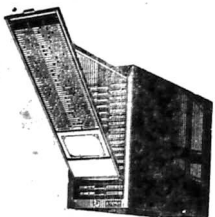

What a specimen—Which is one of at least two dozen more acquired phrases that I have to thank Kenya for. In my humble way I am a collector of phrases and when I hear a particularly interesting and beautiful phrase I stop myself before I stand still. The one I am now talking about is "to be a pig" which I have picked up in Kenya. It is a strange and wonderful word in a general phrase but I have used it so many times that I have written it in my notebook before I realized it, and now when I see a word of that nature I stop myself before I pick it up as I am suspicious of the word who some day will get it from New York cross England, and land in France with an "Oxford accent."

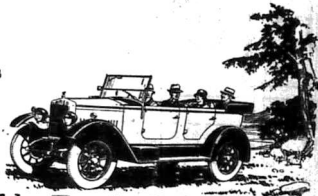

POULTRY NOTES.

The Day-old Chick.

The day-old chick business is one which should attract the attention of poultry farmers. Billing eggs which have to travel say 400 miles are most unsatisfactory in this country.

In many cases a sitting of eggs will have a fairly long railway journey during which, owing to the fact that the eggs are not fully incubated about the 10th embryonic effect that the normal container eggs. From the train they will be loaded to a motor motor which will push them into a village containing many other things and off they go again for probably six miles or so. If a later journey from the station, and the boy comes a night on the way, he will drop the village in the course of a hat and it will probably be kicked out of the way half a dozen times. Then when the eggs have passed through all these trials, the latter, doubtless, will get a heated letter describing the motor motor. As I very much object to being dissatisfied customers, I make it a rule not to supply anything of eggs if it will mean a long journey.

Day-old chicks will travel fairly comfortably well, and being day-old they are more carefully handled throughout their journey. It is usual to charge exactly double the price of a sitting for a day-old chick.

Day-old chicks travel well because they require no food during a reasonable length journey. They require good packing. The best way is to use a box of wood lined with straw, and to put a layer of straw at the bottom. All corners must be rounded off with the padding and there must be good ventilation.

Chicks should be despatched as soon as they are thoroughly dry and fluffy. It is the birds are to be put under a hen, on arrival, the hen should have been sitting on them eggs in a coop, for at least a week.

The chicks, on arrival, should

The floor space was large enough that the perch were well clear of the sides of the house, and all the walls were made of wire-netting. Open houses are the most satisfactory in this country, as the more fresh air the birds get the better they will grow, and know that this type should be excellent. Also, although the birds were of each type were beautifully clean. All the birds looked extraordinarily fit and well, and it seemed to me a pity that where the birds were so well cared for, the stock should not have been pure-bred.

**Public Schools and the Empire.**

The party of British Future and boys are returning to Britain and a recognition of their academic studies this week. This is the second of the week of work. It is already supposed that a British party should visit Canada towards the end of this year and there is little doubt that the system of pen-gained visits by the youth of the Empire will be extended. There is much that can be said and written in favour of the system and nothing in criticism of the principle. Whether the full advantage of the visits are reaped by those who are fortunate enough to participate in them depends on the attitude of the students to their experience and, no less important, the form in which that experience is presented to them by the committee in the countries they visit. There is no doubt at all that as a practical form of education, a lesson in appreciation of the Imperial heritage and an inspiration to patriotism, the tours organized

for selected youth have a great and permanent value. The divisions and forms of these advantages are not numerous to number; there must be kept in mind the future generation who are being drawn, the tendency of the Empire to look to the future, the stimulus of service in after life explored and followed by the presence of those great educational institutions. We have found in East Africa how great has been the influence of the Public Schools upon the quality of the white settlement and although East Africa has not yet attracted the attention of those who have attempted themselves in the series of Imperial tours there is little doubt that the prominence which has been devoted during the past few years to the immaturity of the problems of Empire which are being solved in the political, social, economic and scientific research fields of the East Central African Territories will in course of time suggest the value of inclusion of the States in a future itinerary. It is however apparent the lack of previous education provided by the State stimulates in the fortunate participants that Imperial patriotism and sense of the unity of the Empire which is so great a possession upon which to build and set on in the Colonies and standing on the knowledge of personal content and knowledge, respect related to common life and life of the old country and the new, of the right type of young men do the work of the future overseas and not only in the minds of the site, the body of their fellow in the great scheme must create a new and abiding meaning of Empire to the responsibility of the white race themselves. From East Africa we are sending home in increasing numbers the youth of the white Empire to find their education in the Public Schools of Britain. They will take with them their love of

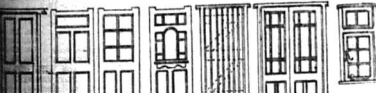

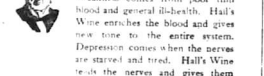

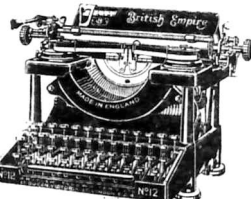
