



LORD DELAMERE OUTLINES FEDERATION PROBLEM IN PRESIDENTIAL SPEECH.

Co-ordination of All Six Territories Considered Impracticable at the Moment.

NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN GROUPS.

Delegates from North and South Rhodesia Reveal Position Regarding Amalgamation.

In his presidential address at the opening of the on Monday Lord Delamere focussed his views on the problem of Federation which, he said, could no longer be disposed of by pious resolutions but was an issue which must be faced

For reasons which he gave, he believed it to be im-practicable to apply any scheme of co-ordination to the whole of the territories in East Africa, but he regarded some form of closer union between Kenya, Uganda and Tanganyika in the North and between Nyasaland and the Rhodesias in the South as an essential first step without in any way losing sight of the larger aim of the creation of a great self-governing Dominion from the Limpopo to the Nile.

He dealt in considerable detail with the safeguards He dealt in considerable detail with the safeguards laid down in the Elected Members Manifesto at the last General Election in Kenya, making it quite clear that these asfeguards were not necessarily an indi-cation of a narrow Kenya view but were safeguards which, in his opinion, were necessary even to the weakest State.
