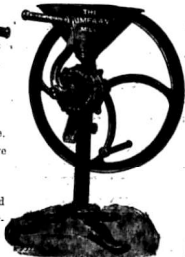

## WORLD'S NEWS. BY CABLE.

### British Association. Living and Non-Living Matter. EXTRAORDINARY ADDRESS.

[Buster's Special to "E. A. Standard," London, Sept. 5.] The English papers are making a prominent feature of Professor Schafers' address to the British Association now meeting at Dundee. The Professor forebodes the artificial production of life. He contends that research indicates that the dividing line between living and non-living matter is not so sharp as perhaps supposed. He states that both are governed by the same cell laws and life has no complex constitution and that the chemical production thereof is only a matter of time.

### Peace Proposals. London, Sept. 5.

Barns Herchell has sent his second communication to the Powers elaborating on the first but the latter still does not remove the doubt as to the ultimate success of the proposal.

### Strange Accident. TWO DEATHS. London, Sept. 6.

A huge water tank at the Pit head of the Colliery at Shakespeare's old Elmer has collapsed and fallen two thousand feet to the bottom of the pit. Two people were killed and six injured.

### Trades Union Congress. BEN TILLET'S MOTION OPPOSED. London, Sept. 6.

The Trades Union Congress has overwhelmingly defeated a motion by Ben Tillet that a Committee be appointed to inquire into the Government's powers in their prospective action regarding compulsory arbitration. Speakers vehemently opposed fearing that it might be taken the acceptance of the principle of compulsion.

### First Collision in Tube. 18 Injured. A NARROW ESCAPE. London, September 5.

The first collision which has ever taken place in a London Tube occurred last night at Caledonian-road station. Two hundred passengers had a narrow escape, eighteen being injured. There was a momentary panic, owing to the pitchy darkness.

### Ulster Bishops. London, Sept. 5.

The Ulster Protestant Bishops have issued a pastoral letter declaring that none can forecast the disastrous consequences of Home Rule. They appeal the 22nd instant as a day of humiliation and for prayer.

### Lloyd George and Suffragettes. WOMEN EJECTED BY AUDIENCE.

Mr. Lloyd George speaking at the Blandford as a woman was interrupted by a number of Suffragettes who were avidly ejected by the audience. The crowd outside gave them a rough handling with the result that their clothes were shredded. The woman was severely injured. The police managed to rescue the unfortunate woman under great difficulties.

Panama Tolls. SIR EDWARD GREY'S LETTER.

London, September 6. Sir Edward Grey, in a letter to the New...

Indefatigable Kaiser.

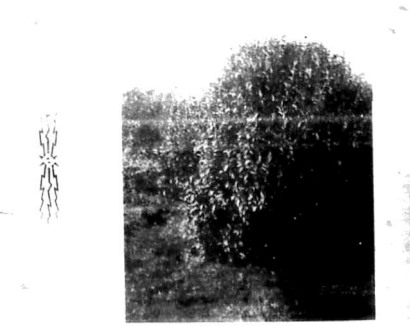




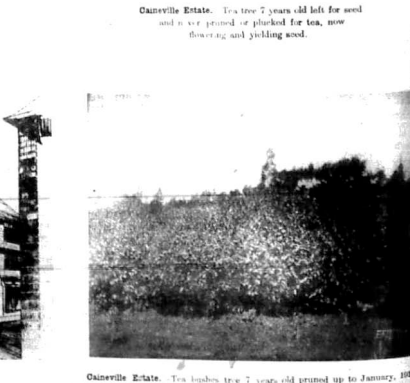

According to the programme twelve of the greatest masters will compete, and the four leaders will then contest the World's Championship. All the twelve taking part will have those who have won the International Tournaments, or set matches from such winners, and all their expenses will be paid.

During the next few weeks the Chess Editor will give elementary notes on the Opening and Mr. Somburg has kindly offered to discuss one of them, the Centre Gambit in detail. No part of the game is so important as the opening, and when one's opponent knows the correct moves in reply, it seems to get such a grip on the game as to make your position seem hopeless from the very start, unless you know the opening equally well.

A few words of explanation with regard to the terms used will be useful. A "Gambit" is a sacrifice of a pawn or piece in the opening to secure a better position. Most of the gambits are now said to be unsound, when strictly analysed.

Some Gambits have special names, e.g. "King's," "Bishop's," "Knight's" etc. There is no need that the gambit is sacrificed, or risked, merely that a prominent part is taken thereby by the K or B in the other play.

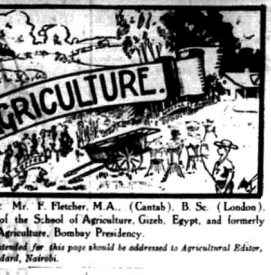

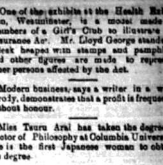

Establishment of Commercial Bank.

PROGRESSIVE POLICY.

(Reuter's Special to "E. A. Standard.") Peking, Sept. 13.

A ten million sterling loan agreement has been arranged in London which is independent of the Anglo-French-German-Austrian group and which includes the establishment of a Commercial Bank with a capital of two million pounds of which one million is provided from the loan. The bank office in London is composed of a mixed board of half Chinese and half English financiers including an English chairman. A similar board will sit in Peking also half English and half Chinese. The Chinese contend that this will satisfy the requirements of the investing public of all nationalities.

The Chinese Government has authorized Sun Yatzen to establish a Chinese Railway Corporation to build 70,000 miles of National Railways on the foreign loan. These Railways are to tap the frontier provinces where the Chinese control is essential but the scheme also includes the granting of proper concessions throughout China to Chinese and Foreign Companies for periods after which the lines are to revert to China. The Government is also considering the opening of the whole of China prior to foreign enterprise and residence, stipulating at the same time that these foreigners are to be amenable to Chinese Law as administered in special Courts. This scheme thus opens a very wide field for foreign capital.

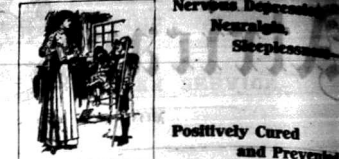

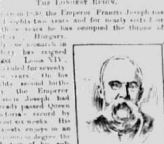
