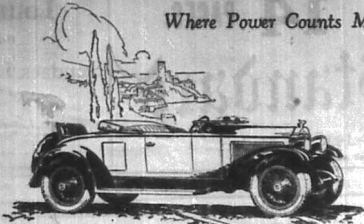

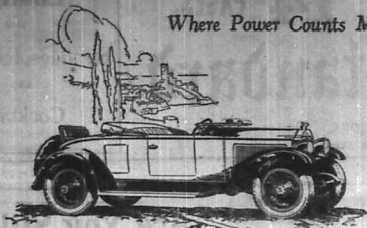

AN ADDRESS MADE TO EASTLEIGH.

Why Town Council Can Not Approve It.

WATER DIFFICULTY.

At a meeting of the Nairobi Town Council held on Tuesday, it was reported that letters had been submitted to the Works Committee from the Hon. Colonial Secretary asking that Council should approve an access road to Eastleigh, in which the Government would contribute £1,000, and say anything in excess of this should be borne by the Council, this meaning that the access of this line was apparently not intended to proceed with the proposed Town Planning sub-division of the area, which if carried into effect would automatically provide access roads to Eastleigh.

It was recalled to recommend that the Nairobi Council are not interested in any access road to Eastleigh, which would involve a private estate, without road to the owners of same, and after the construction of such a road maintenance of same is not provided for except out of Council funds.

Further from the Council point of view, close development of Eastleigh is not at the moment desirable in view of the fact that only a very limited water supply—if any—can be given, as the Council have the greatest difficulty in supplying the present one with water and have some time ago been compelled to discontinue supplies to outside areas.

The access road to Eastleigh, as set out in the "Road Two" programme and numerous important roads, in the foregoing, require urgent attention.

Minister for Native Lands.

NEW SUGGESTION IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS.

A suggestion has appeared in some quarters recently that in the case of Kenya native reserves should be administered by a Minister of Native Affairs appointed by the Crown.

Mr. E. B. South (Lab. Party) on December 12, asked the Under-Secretary of State for the Colonies whether he has received any representations that in the case of Kenya Colony, lands reserved for natives should be administered by a Minister of Native Affairs appointed by the Crown, and if so, whether he proposes to take any action in the matter?

Mr. Omsley-Gore: The answer to the first part of the question is in the negative.

"Definitely" Hasi.

COLONIAL OFFICE ASKS FOR SPECIFIC REFERENCES.

Labour Members of the House of Commons are still worried by the "definitely" status of the Masai, arising out of the recent report concerning the Masai and the Colonial Office have promised to investigate specific cases.

In the House of Commons on December 22 Mr. E. B. South (Lab. Party) asked the Under-Secretary of State for the Colonies if he is aware that members of the Masai tribe in Kenya have been treated and rewarded by the Government which he has been deprived of their fishing spaces; and if he will reconsider this decision?

Mr. Omsley-Gore: I followed the hon. member for Westwood (Mr. South), in reply to a question on the 22nd November, that I had no reason to suppose that this exercise of authority in respect of one of the Masai tribes had led to the consequences suggested, but if the hon. Member can supply me with specific instances I will make the necessary inquiries to be made of the Governor.

Mr. A. Hinchman (Ind. Member): Will the hon. Gentleman make representations to the Foreign Office so that they may draw the attention of the Proprietary Commission at Geneva, to the unfortunate facts alleged in this question?

No reply was given.

S. West Africa.

ADMINISTRATION OF THE CAPRIVI STRIP.

Mr. Hoare (Lab.) Edgely, asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies whether the Caprivi strip of South-West Africa is still being administered by the Bechuanaland Government; and on whom devolves the responsibility of reporting upon the administration of this territory to the League of Nations?

The Prime Minister (Mr. Baldwin), in answering this question said it should have been addressed to the Secretary of State for Dominion Affairs. The Caprivi strip is still administered by the southern part of the Bechuanaland Protectorate, but the responsibility for submitting reports upon the administration of this area to the League of Nations rests with His Majesty's Government in the Transvaal. South Africa is the mandatory for South-West Africa.

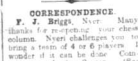

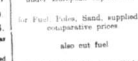
