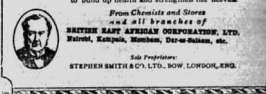

A Rhodes Commemoration.

Twenty five years have passed since Rhodes was buried in his lonely grave on the heights of the Matroospan and the crowd of men of the Albion history was too full of incidents and too near to our own time to permit of any just or even close appreciation of their importance to the Continent to which Rhodes gave his life, or to the present generation to measure his influence upon Imperial policy in Africa. Rhodes was not only a great Statesman, a great citizen of the British Empire, a great African; a quarter of a century has not dimmed the greatness of the man, his character or the crowd his name in the minds of those whose lives are laid in this country. His personal skill and suspicion is even now with us in the form of building the traditions of the Empire in Africa and in Kenya itself we have not only laid with us within recent years a Governor whose life was influenced and whose mind was inspired and guided by personal contact but we have in our present day Governor a man whose Imperial faith is founded on the line which formed the Rhodes tradition and a part of whose life has been devoted to the defence of the great Trust which Rhodes left behind him for the furtherance of the ideal of Imperial service. In the present materialistic age we may profit by a reminder of a great Imperialist who has left the stamp of his genius on British Africa and British Africa. His nomination is not served in parading stone; it is around us throughout the Continent and particularly prominent in the country which has been named after him and owes the reaction to the thought and the indelible energy of the founder of the Company which laid the basis of our modern Rhodesia. And in Rhodesia we have a model of all that is best and British in Africa, a model which East Africa, despite the somewhat dissimilar physical conditions, may study and copy with advantage to its future and the diverse people. In Rhodesia, rich with the traditions and the influence of Rhodes, British settlers are building a British Colony on Rhodesian traditions with the ideal of the Homeland and the Race to inspire and encourage them and which has been and is being done in Southern Rhodesia is but the forerunner of the success for which we are working in this country. We are not too far removed from the scene of Rhodes' labours and the influence of the unending courage of the man of single purpose of mind who is the type of the individual pioneer settler so rarely seen in Africa, as far as the example of the East African Statesman. We in East Africa have not departed very far from the main Imperial path along which his thoughts travelled half a century ago and which the scope for Empire building in the new phases of the world is now limited we can bring to the less important tasks of life, and to the greater responsibilities of civilization and leadership which have followed from the network of such men as Rhodes, the same high sense of justice with honest pride of conscience and faith in the destiny of the race which characterized his genius.

THE THORNYCROFT LORRY. A Six-wheeled Rigid Classic.

During the last few days the attention of motorists in Nairobi has been attracted to a huge six-wheeled Thornycroft transport vehicle which has been passing along the roads of the town. The vehicle has been sent to Kenya for demonstration purposes by Messrs. John J. Thornycroft & Co., of London and arrived here a day or two ago under the charge of Mr. Roger Thornycroft, a member of the firm. This lorry is the first of the type to be sent to East Africa, and it promises to supply a very distinct demand from owners who rely upon road transport for bringing their produce to the railway, particularly in parts where roads are thus considered impassable during the rainy season.

IN OTHER COUNTRIES. The Thornycroft has given remarkable satisfaction in other countries where its use has been adopted. The War Office uses the South African Railways have three on tender traffic, both freight and passenger service, while the Sudan Government has purchased a large number of use on cotton transport.

THE DRIVE. The outstanding feature of the vehicle which is responsible for its outstanding performance on bad ground, is the drive through heavy back-axles, which are attached to the frame, so that although the driving wheel on one side may be 19 inches above or below the other driving wheel on the same side, the shaft which carries the axle is in constant contact on the springs and consequently all four wheels are constantly driven.

The main and auxiliary change speed levers are so placed that it is possible to progressively use eight different ratios before the engine speed falls to a minimum of 10.25 to 1 in the forward direction, and two ratios in reverse.

LOCAL DEMONSTRATIONS. Mr. Thornycroft will be taking the vehicle through to Uganda today by road, where it will be demonstrated in that Protectorate. It is then returning to Nairobi in about three weeks time and it is expected that a number of requests for demonstration leaflets will be forwarded to Mr. Thornycroft, c/o Motor Sales, Ltd., 4, Grosvenor will be handed to him.

After a stay in Nairobi, a cross-country journey will be undertaken, Northern Rhodesia being the objective, or if necessary, Johannesburg. The Thornycroft six-wheeled rigid chassis should find a ready market in East Africa, where the question of transport of produce is a very real problem in view of the state of many of the country roads.

As an indication of the capabilities of the Thornycroft lorry, the following details of a trial carried out recently before the Government of South African Railways, should be of interest. The chassis was fitted with rough body and loaded with cement, the total weight of the chassis, body and load being 12,000 lbs. With this load the vehicle has been driven at a speed of 15 m.p.h. for 18 1/2 miles of a road which is mostly broken and unevenly surfaced.
