Description of the 20/60 Model.

The 20/60 h.p. Vauxhall is a great improvement on the predecessor the 14/40 and the amazing success of the Vauxhall. The chassis has six cylinders and four speeds. This model was designed before the outbreak with General Motors was made, and is therefore, in construction, and in plan British. The chassis has two bearings, and the engine largely accounts for the stiffness with which the engine runs, even at high speed.

The bore and stroke are 75mm. and 110mm. which give a capacity of 2700 c.c. The valves are overhead and are worked by light cast roller stems, which, in turn, are worked by steel springs, and attention of clearance is made by threaded bolts, with lockwashers in the roller shaft and bearing from the end of the valve stem. 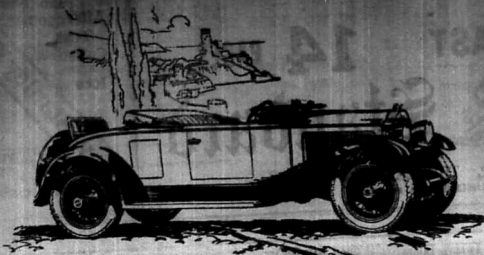

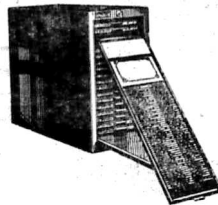

Dealing with the dear money in Kenya, the Chief Native Commissioner in his annual report after remarking upon the fact that the 1925 year had been one of the Conference of East African Governors continues:

"The dual policy of development which Kenya embarked upon early in 1925 received the support of the Conference of East African Governors. The success of this just and progressive policy is indicated firstly by the general upward rise in the quantity and value of native exports, especially with the large increase in the numbers of native producers of official classifications for whose sales the revenue during the years 1922 to 1925, and especially for the remarkable signs of increased prosperity which are apparent on every hand.

It is hoped that so far from leading towards depression as native critics sometimes allege, the policy will have the effect of bringing into native communities improved knowledge caused by the stimulus in the course of their employment, while any tendency on the part of the trading community to challenge the authority of the Government's official base should be kept in check by the constant presence of national Government which has been secured under the Native Authority Ordinance to Local Native Councils."

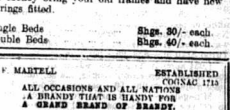

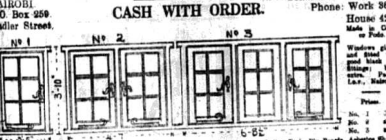

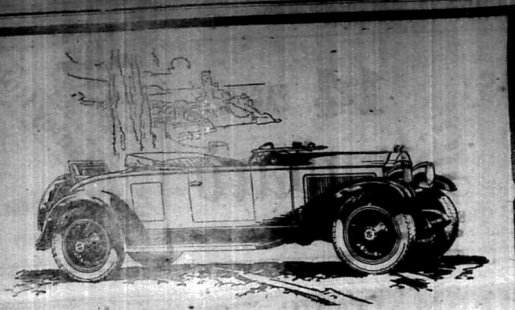

BRAKE TESTING.
Tackling Problem of Bad Adjustments.

AN AMERICAN DEVICE.

Although the general adoption of four-wheel braking has led to increased safety, particularly on steep roads, it is a reduction in the average stopping distance from given speeds, it has undoubtedly at the same time intensified the problem of brake adjustments. It is a difficult matter even for an expert mechanic to adjust the brakes on each of four wheels that the retarding force produced will be exactly proportional, because scientific means for measuring the forces are usually entirely lacking.

Easily Method to Common Use.

One method, for example, is to jack up the axle, place a block between the pedal and the seat to hold the pedal down and test the extent of brake application by pulling round each wheel in turn to see how far the pedal will move. This method cannot be said to give very good results. In the first place the mere jacking of the axle introduces a factor not present on the road, and by taking the load off the wheel bearings may result in an inaccurate adjustment of the brakes should these bearings have become worn. This, again, in pulling round a one-side wheel, the mechanic uses his right hand, whereas in testing an off-side wheel he uses his left hand, so that it is almost impossible for him to judge when the brake is spring exactly on the two wheels. Another point is that in any run the

driver cannot pull the wheel round if it is applied to the pedal more than about 10 per cent. of the total braking force which can be applied on the road, and it has been proved that when the brake is equipped, using only a flow of the total effort, it does not follow that they will be equivalent when the maximum effort is applied.

The same remark applies with even greater force when the brake is not adjusted by turning correspondingly and leaving the corresponding drum outside dead so soon as the shoe makes contact. The idea is then to slack back each wheel to the extent of three or four millimetres, but here there is a substantial guarantee that when the pedal is fully exerted the brakes will be proportionally equal because of the taking up of backlash and the setting in the various rods and levers.

The subject is receiving particular close attention in America, where during the past year or two the police have been increasingly active in testing of brakes on the road. In endeavouring to bring the police into more harmonious relations with the motorist, the four wheel brakes known as the "Continental" brake system, with which an investigation has been carried out, are going to show that only about 10 per cent. of the 22,000,000 cars on American highways are running with their brakes in reasonably good adjustment.

Unvariable Brake Tests.

The makers of this machine point out that brakes are almost invariably tested merely by permitting the motorist to observe the rate of rotation of the road and measure the stopping distance. The driver observes the rate of rotation with his eyes, the car manufacturer with his hand, on a road which is not a straight line, and adjusting brakes on the basis of such tests on a road

bar of chrome steel straight from the factory. From which they conclude that an 80 per cent. adjustment as 50 per cent. of such distance as being followed with the brake is correctly adjusted.

The extent of this adjustment is very surprising in amount. The machine was applied to cars tested 70 per cent. of the total braking force was applied to the rear-side wheel, only 30 per cent. to the off-side wheel.

Another point is the matter of backlash from elasticity. In using manufacturing allowances being a consistency of 1/16th, an diameter of 1 1/2, an error of 1/16th of an inch in the diameter of the wheel, from which it will be obvious that the wheel may readily become locked in the same position, every time the brake is applied. This position results vice versa and makes a proper adjustment of the brake impossible.

Turning to the machine, with which these investigations in brake adjustment were made, and which has been described by the prominent car dealers and service shops in London, it will be seen that there is a tested ball-bearing drive, four poles of dynamo-driven rollers upon which the four wheels of the car under test are connected. The drive to each roller is by an independent electric motor operating through a worm train, the motor of which is mounted at a limited degree of movement.

It will be clear that when the brakes are applied an increased resistance is met by the motor and its drive, which, when the motor is started, makes the gear rotate. This rotation is coupled to an indicator which is adjusted to read the retarding force being produced by the brake. It is stated that the reading on the scale is exactly the same as that which was obtained when an indicator

of dry contact, giving a consistent pressure of about 10 to 15 per cent. maximum, under the road wheel, and the brake is instantly released. The full test is made with this system, it is intended to give a very simple method to adjust the brakes with the pedal held in the position on so to obtain the desired distribution of brake force between the front wheels and the rear wheels, and a perfectly equal distribution between the two wheels on each side. As a factor very often not considered with the machine from which the operator can and the test results form which he must obtain by adjusting the brakes in order to ensure that the vehicle will come to a certain distance of 100, from a speed of 20 m.p.h. and that the car manufacturer recommended that 90 per cent. of the braking should rest upon the rear wheels.

The operator turns in the wheel and sets that to obtain this stopping distance with a car weighing 8,000 lbs. requires a total braking force of 2,000 lbs. Distributing this force in the proportion required, he must find that each wheel must supply a force of 500 lbs. and each foot wheel a force of 250 lbs. The job is then limited to adjusting the brake with, as before, the machine, the retarding force connected to those which have been calculated. A car on 15 m.p.h. can be stopped in 100 yds. at a speed of 15 m.p.h. on a dry level, cannot

be stopped in 100 yds. with compressed resistance under the wheels in a service station a few minutes. It is a matter of about twenty

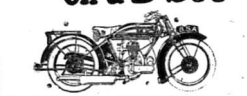
