**DEATH OF FIELD-MARSHAL EARL HAIG**

SUDDEN PASSING OF A NATIONAL HERO.

Distinguished Career of Britain's Premier Soldier.

Field Marshal Earl Haig, the greatest British figure in the field during the last war died suddenly in London on Monday.

Only on Saturday Earl Haig who was, however, looking ill, went specially to Richmond from Scotland to attend a highly decorated ceremony where, in a brief speech, he displayed the deep patriotism and high sense of public duty which were among his chief characteristics.

Addressing the boys he said: "Always remember you belong to a great Empire and when people speak disrespectfully of England, stand up and defend your country."

Since his retirement from active service Earl Haig has devoted practically the whole of his time to the welfare of ex-soldiers and their dependants.

Earl Haig's last public utterance showed his deep love for his country. Speaking on Saturday at the centenary anniversary of the Battle of Marston, Earl Haig (then) Viscount of Eglar, said: "I have died as a soldier, but I have lived as a citizen."

Earl Haig was pale on Saturday when, accompanied by his wife, he went to the hospital. He was not to return, but he only spoke for a few minutes.

They had travelled from Scotland to London to attend the funeral of the late Lord Haig.

**The Speed Limit.**

Government has issued a "compromise" on the subject of speed limits for Nairobi and in doing so will give satisfaction to moderate minded people who, even at slight inconveniences, are prepared to co-operate with authority in maintaining the safety of life and property. The reversal of the Government's decision of the Executive Council has also been a recognition of the status of the Nairobi Town Council and strengthens their claim to representation of public opinion. The effect of the agreement which has been reached, and which will now be worked out in detail, is to apply a speed limit of 25 m.p.h. to the whole Municipal area and a 15 m.p.h. limit to the congested commercial area and to specified dangerous corners and roads. No 30 m.p.h. zone will be declared in Nairobi, but it is anticipated that the new public business in Kenya however long and thorough may have been the preliminary. 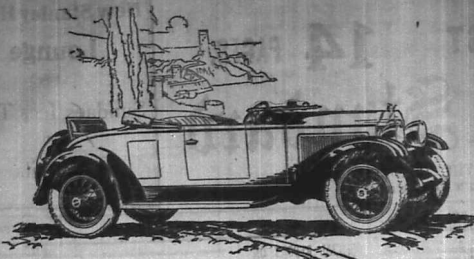

### PROGRESS OF FIRING IN EAST AFRICA.

#### AERO CLUB ACTIVITIES.

#### Schemes for Creating Air Defence Force.

#### Donorship and Handicap Race at Nairobi Meeting.

The first Annual General Meeting of the Aero Club of Kenya was held in the Lyceum Hall on Tuesday, December 1, Mansfield Robinson presiding.

In opening the meeting the chairman expressed his regret at the absence of the President of the club, Col. Harbo, who had been unable to attend. The programme of the Club had been very satisfactory, no offers having been made to push forward aviation in the Colony.

The Government of the Colony were now beginning to take notice of the Club, and legislation which it was proposed to introduce for the control of aviation in the Colony had been submitted to the Club and had now been returned with comments and recommendations attached. This course had been adapted as there were as yet no officials who were qualified to advise the Government on these matters.

The chairman referred briefly to the arrival in Kenya of certain machines which were the property of members of the Club.

There were two events of particular importance to the Club, one of which had taken place and the other which was due to take place within a short time. The former of these was Mr. Carberry's very fine flight from England to Kenya and the latter was Sir Alan Cobham's coming that to the Aero Club regarding the first aviation machine to be held in Kenya, which would take shape at Nairobi. Although in view of the small number of machines it would not be possible to have a very small meeting, it was hoped that by the introduction of some hand-dropping, possibly a short handicap race, and a few minor stunts it would be found possible to make it interesting. The main attraction of all would be Sir Alan Cobham's display in one

of the best modern machines in the world.

#### Air Defence Force.

Interest in an Air Defence Force, an opportunity had now been presented to the Club, and it was pointed out that the Government had been shown with respect to the Government of Kenya that all advantages would be taken of the opportunity. It was stated that machines were able to operate in a minimum cost.

The minutes of the last meeting which were in the possession of members were then taken as read.

#### Past and Future.

The Hon. Secretary in his report reviewed the steps which had led to the formation of the Club and spoke of the satisfactory membership which at the end of the year. Five months after the Club's formation, about 200, those of whom 120 new members had been elected.

The report continued: "Local representatives have been organized in a number of places throughout Kenya, Uganda, Tanganyika and Zanzibar. All these gentlemen report that great interest is being displayed for the Club in their districts and there is every indication that in the near future local Committees will be formed in all the important towns."

Information is being obtained regarding suitable aerodrome sites and landing grounds throughout East Africa and when these investigations are completed it is hoped that the sites selected will be allocated for the purpose.

In this way a chain of aerodromes and landing grounds pervades the continent. The first of these at Nairobi is now in operation. In this connection I would say that the selection of aerodromes is not such a simple matter as it might appear on first sight. Quite apart from getting the necessary facilities in the way of the necessary facilities, area and enough level ground—local topography has to be studied in connection with meteorological conditions. As an example it is nearly possible for a small broken range of hills to cause an accumulation of air, and leading to a really dangerous situation in all but very slight pilots.

Aerodromes have now been completed with the Shell Company of East Africa for the installation. (Continued on page 6).

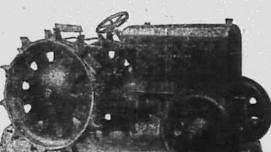
