WORLD'S NEWS.

Canadian Ministers.
As Colonial Institute Guests

CANADA AND THE EMPIRE
Deuter's Special to "E. A. Standard" London, July 11.

Mr. Borden, Premier of Canada, and his colleagues were the guests at a dinner given in their honour at the Colonial Institute.

Amongst the notable present were Lord Selkirk, Lord Agill and Lord Curzon. Mr. Borden in reply to the toast of the evening said that the Canadians were determined to work out their destiny as one of the great nations of the British Empire.

They realized that same supremacy was the breath of life to the Empire, the integrity of which could not be secured by the Navy, One King and One Flag. But he did not desire to say anything that might impair Canadian autonomy. The great question of defence could not be settled for years to come and certainly not at Confer once lasting for a few weeks. He emphasized that those proposals for defence must have a voice in the policy and the shaping of the Empire and Canada, did not propose to be an object of even the British Empire.

The Orange men celebrating the twelfth of July, sixty thousand of them marched to Belfast to White Abbey despite downpour of rain and anti-climatically passed a resolution against Home Rule.

Mr. F. E. Smith in addressing the Unionists said the British made over Home Rule was corrupt and unconstitutional. If he were an Ulster patriot he would support the Unionists by the British of Turkey than by Mr. Jervis.

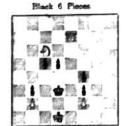

Notes for Women.

Subtleties of Soup Making.

To fathom the secrets of soup making, nothing is so important as the appearance. Given these, no housewife need fear criticism of her soup when it is served. It will seem understood how to balance the seasoning, so that while there is a palatable mixture of all the flavors, none is predominant. In boiling meat for stock, it is never well to longer than the time specified in that time all that is valuable for its purpose is extracted. The bones of most soup is made of some sort. A sparkling and nutritious soup can be made without the use of meat. In proof of this one, has just to be made with a dash of celery, cream, soup, tomato, and so on, the foundation of which is implied in the name. Perhaps one other quality (weight) is necessary. She who would succeed in soup-making, her soup should have a strong and good stock ready to it.

For a family soup, the water in which the meat has been boiled, and the fat from the rind and rib of beef, or from mutton, are the best. The trimmings of large joints, and the fat from the neck of mutton, the large bones of the sirloin and the bones of the neck, are also good. A good foundation. In making the soup itself, do not "sieve" the soup. It is better to strain it through a fine cloth. Do not "soak" it. It is better to season it with cold water or high. Put fresh meat into soup of already-cooked meat, pour hot, but not boiling, water, over it.
