Thirty Years Contribution to Political History. A GREAT SOCIAL REFORMER.

A Brilliant Career Overwhelmed by Deluge of War.

The death has occurred of the Earl of Oxford and Asquith at the age of 73.

He was the last of the Gladstonian Liberal school and for nearly 30 years played an increasingly important part in the political history of Great Britain.

At the outbreak of the War, Mr. Asquith (as he was better known) was Prime Minister and his famous speech at Edinburgh when he declared that Britain would not sheath the sword until her great mission was accomplished will go down in history as one of the supreme declarations of the age of world upheaval.

NATIONAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IMPROVING

The subject of the Bill under the Motor Traffic Ordinance was again discussed at Thursday's meeting of the National Chamber of Commerce, and it was stated that a letter which had been received from the Government had now settled the points which had been discussed.

The Secretary reported that the Sub-Committee of the Chamber had cut and a copy of their report had been forwarded to the Colonial Secretary together with a request that an interview might be granted. This matter is being dealt with by the Secretary before April 20. In addition it was stated that it was not proposed to take any action regarding the painting of pedestrians on motor lorries before February 29, nor regarding drivers before April 20. In addition an amendment which appeared at the point of confusion on the subject of bus body cars and motor lorries had appeared in the Official Gazette on January 17.

Mr. J. J. Kerr (Ballistic Transport Coy) suggested that consideration might be given to the point regarding the speed motor lorries going long distances out of town. When a lorry was travelling right out "in the blue" there was no reason why it should not exceed a speed of 20 m.p.h. It is desired whether people would be penalised on this account as he thought it would be very difficult to catch them.

Mr. J. A. Wood (Master, Ballistic Transport Coy) said that the idea of the speed limit was that it was essential to have a reasonable limit. If one person was found speeding regularly they would be tackled but he did not think that even in town everyone would have to run down to a low limit of 15 m.p.h. That was the official limit and if it was exceeded a person must know the exact conditions under which they exceeded it. The limit was imposed at a reasonable rate that the conditions of race.



SIR E. HILTON YOUNG ON COMMISSION'S WORK.

Influence of the Mandate on Closer Union.

REPLY TO MOMBASA CRITICISM.

Financial Matters Not the Primary Object of the Investigations.

In an interview with the "East African Standard" on social aspects of the work of the Closer Union Commission, the Chairman Sir E. Hilton Young expressed the view that any country entering into Closer Union with Tanganyika must understand that Tanganyika is bound by the Mandate.

THE NATIVE POINT OF VIEW.

By E. Hilton Young, the Chairman of the Closer Union Commission.

As the position of Tanganyika in the British Empire under the mandate, said Sir E. Hilton Young, "Of course, now we have more than the mere name of the Pungu Club who has studied the reports of the Commission and reads his newspaper. Of course, we have all read the report prepared by the Commission and the State on the subject, which explains the higher standard of living."

As to the hearing of this question upon our inquiry, that we be determined by suitable and on terms of reference from which it is seen that we are concerned with questions of suitable administrative policy, the future of the Colonial constitutions, and the welfare of the native races but political and economic matters.

The Mandate.

Sir Hilton Young was asked whether the Mandate might be regarded as a restrictive influence upon each of the Governments in relation to territories adjacent to Tanganyika.

He replied: "The fact that Tanganyika is a Mandated Territory is a factor in our system. We have to keep in mind the limitations imposed by the terms of the Tanganyika Mandate, the Commission of Enquiry and the Government of the United Kingdom."

As a point of interest, Sir E. Hilton Young mentioned that the Commission had been informed of the amount of land being proposed for lease in Mombasa, and that it had been found that the amount of land proposed for lease was not in excess of the amount available for lease in Mombasa.

When it was suggested that the Commission had been practically finished his investigation in Kenya, he might be prepared to say that the Commission had not yet finished its work in Kenya.

The complete stamping out of leprosy within the next ten years is proclaimed in the annual report of the British Empire Leprosy Relief Association.

This will be accomplished by the use of hydrosyrus oil, difficulties in connection with the treatment having been overcome.

Steps will be taken to plant the hydrosyrus tree extensively in suitable countries throughout the Empire and already thousands of seeds have been distributed in Uganda.

SEEDS SENT TO UGANDA.

London, Feb. 19. Sir Leonard Rogers the lecturer at the London School of Tropical Hygiene and the famous author of the book "The Leprosy of the Tropics" has announced that the demand for oil seeds for the purpose of planting the hydrosyrus tree has been so great that 100,000 seeds have been sent out in the past three months, while 100,000 more are being prepared in some of the tropical countries.

The cost of manufacture is half a penny for a year's supply but a few more of seeds will be sent out free of charge to the countries where the disease is prevalent.

From Millions Severely.

The Imperial and Dominion Governments are actively engaged in the work of stamping out the disease, and it is hoped that the epidemic which has been spreading in the British Empire will be completely eradicated.

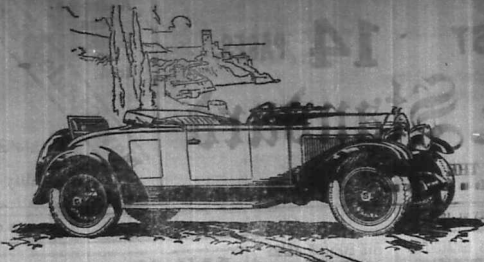

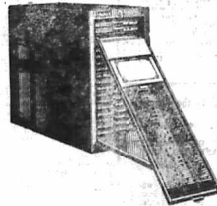
