## WORLD'S NEWS. BY CABLE.

### Lying-in-State. Continuous Crowds.

ENTIRE ABSENCE OF WEeping.

(Reuter's Special to "E. A. Standard.") London, Aug. 23

The body of General Booth is lying-in-state and is visited by continuous crowds in spite of the drizzling rain. The oak coffin, on which lies the General's cap and bible, is in the centre of the hall surrounded by officers holding flags. The lid on the coffin is of glass revealing the features which look as if he were asleep except for the paler. He is dressed in full uniform with red jersey showing the wrists while the collar also is noticeable. There is an entire absence of weeping amongst the Salvationists who are passing the coffin silently with grave and earnest faces.

**TIBUTE TO BOOTH.**

Adelaide, Aug. 23

The South Australian Assembly has passed a resolution of appreciation of General Booth in his work for humanity.

**KAISER'S SYMPATHY.**

London, August 23

In the afternoon a wreath of white lilies from the Kaiser was placed on General Booth's coffin, a representative of Emperor William expressing the Kaiser's sympathy with the General's family and with the Salvation Army.

### Salvation Army's New Leader.

**AN INTERVIEW WITH GENERAL BEAMWELL BOOTH.**

London, Aug. 23

The "Daily Chronicle" publishes an interview with General Beamwell Booth. In this interview General Beamwell Booth said that he did not doubt but that the military system of the Salvation Army would be maintained. He believed that there was still an immense amount of work to be done amongst the lowest strata of humanity and also in the service of foreign and Colonial Governments. The Salvation Army must do something for China. He thought that they would make the work to be done in that country one of their next steps. He thanked the readers of the world wide message of condolence that he had received. In conclusion he said: "My message to be done in this country one of the old General will still go marching with the Army; and, to my soldiers, I say let us honour Christ and live to save."

## A Great Funeral.

Compared to a Royal  
Procession.

FIVE THOUSAND UNIFORMED  
MOURNERS.

ROYAL WREATHS.

Router's Special to "E. A. Standard."

London, August 30.  
General Booth's funeral took the form of a great national demonstration. vast numbers of people had gathered in London to pay respectful tribute to the Salvation Army leader. The weather at the commencement of the procession from Olympia to the Cemetery was a bit showery at first, but became bright and sunny later. The procession threaded its way through the City, and then took a northward route along Kingsland-road to Albany Park Cemetery. There were everywhere dense and orderly crowds of a world wide representation and the funeral cortege was only to be compared with a Royal procession. The procession included five thousand uniformed Salvation Army officers who passed slowly over the route divided into forty eight brigades including representatives from all Dominions and foreign countries. Each detachment was headed by massed banners with white streamers bearing inscriptions which showed the world wide influence of the Army. Forty bands played with much beauty all the well-known funeral marches. The procession was intensely picturesque and impressive. The General's cap and bible were resting on his coffin which was borne upon a funeral car. General Bramwell Booth and his wife followed as chief mourners. Altogether the procession was a mile long and took an hour to pass the Mansion House, where the acting Lord Mayor saluted the coffin. The business near the route was suspended. Throngs gathered in the streets, windows and roofs remained reverently uncovered. The crowd was so great in parts that many women fainted.

### THE BURIAL.

The scene at the Cemetery was the most memorable ever known there. Every space was occupied. The late General Booth was interred in a severely plain grave beside his wife's on which many beautiful flowers were growing. A platform had been erected upon which were the wreaths of Kings, Princes, Ambassadors and many others.

### THE BURIAL SERVICE.

The service was of the most simple nature. A simple hymn was first sung and then the United States' representative gave a prayer. The Chorus was assisted by the massed bands. Brief addresses were then given by Commander Eva Booth and Commander A. Saffery and Cor paying tribute to the General's great work.

General Bramwell Booth, and his daughter then followed with a few simple words, the General finally reading the committal.

His Majesty the King and Queen Alexandra were represented at the service.

AUSTRALIAN MEMORIAL SERVICES.

Melbourne, August 31.  
The Salvation Army held a procession synchronizing with that held in London.

A memorial service was held in the Town Hall of Sydney at which there was an enormous gathering.

### GENERAL BOOTH'S WILL.

General Booth's will shows that the late General has left private property to the value of £487 which he divides amongst his children and property to the value of £5,285, representing a sum settled on him years ago by the late Mr. Reed for private use. It was this gift which enabled the General to forego all remuneration from the Army funds. He vests all the Army property trusts in Bramwell's name.
