



THE cheapest form of Silo is the trench and it preserves the fodder as effectively as the more elaborate kinds.

A trench silo, 8 feet wide at the bottom, 12 feet wide at the top and 8 feet deep, at 25 pounds of silage per cubic foot, would hold one ton to each foot in length or 50 tons if 50 feet long.

M ARK out the surface dimensions of the silo loosen the earth with a single furrow plough; follow behind with a dam scoop and tip the earth a little beyond the longest ends of the trench. Continue backwards and forwards until the depth Continue backwards and forwards until the depth is too great for both implements, then shape the sides with jembes and continue excavating until the required depth is reached. 




