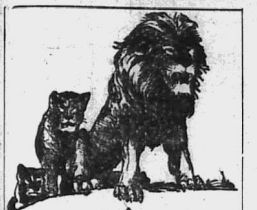

MOTOR TOPICS

POINTS TO REMEMBER

The motor type has been so much improved in the last few years, that many motorists drive for months on end without regarding the condition of their oil, and consequently without realizing that their oil is getting so bad that it is often at a loss to know how to proceed. Perhaps we should make it clear here that we are not referring to the quality of paraffin, but to the condition of a car, one of the four types of which we have mentioned.

Much depends upon the road surface where the car is used, and on the quality of the oil in travelling. For example, a car on a bad road at a speed of 2000 m.p.h. would cause very little wear in the driver, whereas a similar occasion at a higher speed on a better road might prove very troublesome, but to say this is dangerous.

AVOID BRAKING

A point to remember when dealing with horns is that, if at all possible, it is better to avoid braking hard. The reason is that the sudden application of the brakes, especially the motor vehicle, power which are extremely powerful, tends to make the deflated cover turn on the rim, spring out the valve, and possibly wrench the cover completely away from the rim. Through this occurs a more serious type on a sheep's chamber band, then the car may quite possibly overtake.

Generally speaking, however, provided the tyre are kept in reasonably good condition and are kept inflated regularly, there is very little danger of a puncture in a sudden burst. It is as well to avoid runs on the tyre on and off sharp bends, as to some extent when turning in a curve, the road or driving surface is uneven, and the car is liable to get into a rut.

THE COST OF CONTROLLING CRIME AND ADMINISTERING PUNISHMENT.
Salary Increases in the Kenya Police and Prisons Departments.

The following article, the sixth of the series, deals with the expenditure on the Police and Prisons Departments and again, for a comparison with 1923.

It will be seen that there is a very material increase in the cost of the Police Department which is not wholly accounted for by the development of the Railway and Port policies but is chiefly due to heavy revisions of the salaries of European officials. There has been an increase in the pay of the heads both departments.

THE RAILWAY AND PORT POLICE.

The Police Department follows closely in the Kenya Estimates after the Judicial and Legal sections of the Administration. The Police for the Department includes personnel for the Railway and the Port as well, and has not heretofore constituted the Kenya Police Department.

The Police Department has been steadily increasing in size since 1923. It is explained that it is important to maintain the Railway and Port Police by extra staff—non-Indigenous as Inspector for the Railway and Port, and other European constables, one Superintendent and one Assistant Superintendent. The African staff is increased by two but an additional staff is required. It is added that the cost of the increase in the Railway and Port Police has already been approved this year.

In the Kenya Police, that is to say the staff for the work of the Kenya Police, there is a decrease of 478 in 1927 as compared with 1926. The percentage increase in the personnel is being approved in the Kenya Department, and savings have been effected in the African staff, particularly in the force for the Railway and Port Police.

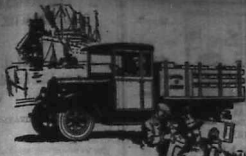

IMPROVED PUMP

Excesses Possibilities if
Carefully Applied.

IMPROVED PERFORMANCE

Almost a year ago an article and

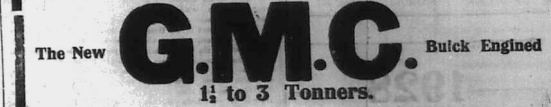

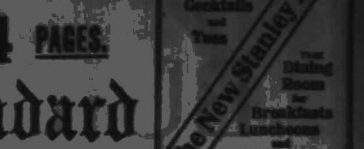



Mr. A. H. Spenser Palmer, left London at the end of last week for Clonca, en route to Nairobi. Mr. Spenser Palmer and the children are remaining in England for the time being.

Mr. T. B. P. Davis has given to Jersey, his birth-place, a firm to be used for agricultural research work and GRAY for the training of boys for the Army, Navy or Colonial Services.

Mr. Christopher J. Mahony, of Bangor, Mr. H. de Wark of Liverpool, Mr. H. B. Atkinson, of Liverpool, Mr. G. S. Parke, of Franklin, now of Nyamaland, but formerly of Kenya, and Mr. J. J. Vernon Wilson of Fort Ternan, are now all in London.

Mrs. M. A. Buxton's book entitled "Kenya Days" has now just been published by Edward

Arnold at a price of 12/6. It is wonderfully well given up, and the photographs are excellent and some, if not most, have evidently been taken by her. One in particular, dealing with the shooting of an elephant, is entitled "Clonus," but I should like to see a copy of that book which is a serious loss to Mrs. Buxton is exceptionally popular with everybody who knows her.
