

CITY FALLS TO VICTORIOUS NATIONALISTS

Fighting With-out-of-Hand Soldiery,

CONCESSION DEFENCES CLOSED AND FIVE NATIONS' TROOPS HURRIED IN.

The situation in China has now reached its most critical and explosive stage. Shanghai must answer the question whether the British and the other Powers Defence troops half or shall not be

drawn into the war.

Chang Sang Chang, the massive Ru-Erighad who recently took over the half-beaten Northerners or Peding Government Army, has fared worse than his predecessors. His name as a remorreless tyrant was hated even by the Chinese merchants in Shanghai Apparently; it has had the effect of turning masses of his army over to the Cantionness. And thus their sweep upon Shanghai has been expedited, not checked.

expedited, not cheesed.

Many thousands of desperate fugitives of the defeated army have poured into Shanghai. They are out of hand; the barbed wire defeness of the foreign concessions are closed against atack, for they warm outside. Bluejackets frem Five Powers' Warships have been hurried in to rendere the defence; incre British throws: have been hurried in to reinferce the defence; more British troops are on the way from Hongikong.

From the skirmishes recorded, in one of which four of the Pun-jabl Regiment were shot by Chinese, it is to be inferred that many, have occurred. Armoured cars, probably British, have been in

Meanwhile Chinese workers have responded to the Labour Unions call of a general strike, a political move to aid the Gautonese, coincident with their appearance at the City. The strike is en-forced by the Southern gunnen who were introduced as "prepara-tion" into Shanghai. Bullets, the cable narrative records, are flying everywhere.




