DRUG AIDS FOR EXAMINATIONS.

Advice to Nervous Students.

REMY AND DIET.

Several hints to students who have to face examinations are given by Dr. Alex. McKeown, Lecturer in the Department of Midwifery, Glasgow, in his most recent issue of the "Lancet". His recommendations are a handy guide to students who are "nervous" to consider his diet and to appeal to the student who is in the old hand of passing examinations.

For those whose examinations proceed are submitted by the light of an examination paper, he says, "a drug such as caffeine, which, in small doses, certainly stimulates the higher centres, is often beneficial in the form of the black coffee half an hour or so before a written paper."
Preparation by a stern tutor with "regimentation" should be recommended as a training for stout nerves who take strong fright at oral examinations. A whole day off spent in every-day recreation is often a great help.

Parents' Anxiety.

Home worries should be reduced to a minimum. "Over-attention parents do not always realize what harm can be done by letting it be seen that they are very nervous over the children's examinations."
Some candidates take little or no breakfast before an examination and have only a certain portion for lunch. While the lack of food of heavy meals is probably beneficial, the few nibbles and drinks do much to prevent the collapse of candidates in the afternoon. The middle meal should be the same as that taken on ordinary days with the addition of some sugar or some other such substance as glucose or a little quantity of brandy.

Dr. McKeown concludes parents with the following advice: "Do not expect too much of your child. A few hours of study in the evening will do more for him than a whole day of over-exertion. POULTRY NOTES.

The Egg.

Generally speaking the egg should receive one-third of the air space of the egg on the 12th day if the air space is too large it shows that there is not sufficient moisture and if the air space is too small it shows that moisture must be reduced.

If the perforations in the egg shell are too large and very close to the added air, the egg shell is termed "popped" and such eggs will not give good results in hatching.

Under normal conditions it takes about twenty-four hours for the egg to travel the entire length of the oviduct. Of this time, fifteen or seventeen hours is passed in the process of the egg containing its outer covering of shell, and its lining fluid. Hence usually lay between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m.

As far as the egg is laid, reproduction commences. As respiration continues the air space in the egg increases in size, and by the laying the air space in the egg is increased fully one-third. When an egg is laid the air space is quite small.

In incubating, especially artificial, great attention, during setting, should be paid to the air space, so, to a great extent, the

present table egg being used by purchase. The hatching process. Fricking the egg, and various other manipulations are resorted to when hatching eggs are sold for table, but of these things are detrimental to the hatching qualities.

These, again, eggs for table use are usually produced by forcing carefully and such methods are not conducive to the hatching of healthy chicks.

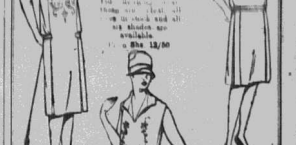
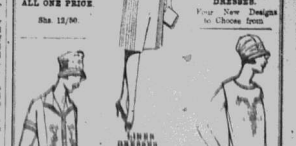

WORK PISTON RINGS.

How They Should Be Replaced.

HINTS TO THE AMATEUR.

The car owner who intends to replace worn piston rings should have some mechanical knowledge before attempting the task. Although not a difficult operation, it is necessary and a certain amount of experience is advisable if the job is to be done properly.

Providing the owner feels competent to tackle the operation, precautions are as follows: We will assume extra work is required, that the car has been dismantled. For safety work a pit is needed, or a jacking stand, or the car may be jacked up on blocks or stones to secure a steady plane in which to work.

Remove the spark plug and the bottom of the stroke is first turned until two points are at the top of the stroke, preferably one on each side of the piston.

Now get under the engine and remove split pins from the rod and bearing and remove the retaining nuts. The bottom half of the rod will now drop into your hand, or will come off very easily. Hold it in the same position as when on the crankshaft.

Do not allow it to be turned round then remove any shims (if the bearing shells between the two halves of the bearing), taking care that these are kept on the proper side of the bearing.

Hold the connecting rod and gently push upwards until you have seen to replace the lower part of the bearing exactly as it was before removed. The whole thing—piston, connecting rod, and split pins bearing can now be pushed upwards to the top of the cylinder.

FOREIGN COMPETITION IN EAST AFRICA.

Unofficial Conference Resolution Analyzed.

TRADE FIGURES.

Although no full appreciation for the future prospects of the East African market, it is within the province of this journal to discuss the question of political federation which has been occupying the attention of the Nairobi Conference, and which will next come before the Royal Commission (says the British and South African Export Gazette). Unofficially in Customs matters and commercial legislation in connection therewith by the majority of the mercantile authorities in British, French, Tanganyika and the other territories affected, and some complete unity of control, but in a degree that takes the latter case to protect the position of Northern Rhodesia and Nyasaland, and to make it plain. Meanwhile, however, some resolution passed by the non-official delegates at Nairobi demands to be brought into the shadow of political and economic federation, and dealt with as a matter of immediate urgency. We refer to the motion regarding unity of the mercantile departments of foreign goods, which the delegates are understood to have articulated mainly to the favour of British manufacturers and shippers to study East African trade and to adopt their trade to it.

No Alarming Features.

Before examining the complaint it is necessary to ascertain how far the situation warrants it. The delegates were practically all European men with direct interest in the import trade either as merchants, or as producers dependent on their machinery, implements, domestic and personal supplies, and so on.
