THE INDIAN STATUTORY COMMISSION.

Earl Winterton Explains the Situation.

THE TWO MAIN CONSIDERATIONS.

Appointments Suggested by All Parties in the House. In moving the appointment of the Indian Statutory Commission in the House of Commons, Earl Winterton outlined the two main principles to be considered in connection with the appointments. The first was that the responsibility and ultimate decision rested entirely upon Parliament which could neither share nor hand over to any other country, and the second was that the composition of the committee and detail of the method of enquiry were integral whole.

NO INDIAN INFERIORITY.

By Mr. WILKINS. In the House of Commons today, Earl Winterton Under-Secretary for India moved the appointment of an Indian Statutory Commission. He said there were two points to consider. The first was that upon Parliament lay the responsibility and the ultimate decision upon the issues to be raised by the enquiry—responsibility which no member could shirk and which he would have to carry over to any other country. The second point was that the composition of the committee and every detail of method contemplated for its enquiry formed one integral whole which stood or fell together.

Earl Winterton recalled the circumstances under which the House in 1919 had appointed a committee to inquire into the Indian situation. He said he had fought but won, if I directed things in that way under the Act. He was, he thought, bound to state that the British found a first duty to India was to secure the responsibility of that country. The British found India a weaker country than they assumed the responsibility of the present and for the future of the Indian people and especially to treat for various countries in the world.

THE 1917 DECLARATION.

About the middle of next year the cotton section will  
 be commenced, a new branch railway to serve one of  
 the cotton native reserves in the Colony. This will be  
 from the Council to Yala, a distance of 60 miles and  
 is estimated to cost \$175,000.

As a result of the cotton line in developing this Kivu  
 road country was stressed in Legislative Council on  
 Monday when the belief was expressed that in a short  
 time it would prove to be one of the most profitable  
 branch railways in the country.

### HISTORY OF THE SCHEME.

In the Legislative Council on  
 Tuesday the Colonial Secretary  
 (Mr. Leonard Duggan) moved:  
 "That the Council consider  
 that the construction of the  
 Branch Railway from Nairobi  
 to North Kavirondo, provision  
 for which was included in the  
 schedule to the Imperial Loan  
 Ordinance (No. 39) 1924  
 should be proceeded with at an  
 early date and approve the annual  
 payment by the Colony to the  
 High Commissioner for  
 interest, after the completion  
 and opening of the line for ten  
 years, the payment of an amount equal  
 to the losses on the working of  
 the line as provided that on such  
 normal payment shall be  
 made the amount of the interest  
 and redemption charges on  
 the capital cost of the  
 branch."

The Colonial Secretary said:  
 "The Honorable the member  
 who introduced the branch rail-  
 way, the Kavirondo Line, is one  
 which has commended itself on  
 several occasions when it has been  
 discussed in this Council. It has  
 been particularly keen on the stocks since  
 the start of the year. It is a branch  
 which the Private Company applied  
 for a concession to construct  
 and which the Government has  
 not proposed that it take the  
 railway over the line which has  
 now been decided upon but it was  
 proposed to take this railway into  
 the hands of the Government."

A survey was made by the  
 Public Works Department in 1922 and  
 in 1923 the Secretary of State sug-  
 gested that a branch should be  
 constructed from Kisumu to Mu-  
 gudi in 1924 and 1925 a detailed  
 survey of the Union District Rail-  
 way to Mbita was made and in  
 1926 the construction of the Uasin  
 Gishu Railway as far as Tana was  
 undertaken. In 1928 the Secretary  
 of State suggested a railway  
 from Turko to meet the Uasin  
 Gishu Railway in Uganda, and that  
 year proposals were drawn up  
 which culminated in what is  
 known as the "Cotton" Loan and  
 in that "Cotton" Loan was in-  
 cluded a branch through the  
 Kavirondo Area. In 1928 the  
 railway of East suggested a  
 branch from Mbita to Turko  
 and suggestions have been  
 made as to the route the line  
 should take.

These suggestions have been  
 considered by the Railway Branch  
 Committee of this Council and the  
 resolutions that have been passed  
 by that Branch Railway Com-  
 mittee are in the following order:  
 In March 1927 the Intercolonial

Railway Council resolved that  
 a decision as to the route to be  
 followed should be left to the  
 Kenya Branch Lines Committee  
 and that the Kenya Government  
 should be asked to guarantee  
 Loan Charges whatever route  
 was adopted.

On 11th May 1927, the Railway  
 Branch Lines Committee have  
 considered the report and have  
 recommended that the Kenyan  
 Government should be asked to  
 guarantee the interest on the  
 loan of £1,000,000 for the  
 construction of the line from  
 Nairobi to Wala should be  
 made with all the earliest pos-  
 sible date estimated to be June or  
 July, 1928 with the object of  
 enabling the Government to be  
 able from the start of the year  
 a million loan will allow. As will  
 be seen, the Government of the  
 Kenya has been provided and in-  
 terest on the £1 million loan.

All that Council is asked to do  
 today is to guarantee an amount  
 equal to the loss on the working  
 of this North Kavirondo Branch  
 Line.

### Look After the Battery.

#### FURNISHED INFORMATION IN HOT WEATHER.

Periodical inspection of your battery's condition during hot weather is advised. The best test of trouble is to examine the automobile owner can carry.

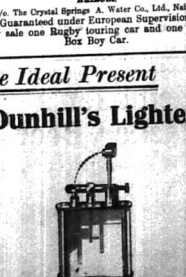
