is most urgently needed is bene-ficial will be concerned, no one can doubt; but any considerable inter-ference with the great basic laws of supply and demand would surely be detrimental.

While it certainly is neces-sary, and more even more hand-ful to many employers, to be forced to employ Kikuyu who they can ill afford because native labour is so scarce, it is more pre-ferable, still in the long run, that the machinery will pay over and over again both in the increasing of expense, and in the saving of man-power with which the farmer must contend. It is directly detrimental to employers and employees alike if labour could be recruited as much as a cheap labour as it is to employ it wastefully than it is to

include labour saving methods. It would probably not be pro-cessing agency to visit without having that gold will justify those means from the reserves without also regulat-ing the amount that each em-ployer could have? This would mean amongst other things limit-ing the individual production and business of the whole employer, as the scheme might be if worked by a perfect Govern-ment body, a perfect Govern-ment body and being sub-ject to every detail of our work as a social system.

Again a tribe phrase is brought to bear upon the situation by some who are B.O. "I never answer a native to his clothes, they seem so much more natural in his clothes." Possibly this, put it the other way round, it would be unwise to encourage a native to wear clothes, because if he left us down to do so they would not in the best affect his masculinity. For the native (especially the Kikuyu) who has reached the stage of wearing decently clean clothes and taking a pride in his appearance and who will volun-tarily working, a to be very much encouraged for his work to be of a much higher standard than that of the unskilled labourer, and having a more immediate necessity for meeting good wages. He is more amenable to the training necessary for a skilled job. What the Sunday clothes appeal to a Kikuyu, seems it is not he altogether beside the point. He is certainly sometimes ridiculous in them, but we have all under-standingly passed through that stage, and it is a stage that we do not wish to see in our native.
