AGRICULTURE.

THE FINANCIAL SIDE OF DAIRYING. Farm Stock and the Land.

AN INTERESTING BULLETIN.

Dairying fits an important place among the farming industries of Kenya. An interesting 40 page bulletin has been issued by the Department of Agriculture and Veterinary Science of the Government of South Africa which deals with the question of payability.

If in our agriculture we are to compete with the other nations of the world, we must make a more efficient use of the active. 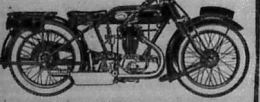

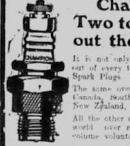

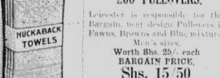

ALLEGATIONS AGAINST A BANKRUPT.

Cars on the Scrap Heap in Eldoret.

During the recent public examination in bankruptcy of Cornelius Johannes Engelbrecht, held before Mr. Justice Keatinge, the Acting Chief Justice, the following allegations regarding fraudulent suppression of information regarding his motor cars, were made:

Mr. H. Math represented the debtor and Dr. Keatinge, the Official Receiver appeared to resist the examination.

Dr. Keatinge said that the debtor had already been examined by Mr. Acting Justice Keatinge, but there were still some circumstances in connection with two motor cars, which had not been disclosed in the debtor's statement of affairs.

AN EXPANSIVE CAR.

In answer to the Chief Justice, Engelbrecht said that he arrived in Kenya in 1916 and worked as a mechanic. He had bought a motor car from the Pioneer Garage in Eldoret, which was new in Eldoret and worthless. He also bought a Hopalong car from an Italian which might be worth £10 now. He paid £120 for it, and spent £120 on improvements and it was for four months. It had been in the sun and rain for two years.

The Judge: Why was it not included in your schedule of assets?

The debtor: I don't put it in as new the Motor Corporation cars in Kenya.

The Judge: It is with his brother.

The debtor: The garage used to belong to my brother, but he sold it in 1926.

The Judge: When were you last in Malindi?

The debtor: In May of this year.

The Judge: Is the car still there?

The debtor: Yes. It is on a scrap heap behind the garage.

The Judge: Do you own it?

The debtor: Yes. I have no intention of going back and taking possession.

THE MOTOR CAR.

In answer to further questions by the Chief Justice, the debtor said that the car was being managed now by his brother, though it was his car. It had not run since 1925. There was another car there, a Gray which he had bought on the home purchase system from the Pioneer Garage, but paid £30,000 in instalments and the same will collapse. It was also standing on the Malindi scrap heap, but he bought it in August 1926.

The Judge: Who did you sell that car for your schedule?

The debtor: Because it won't run properly. It is on a scrap heap on the Pioneer system and I don't put it in the schedule.

The Judge: Yet you put the Pioneer Garage amongst your creditors?

THE DEBTOR.

THE DEBTOR: Yes.

THE FRAUD ALLEGED.

The Judge: There has been an allegation made in respect of the debtor.

The Judge asked Dr. Keatinge if he was willing that the debtor should have the proceeds of the car. Was it any, by commencing the debtor for and unless the car was worth something?

Dr. Keatinge: I don't believe a word of it. The debtor is not to be an engineer. He has a Hopalong car for £120 and spent a hundred pounds on repairs and now it is a worthless.

The Judge: It seems so certain that the debtor should put the value in his schedule and not show the asset.

The Judge: You want to say it is a clubhouse and not fraud?

Engelbrecht: Yes.

The Judge: Asked for the continuation to be adjourned until he could get his car home.

A WARNING.

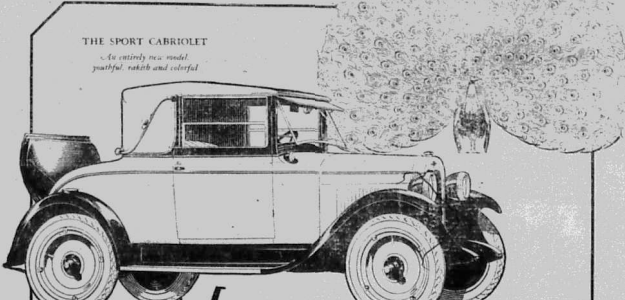
The Judge in adjournment, the debtor was warned, the latter that the car was belonged to the Official Receiver. "If you interfere with them in any way, you will be liable to go to jail on a heavy sentence. The Official Receiver says you suppressed the true state of these fraudulent cars. Don't try any hanky work. If you do not terminate the connection with the car, the Official Receiver is going to sue if they are of any value. If they are of any value, you can go back to the Official Receiver."

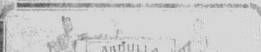

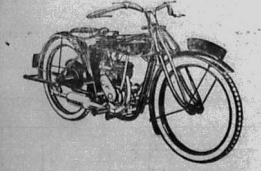
