The New Defence Bill.

The new Bill providing for the organization of a Defence Force in Kenya, which replaces the reserve withdrawn just before the elections, has been published for information and criticism this week in the *East African Gazette*. Yesterday we printed the statement of the full analysis of the clauses of the measure. There is no need at this late stage to repeat the history of the Bill. The proposal to create a Defence Force on a compulsory basis has been before the country nearly six years and it is two years since the consent of the Secretary of State for the Colonies was given to this principle. Publication of the original measure which had been before the Colony at intervals since 1921 gave rise towards the end of last year, to considerable criticism of principle and details and as a result of that criticism and in view of the near approach of the elections, Government withdrew the Bill. A Select Committee was appointed and reported on January 11 upon the changes which it considered to be desirable in any new legislation. 

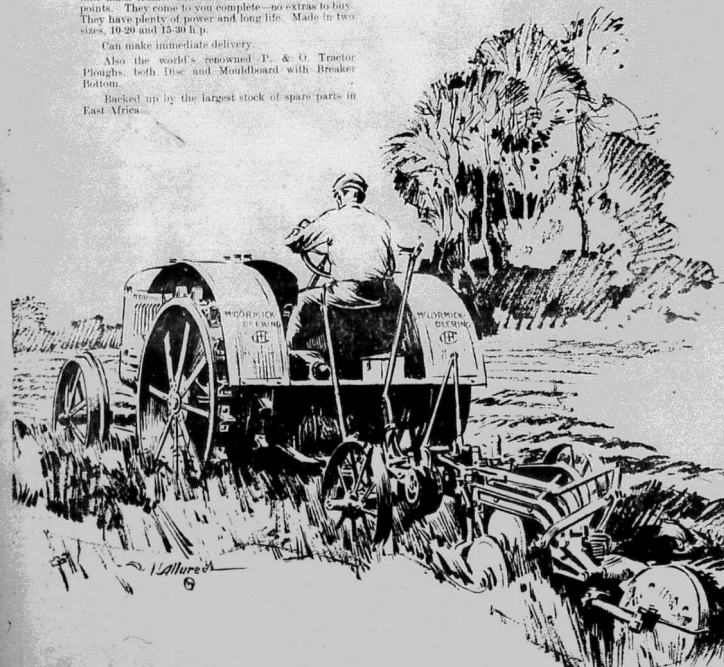

Goan Education.

At a meeting of the Goan Committee it has been decided that no action be taken, by way of a veto, to make it impossible to educate Goan children and their parents, in co-operation with the Government. It has established a primary school. Last year members of the Goan community who resisted the imposition of education opposed a movement to provide funds. With the exception of a case in which there is no special provision for Goan children and their parents, no such advantages as the Indian Government has by tradition, but by statute, religion and education. It was therefor decided in 1926 that steps should be taken to provide for the education of the children of the race in East Africa. Nambohoy accepted as the most suitable centre where a beginning could be made. The Central-General for Portugal believed that a grant should also be made to assist in obtaining from the Lisbon Government. The Department of Education in Kenya were in complete sympathy with the movement and agreed to set apart a site for a school if the Goan community would raise a sum of four or five thousand pounds to which Government would add a similar sum in order to defray capital costs. There are about 800 Goan children in Kenya and only a handful are receiving an education at all. An appeal is made to the community and its organization were established to collect funds under the name of the Board of Trustees. The fund went well, the community was enthusiastic and over 4,000 had been collected when the Education Commission proposal was made in the Legislative Council and rejected. The Goan community felt that their position was undervalued and explanations were requested from the voluntary contributions were made. Then the Government, it is reported, discovered that the Education Commission could not be applied to the Goan community, who are alien to the Colony, and they were exempted. In the meantime, Government withheld the payment of the monthly contribution which was pledged to be collected until the question of a veto had been resolved and that also the allocation of funds for Asiatic requirements would be given in the position of the Goan. That, so far as we understand it, is the position.

The recent meeting has shown an unappreciated disadvantage of the accumulation of funds and the whole scheme which promised so well and collected so great credit on the Goan has less than a year ago is now in the air. The Goan were the first in the community to assume to display practical realization of the responsibilities of a people for the education of their children. They present themselves as being called to face in the world and begin at once the accumulation of funds which will enable Government to assist in preparing a scheme. Kenya cannot afford to neglect the education of its permit children to remain uneducated but the Goan cannot neglect their own children for them if they think their own best in the work.
