TRIES BY WHICH CHINA IS ROUSED.

Babies Alleged to be Slain by Nuns.

The British consular officials in London Jan. 17, are reported to have received information from the Chinese Legation in London that the Chinese authorities in Hong Kong had ordered the British missionaries to leave the colony, where they were reported to have been engaged in a campaign of propaganda. The Chinese authorities are reported to have demanded the immediate departure of the missionaries, and to have threatened to confiscate their property and to deport them from the colony.
