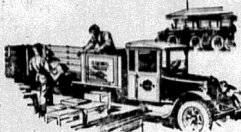

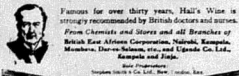

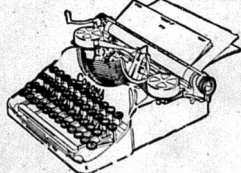

MEDICAL LIES AND LIARS.

Need to Diagnose the Truth.

AMERICAN'S VIEW.

The longer I practise medicine the more I am convinced that every physician should cultivate as a first art.

Thus does Dr. Joseph Collins, a leading American physician, begin an article in an American magazine.

"Some lies," he continues, "are more prejudicial than others to the physician's usefulness. There are other lies which contribute seriously to the success of the physician's sedulous ministrations and malice."

"He does not intend the whole truth about himself, who should wish to see his patients at his best health."

British doctors appear to agree with Collins. "A patient may say to me that he is the last thing he wants to hear, and so we do not tell him."

Specialist's Views. Sir Thomas Hunter, the famous cancer specialist, said recently—"A patient may say to me that he is the last thing he wants to hear, and so we do not tell him."

A Daily Express representative asked the opinion of Sir Cox, secretary of the British Medical Association.

"I should have thought the fact that doctors don't always tell the whole truth was too well known to be doubted," he said. "Obviously a doctor must sometimes tell lies or withhold parts of the truth."

The doctor in the first instance is not always aware of the disease or the malignancy of the disease from which his patient is suffering, and it is better never to tell than to lie."

"It is largely a matter of psychology. The doctor needs to acquaint himself with his patient's judgment, but it is a job on the profession for Dr. Collins to say that the 'successful doctor' exaggeration that 'in the average English doctor would regard."

ENGLISH WHICH IS BARMY TALK.

Strong Comments by Examiners.

"CHILDREN'S BRAINS"

The teaching of English composition and elementary arithmetic in the secondary schools of the country is severely criticised by the Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate in a report which commiserates the close state of the certificate examination issued recently.

They say of English composition, it appears from the high proportion of candidates whose work on this paper was thoroughly unsatisfactory that in many schools English composition receives inadequate attention on the part of the teachers.

One of the chief causes of the poor quality of some writing was deplorable. Compositions were childish in thought and expression, and were characterised by lack of coherence, incoherent use of quite common words, and a general ignorance of what an essay is.

Book Questions.

Candidates at many schools had been examined to answer questions of a certain stock type, but no general training in the use of English had been inspired. "The result," says the report, "is of grave importance, and the attention of teachers is earnestly called to the need for a more thorough and systematic teaching of the intelligent use of the English language."

The examiners found that in arithmetic and subjects involving arithmetic there was a marked lack of interest in significance in performing numerical calculations with decrease in expression. Teachers are told that many schools fail to give their pupils a satisfactory elementary knowledge of their own country, the general value of the Latin work was worse than a year ago, and there was

much bad grammar in the English versions of the French passages. The candidate numbered 2081, and of the 650 entered for arithmetic 2,002 boys and 1,905 girls were passed. Honours certificates were obtained by 684 boys and 353 girls.

They were found face to face, for each had been buried in a coffin. Mrs. Vinton, from York, says that the babies were five. There are no facilities at the hospital for the kind of work now conducted at a hospital and St. Thomas' Hospital is one of the few there are said to be in London.
