APPROACHING CONSIDERATION OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGES.

Although two months have elapsed since H. E. Sir Edward Grigg reported upon his visit to London and reviewed some of the constitutional issues facing Kenya and requiring consideration in preparation for the arrival of a Royal Commission, there has been a strange absence of expression of public opinion and no leadership in thought.

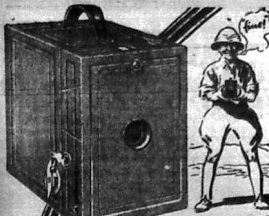

DISASTER OVERTAKES THE "PELICAN" AGAIN.

Crash During Test Flight at Kisumu.

For the fourth time disaster has overtaken the East African air mail. The news was conveyed to the Secretariat in the following telegraphic message from Captain Gladstone: "Pelican met with accident at Kisumu this morning during practice flight. No one hurt. Letter follows to-day's mail giving details."

At the same time the B.E.A. Corporation, Nairobi agents for the North Sea Aerial Transport Company received the following telegram: "New pilot crashed 'Pelican' landing test flight Kisumu. No one hurt. Inform all concerned Nairobi."

The Postmaster-General also received a message from Captain Gladstone which gave the additional information that the mail from London had been landed safely before the accident occurred.

The "Standard" is informed by the postal authorities that in view of the accident no air mails will be despatched until further notice.

Damage Not Repairable at Kisumu.

Regarding the accident to the "Pelican" reported on Tuesday, the following telegram has been received from the "Standard" correspondent at Kisumu: "Capt. Gladstone landed safely and delivered the mail. The new pilot on a trial trip landed unskilfully on the 'Pelican' which is not repairable here. Capt. Gladstone arriving Nairobi to-morrow morning."

"An evil fate seems to pursue the East African air mail. It will be recalled that the first disaster occurred when the "Pelican" at the very outset of its career struck a submerged obstacle in the River Nile and was suspended for many months. A substitute machine was damaged during meeting operations at Mombasa. The third accident occurred when the substitute airplane fell in Lake Victoria at Kisumu. The "Pelican" was recently recommissioned and it was the intention to carry out a test series of six survey flights. One of these had been successfully accomplished and Kisumu had been reached on the second flight when, as indicated in the message given above, the fourth crash occurred.

Raid on Leopards. A leopard hunt has been organized at Nandi, Uganda, to reduce the number of these pests which are doing much damage to the natives and are also a nuisance to the country.

DEDICATION OF CHURCH FOR CHILDREN.

Simple Ceremony on Sunday.

An interesting and impressive service was held on Sunday last on the occasion of the opening and consecration of the newly erected Children's Church, by the Bishop of Mombasa, assisted by the Rev. Fr. Fita, Ambrose Swann and Dr. Gorman.

By 9 a.m. a crowd of some 75 or 80 children and also a large number of parents and other adults assembled outside the doors of the pretty little church, which is situated a short distance from the Kabete Road.

"Those who had not seen the progress of the Church and who only remembered the laying of the foundation stone some four months ago by Lady McMillan were surprised at the beauty of the little building and the care and thought which had been given to the erection of it had been roomy, finished. It is built of wood, with a tile roof and a stone floor. The interior is very neat and the features of the church suit the varying ages of the congregation.

The Service.

The service began with the singing of the hymn "O Jesus, Christ, My Lord and My King" by the children and the Bishop of Mombasa.

The ceremony of the opening of the door was performed by Master John Decker, who stood on the large block of wood in order that he might insert the key, turned it and pushed the door open. Master Decker was presented by the Bishop with a Prayer Book as a memento of the performance of his first public function by the Bishop of Mombasa.

The Dedication.

A prayer led by the Bishop and repeated by the congregation followed by the prayer of dedication. The Clergy then proceeded into the Church and pronounced the benediction. The children took seats in the seats and the adults who were very anxious to find seats, stood round the walls and outside in the porch.

The hymn "Praise the Good Lord" was then sung to the tune of "St. Matthew's", 12-16, as read by De Gorman.

The first two verses of the hymn "There is a Friend for little children" were read, and the last two verses concluded the prayer of consecration delivered by the Bishop of Mombasa.

A Message.

In a short address, the Bishop referred to the many kind friends who had contributed their work and gifts to the making of the Church, and expressed the hope that the Church would be helpful not only to the children of the district but also to the whole people who, living some distance from another Church, find it difficult to worship elsewhere. Referring to the story to be found in the 11 chapter of St. Luke's gospel of Christ's visit to the Temple when He was 12 years old, the Bishop said that the children that this Church was "Our Father's Home" which should be watched them to carry away, that they must also show in their own homes that they wanted to do His Will.

Traces.

TREATING CRIME AS A FORM OF DISEASE.

The Government has asked to consider the establishment of a new form of crime, the crime of habit, which would cover those persons who, by their conduct, cause serious damage to the community and who are not subject to ordinary penalties.

The move of the original motion would not accept this amended motion while Commander Cole also said it is as a direct result of the Chairman, however, as it is a private matter and it is as amended by Dr. Deming that it is really more suitable to the severe nature of the crime. He could not see that it should cover the liberty of the individual whether his colour or race is the more of another individual without appeal.

Mr. Hanbury suggested "with a view of the original motion and the original amendment. He said that the proposal amounted to taking the matter out of hands of judges and putting it into the hands of medical specialists. It was much too big a question to be debated by people who had not been brought up to take.

Commander Cole rejected the suggestion that he had not given thought to the motion. He suggested that the position might be met by the passing of an Habitual Offenders Act, under which the whole idea was to prevent the country from being swarmed by habitual criminals who were a danger to the community. He said that people should be looked up until they had shown that they had become habitual offenders.

Captain Montagu spoke against the motion and said that he was not in favour of the proposal. He said that the proposal was a very serious one and that it was not one that should be taken lightly.

KEEPING LABOUR FIGURES UP TO DATE.

Correction Request to Government.

The Convention of Associations has expressed the opinion that steps should be taken by Government to keep the work of the revised Labour Commission up to date.

On Monday morning, Capt. M. S. Montagu, on behalf of the Kenya District Farmers Association, presented the following resolution:

"That this Convention is of opinion that the Government having gone to the expense of collecting important data with reference to the labour requirements of and supply for the various industries of the Colony; the work of the Labour Commission should be kept up to date either by the Statisticians or other Officers, in close touch with the Association, and adjustments made of the data as experience will teach to be necessary."

He declared that the object of the revised Commission had only been met and could not be completely attained until some body or person in the country, probably the Statisticians Office, settled down to show the figures and by keeping the position up to date and so how they had been made under or over estimated.

The Hon. Conway Harvey seconded. He said it would be thought desirable to compile the revised figures if after the amount of the revised figures had been taken into account.

The Labour situation in Kenya changed suddenly and with alarming rapidity and in order that they might follow a correct policy in dealing with the situation arising

at any moment it was vitally necessary that they should have actual figures which that policy should be based.

Mr. A. C. CAR HELD UP BY A LIONESS.

Motorists Forced to Make a Detour.

How a party of motorists were held up on the road between Ngora and Koyula by an angry lioness which stood in the roadway apparently hesitating whether or not to attack is told in the following story of the experience related by Mr. W. Bookan-Smith of Arusha.

"I left Nairobi for Arusha with two cars at 6.30 a.m. on the 6th instant accompanied by my wife, our two little boys and an older son, and Mr. Smith.

Both cars stopped and the lioness looked at one car and then at the other as if undecided which one to tackle. I wanted to shoot her but my son opposed this, saying I would only get into trouble.

The lioness followed crawling and sprang and leaping herself with her tail. At times she was within five yards of us. I was very anxious to shoot but my son restrained me.

"At last we got out of the ruts and made a detour pastward, within 15 yards of her. She watched us and we were past and then walked slowly down the road, apparently trying to get up to a point. It was some time to the conclusion that she had but had been there some and was trying to find him. She was in a very bad and dangerous mood and it would have been very unpleasant for anyone to see her face or to be scratched or even to have her hair as she has been seen the spot to climb. We heard from a party that we met that she had been shot in a bad spot and that another party had been chased by her.

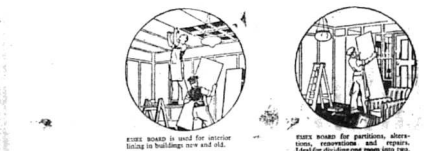
