



SELECT COMMITTEE APPOINTED.

The debate on the second reading of the Domestic Servante Registration Bill which took place in the Legislative Council on Sept. 13 revealed the not un-serpected cleavage of opinion which exists—not only the solid opposition of the Indian members but a split in the ranks of the European Elected Members.

The line of least resistance has been followed again—the Bill has been referred to a Select Committee of Council which was announced at the end of private discussions among members overnight on the subject of its composition.

The Committee is: The Colonial Secretary (Chairman), The Attorney General, The Chief Native Commissioner, Colonel Durham, Capt. F. O. B. Wilson, Mr. A. C. Tannahill, Mr. Pandya, and Camon Leakey.

It is a balanced Committee in so far as known views are concerned—almost equally divided, in fact—and it seems unlikely at the moment that the Report will be a unanimous one.


