footholds in the hard snow with his stockinged feet. On reaching Major Min-chinton, Lieut. Smith made a sledge of his cost and, ac-some named by the injured to move, proceeded to lower Major Minchinton over the freezing snow until the de-scent was checked by the roughness of the snow.

After covering Major Minchinton with his cost Minchinton with his coat, Lieut. Smith descended to a fire that was seen burning below the glacier where he found Mrs. Minchinton and party of men.
