OPPOSITION TO EASTER SATURDAY HOLIDAY.

Four Days' Break Too Long.

CHAMBER DISCUSSION

Nairobi Chamber of Commerce on Thursday last the question of recommending the observance of Easter Saturday as a statutory public holiday. Mr. C. Tammilli said the Chamber was informed at the last meeting of the fact that the Government had contemplated the inclusion of Easter Saturday as a bank holiday. The Chamber wrote to the Secretary asking if they had any information on the subject and the reply was to the effect that this day was not kept as a statutory public holiday in England and the Government had no information that there was any suggestion that it should be kept here. Mr. Tammilli asked that if Easter Saturday was made a statutory holiday it would be compulsory for the banks members were in favour of recommending that Easter Saturday should be observed as a public holiday or not.

Mr. W. C. Mitchell mentioned that the Chamber of Commerce, on one or two occasions in the past, had passed a resolution in favour of Easter Saturday being recommended as a public holiday and one would think that to be consistent they would recommend Easter Saturday being a general public holiday. He moved accordingly to feel the feelings of the meeting.

Mr. E. F. Meyer seconded Mr. T. A. Wood's motion that he would oppose the resolution. It was one thing for the local Chamber of Commerce to put forward a mere expression of opinion that it would be nice to have a Saturday holiday in between Good Friday and Easter Monday, but when they were asking the Government to legislate, he would insist that they would not be imposing for a section of the Nairobi community who wanted an extra day's holiday, they would be legislating for the whole country and their friends at Mombasa said "Nothing doing." Because they had a holiday on the Saturday, the ships did not stop on the high seas.

The ships came into harbor and the people at Mombasa wanted to get on with their jobs. The Government departments had naturally taken the line of least resistance—the holiday and work would be done. He did not think the banks were in favour of having it made a statutory holiday. It was an entirely different thing from recommending from year to year

that the Saturday should be a public holiday. As chief of the town council he had received a very serious complaint from the business community regarding the bank holiday as there was then four consecutive days during which no goods could be sold. Mr. C. M. D. also opposed the resolution. Mr. A. A. Luedl supporting the opposition and the public holiday on the Saturday made it an unnecessary long holiday and it was opposed by business being upset in this manner. The members voted practically unanimously against the resolution and the President's suggestion that this expression of opinion should be forwarded to the Colon Secretary was adopted.

Trade Protection.

CHAMBER COMMITTEE TO ENQUIRE.

When the subject of trade protection came before the Nairobi Chamber of Commerce at the monthly meeting on Thursday a former expression of opinion from the Chamber that the details of civil debt cases and judgments in the local courts should be given in the Press was referred to. It was pointed out on behalf of the East African Standard that there were several difficulties in connection with the reporting of such cases and that it was not proper for them to be published in a special gazette and trade journal. It was also suggested that the Chamber should obtain from the Court Registrar essential details for private circulation. The Secretary reported on an interview he had had with the Registrar who pointed out that there was a semi-official publication in England and Ireland in which details of civil judgments and bankruptcies were given and suggested that the London Chamber of Commerce might be approached on the matter. The publication of such a gazette in Kenya would have to be with Government sanction, otherwise any action would be against the publication for libel. The President of the Chamber of Commerce Mr. A. C. Tammilli remarked that it was a very respectable subject. He suggested the appointment of a committee to investigate the matter further and this was agreed to.

SIMPLE HOME MADE SWEETS

(By Martha Maguire)

If you have not done much in the way of sweet making, I will send you a simple recipe and ask you to make only small quantities at first. The following recipes have been tested and proved excellent.

Chocolate Fudge

Take one cupful of Decauville sugar, one level tablespoonful of flour, two tablespoonfuls of hot golden syrup, half a teaspoonful of salt, half a cupful of milk, and a tablespoonful (heaped) of grated chocolate.

Put the mixture into a fat saucepan and cook over a moderate fire, until the fudge falls from the sides of the pan, and still remains soft. When it is thick, remove from the fire, and add a piece of butter the size of a large walnut, gradually to taste. Leave until fairly cool, then beat the whole to a thick, creamy mass. Put this in a fat, well buttered tin and mark it square. Decorate each division with a pattern suit, well pressed.

Pondant Cream

Take the white of one egg, the juice of one lemon and two tablespoonfuls of soft butter. Add to these sufficient sugar to make it stiff enough, which may be added into balls. Divide the mixture into three colors: one pale green, one pink with vegetable coloring, and have the third portion white. Roll into balls, flatten slightly and decorate with a kind of comb, or a different fanciful mark, and send to the oven if desired.

There are several useful devices in the kitchen which are calculated to help quite a professional to become one, if desired. The most important of these are the edge of the text and complete.

Every housewife should invest in an abundance of egg-powder, for it enables the veriest amateur to keep things shaped and absolutely uniform pooled eggs. There is a little adaptation for each egg, which is thus kept equal, which being cooked, gives rise to a slight movement of the hand outside the egg to be slipped on the heat.
