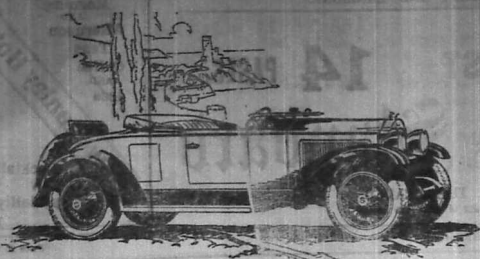

Miss A. C. Franklin, Secretary, The Society for the Overseas Recruitment of British Women, has written to the following effect:

From several sources in East Africa we have been informed that a number of semi-trained nurses have been offered to the Government by lack of employment due to long-term qualifications. Our field secretaries have asked us to state emphatically that there is no opening in East Africa for any nurse unless she is fully trained and holds her C.M.N. certificate.

and we are desired in the interests of women intending to work in East Africa, to state this warning loudly and clearly as possible.

Moreover, it is considered desirable that there is fully qualified nurses to arrive to go to Kenya, and that has resulted some delay in the offer of employment. We should like to add this information regarding prospects of employment can always be obtained from the Nurses Section of the Society, through which also applications in the East under the Association have recently been filled for the early part of 1928, but we are prepared to consider applications from candidates for future vacancies.

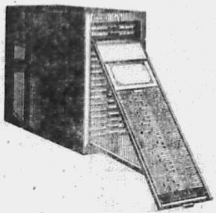

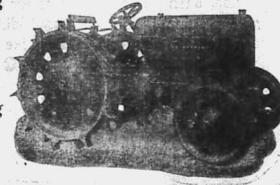

**THE AMATEUR OWNER.  
How to Start One's Own Workshop.**

**PRactical HINTS.**

A great amount of pleasure can be obtained from one's own workshop apart from its utility and the satisfaction it affords when it comes to carrying out various jobs and improvements in connection with the car. The average motorist desires a part of the garage for workshop purposes; unfortunately, the available space is often limited, but where there's a will there's a way, and room for a bench can be generally found somewhere.

The bench must be firmly and there should be a good stout post under the vice-mounting 4 feet by 4 inches in not too much. Many motorists have to work with something less well made and good work can be done on a light 360 lbs. of screws. It is clear that only light work corresponding to the equipment can be carried out.

The height of the bench is rather a matter of individual taste. It is usually about 30 in. or a little over. The top of the vice-mounting should be about on a level with the elbow-joint of the worker to assure comfortable use of it and the ends of the sides of the vice to be level across the height of the jaw, and a 4-in. one will be ample width, but the bench must be sufficiently strong to accommodate it. This is the case generally used in garages and is recommended. The most available size, 4 1/2 in. is also generally used. It is sufficient big to take almost every job that comes the way of a car owner. The 4-in. vice will suit small work, but, in my opinion, is something of a toy, and makes no much like an amateur's tool. It may be the best of screws, and a good vice will last a lifetime. ### SUGGESTED PUBLIC SCHOOL AT NYERI.

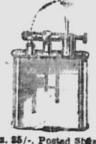

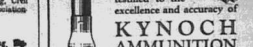

MORALS.

Public School Where It  
is "In Charge."

TRUCK REPORT.

A famous public school "where  
heat is given to every and fre-  
quently appears at supper within  
two or three hours of tea" was  
mentioned at the Conference of  
Educational Associations at Uni-  
versity College, London.

Mr. Charles L. Heath, speaking  
on "The Influence of Institutional  
Houses, Hospitals, and a New Center  
for Women," gave this school as  
an instance of the kind for reform.  
"Sunniness, cold meat, and  
cigarette fumes on the terrace,"  
said Mr. Heath, "though quite  
unavoidable for boys, some of whom  
own their own beds. Food of this  
kind makes possible the good health  
now for good work."

He quoted Dr. Walter Kennedy as  
stating that "Doctors would be  
amazed if they knew how often  
inexpensive, unadorned, but  
how often appointed with as  
surprised in mind. The dietary  
regime of the workhouse is often  
superior to that of the public  
schools."

"My indignation is aroused by  
the provisions of the school,"  
he wrote a parent. "These  
boys after twelve noon, go there  
and obtain unseasoned, egg-sal-  
adous, etc., and then wonder  
why, when I do arrive, they have  
no appetite for dinner."

"The Rev. G. A. Stubbins,  
Kennedy's "Woodhouse. Wilton's  
deplains to the King, penance at  
St. Mary Abbots, in con-  
nection with the annual meet-  
ing of the Incorporated Association  
of Headmasters, suggested that  
religion was the real "Cinderella"  
in the educational curriculum of  
the modern world at present."

"Dully Condemned"

"I am very sincerely I have  
visited," he said, "the school that  
is least respected and least re-  
spectable and the most uneduca-  
tional and least dignified I have  
ever visited, and in some of the best  
universities that Cambridge has  
been destroyed and put of the  
map altogether."

"I think it is partly because, in  
the matter of religious opinion and  
the cause of religious belief, educa-  
tionalists are at a loss to know  
how to deal with anything they can

handle in the nature of religion  
which will be useful. The pro-  
cesses of religion are so obscure  
rather than the educationalists."

When the conference was re-  
sumed in the afternoon, Mr. Wash-  
burn closed, in an address on "The  
Position of German in English  
Secondary Schools," stressed the  
great importance of a knowledge  
of German in modern life, and said  
that we could not afford to neglect  
it if the Empire were to hold its  
own.

"In spite of what may be said  
by people whose only aim is to  
"Victims," we are proud of our girls

Miss H. B. Wolmerley, of Bir-

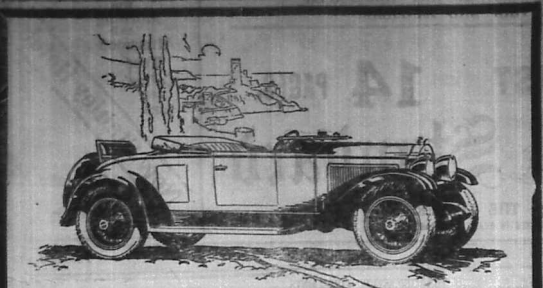

### BRITISH TRADE IN EAST AFRICA

#### American Competition in Machinery Group.

#### MR. KING'S REVIEW

Mr. C. Kemp, the British Trade Commissioner in America, in a report to the trade committee of East Africa for 1932-33 (issued by the Department of Overseas Trade), makes this report to the effect that manufacturing the heavy machinery of American origin has not been hindered. The interest was largely concerned by offers of gift credits to stimulate the replacement of foreign supplies, but largely owing to the decrease in offers of long credits, the rising price under of American manufacturers, the response in many cases of obtaining firm offers of delivery and, more than all, the fact of continually increasing replacement prices. Great Britain has regained some of the market which was lost.

Naturally the efforts of the British and other nations for some time the progress of British manufacturers, and competition from Continental sources, particularly Germany and Italy, is always to be expected in the long run, with heavy machinery, and in some cases with the East African Departments, which are developing rapidly and where the cost of firm and metal requirements has not much to do with the scale of possible profits upon agricultural products. Particular mention should be made of the light rail import.

#### Transport Policy

Labour difficulties, the growing mechanization of agricultural industry, and the growing or re-capitalization of estates are providing an increasing opening for all modern means of obviating the cost of transport from the nearest point on the general transport system. The general policy in certain parts of the area, but particularly in Kenya and Uganda, is very largely to encourage all means of cheap transport of exports even at the expense of high rates upon imported goods.

Again British manufacturers have more than succeeded in maintaining their share of the trade in railway hardware and instruments, and again largely at Continental expense. There has been some development, however, in
