Sir Edward Grigg on Significance of the Uganda Extension.

VALUE OF CO-OPERATION.

His Excellency on the Marital Relationship of Kenya and Uganda.

His Excellency Sir Edward Grigg, speaking not only as Governor of Kenya but as High Commissioner for Transvaal, made a notable speech at the official luncheon held in celebration of the linking up of Uganda by rail with the Indian Ocean.

The value of co-operation not only between countries but amongst people of different races was stressed and the Railway was instanced as one way in which that co-operation had worked to good effect.

Touching lightly on the question of the relations between Kenya and Uganda, His Excellency pointed out that in several directions they had interests in common because of the services which were shared by both.

Sir Edward Grigg stressed his view that there could be no form of closer union between East African territories in the future which did not provide for equal partnership.

MOTORING TOPICS

THE BATTERY.

Points to be Observed for Efficiency.

THE COMPONENT PARTS.

The storage battery may seem to be an unimportant matter, but in most of the present-day cars it is most important, and its failure will stop the car at once.

There are three main types of storage battery for the current-day ignition system. If the battery is dead, the engine will not start unless one of the gasoline tanks was empty.

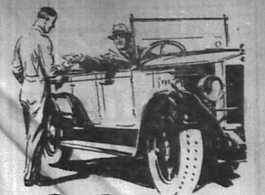

A Bishop's Visit.

Since writing my last "Notes," His Lordship the Bishop of Mauritius has paid Seychelles a pastoral visit. There are for instance, a must be confessed, the last one having been in 1920. In London he found that Seychelles had been unknown to the average man, then Mauritius, which—though it has been British for more than a century—is still regarded by some as being a part of France. Perhaps, Paul of Tarsus, that sentimentally-voiced but of elevated address, may have filed in many of the lines that Mauritius is still French.

AIR LEAKS.

Cases Lack of Engine Balance.

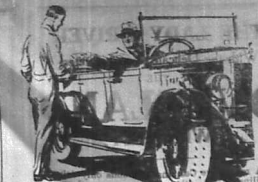
THE SYMPTOM.

Clearly akin to the matter of back-firing is that of air leaks, which upsets the operation of the engine. All leaks in the mixture pipe and manifold and pressure to the valve ports upset the mixture and cause mis-firing and imbalance of the engine.

Leaks in the exhaust pipe and the valve may be and about leaks in the joining of the cylinder head, that in close contact with the gasket, will cause the blow-out affect the power of the engine in two ways. It reduces some of the expanding power which drive down the piston, but it also allows air to enter on the suction stroke, upsetting the mixture balance of the engine and causing erratic running with mis-firing on one or more cylinders. Air leaks in the induction system make for erratic running, and much loss of power, and the symptoms are often wrongly attributed to carburetor mis-adjustment.

HINDING NOISE.

Generally, air leaks have an accompaniment by a slight hissing noise which may be detected if the car is in the induction pipe. The points of the induction manifold should be re-made with well varnished washers, which will seal the joint. But this plan must be quite fast and may have been distorted by trying to open the joint with a cold chisel.

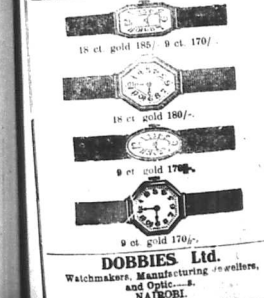

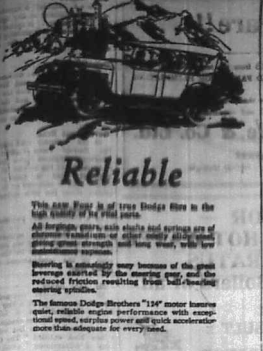
