## H. RHODES SPEAKS UNDER AMALGAMATION.

### Opposing Views at a Missionary Conference.

#### "NO RIGHT TO DISPUTE."

Two resolutions dealing with the position of natives in the event of amalgamation of Northern and Southern Rhodesia were discussed at the Southern Rhodesia Missionary Conference at Salisbury.

The first, which was moved by the Rev. John Wain, was "That in view of the fact that natives possess as this stage be adequately represented in any negotiations that may take place for their future Government, being politically un-orientated, and having regard to the many unsolved inter-racial problems, which, in our opinion, could be more justly settled by an Imperial authority than the Imperial Government than by a Legislative Assembly that represents white people only, and in view of the fact that this disparity in numbers between black and white in those areas is so great that it is practically an impossibility to introduce adequate safeguards for native interests, we recommend that responsible government for Northern Rhodesia be delayed. We express it as our opinion that the only effective form of political power that can be added to native people is to subordinate them in a basis that will encourage progress."

#### Bishop Opposes.

"I really feel," said the Bishop of Southern Rhodesia, that this has been foolishly nothing to do with us. We should object if Timbuctoo passed a resolution in their missionary conference saying that we were unfit for responsible government in Southern Rhodesia. Is it right for us to dictate to Southern Rhodesia under what conditions they should seek for responsible government? I think we are going beyond our province in this matter."

The Rev. J. P. Hartaker then moved "That this conference as a strictly of opinion that of the majority of those in Northern Rhodesia were satisfied they would prefer to remain directly controlled of the Imperial Government. We therefore hope to be asked that before any amalgamation takes place involving any handing over of natives to local control, native opinion, so far as possible, will be sought by Imperial authorities."

Further, he considered that before relinquishing any measure of control the Imperial Government should ensure that adequate safeguards are provided for natives to have right to purchase of sufficient quantities of land, the right to share in the franchise on reasonable terms, and the right to be a measure of control by the local council.

"Entirely so," the Bishop of Southern Rhodesia added here they could express so definitely in a resolution what the native of Northern Rhodesia was thinking. This was also outside their province.

The Rev. Fy. Burdidge agreed that these terms should be limited to the Salisbury people on a world-wide problem. This had a perfect right to interest themselves in the affairs of the London or anywhere else.

The Rev. Frank Nolle thought they should keep themselves away from any suggestion of interference with the Government of the Rev. Fr. Sheehan moved that the whole question be dropped. Mr. Lowe seconded, and the motion was agreed to.

**AN ATTEMPT TO SOLVE THE PROBLEM OF PORT CONGESTION.**

It was fully cognized in his office that any delay which was to be made from the assumption that the traffic could be easily dealt with without going far. It is therefore impossible for him to have any very considerable amount of time to present and conduct inspection of the work depending in the Port area and although the Port Manager is at all times accessible to his office, he is physically unable to establish the close personal contact with those engaged in the detail work of the Port which is vitally necessary to the maintenance of a high state of efficiency. Similarly, the District Traffic Superintendent who assists the Port Manager in shore working has, in addition to those duties, the control of a district extending from Mombasa to Malindi, half of his salary being paid by the Railway Administration. His own work, he has little time to spend on concerning the business work of the Port. As a result it appears to the Committee that the best sort of union between the public and the Port Administration on the one hand and the seamen, officers on the other is not required and a number of small committees each dealing with individual adjustments accumulate until they find expression in such agitation.

It is understood that the recent Estimates of the Kenya and Uganda Railways and Harbours Administration provide for the appointment of an Assistant to the Port Manager at a salary of £400 by £50 to £600, but that this position has not yet been filled. Presumably this office would be a permanent one and the Port Manager will have to be secondarily assisted in his administrative duties by the Assistant to the Port Manager and his own duties as a seaman, officer on the other hand and the seamen, officers on the other hand are not required and a number of small committees each dealing with individual adjustments accumulate until they find expression in such agitation.

THE NEW CHEVROLET. ROAD CORRUGATIONS. Investigative in America. CAUSE AND CURE.

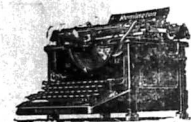

**IMPROVING RHODESIA'S TELEGRAPHS.**

Cred System to be introduced.

£100,000 SCHEME.

Telegraphic delays in Rhodesia were the subject of discussion at the eighth annual conference of the Rhodesia Telegraphic Society held in Harare recently.

Mr. W. E. Tongue (Railways) proposed they bring to the attention of the Government the shortcomings and delays in the telegraphic service, which were hampering business and causing actual loss, and request the Government to consider the present unsatisfactory working of the telegraphic service without delay.

Mr. J. Johnson (Railways) said there had been considerable complaints from the Press as well as from business men and a leading Harare leader had complained that his prices were now arriving 15 hours later than usual. In his own experience he had found the time between Johannesburg and Harare was nothing to complain about, though he had taken notes and looked up his telegrams for some time past. Yet there would be no doubt that in some quarters there had been considerable delay resulting in loss of business.

Mr. C. Kerkar (Times) said the delay was undoubtedly general throughout the country. Heavy capital expenditure was the only solution.

Mr. St. Quentin (Salisbury) mentioned the delay in the delivery of telegrams. Often, he said, a boy was sent out at 4 o'clock or 4.30 in a.m. with more telegrams than he could deliver before the office.

The difficulties.

The Postmaster General went through the history of the difficulty he had been faced with when he had taken over his present position. There had been a shortage of telegraphists which had also been largely remedied and a shortage of adequate material. He assured the Congress that if he got the money for which he had asked the Government, his telegrams would improve before very long. Two things were also necessary to

improve service, a Credit instalment and equipment upon that, a regular station at Harare in the Highlands. Most of the delays had been between Harare and the Union, and it was only for that route that a regular station was required. The Treasurer had asked him if it was a matter of credit because of the difficulty of erecting buildings outside the boundary of the Colony. He had replied that the power on South lines was not sufficient for the Credit system without a regular station. It had taken some time to arrange a site with the railway authorities in the south, but he understood that that had been fixed up and telegrams would shortly be running.

**Great Arrive.**

A Great Ireland had been purchased and was due at Harare that day. Within two months of that date the Government in Harare and Harare, and will not be the Union, just the Department of the Interior. **Cotton Seed.**

The Chamber had a full agenda on Friday last and dealt with a large amount of business.

Correspondence with the Director of Agriculture was read, showing that 4,077 tons of cotton seed were repackaged from ginners in the Protectorate during 1927. As a total of cotton seed should plant approximately 224 acres, this would give an approximate average of 60,000 plants per acre, which is a very high figure. It is a very interesting fact that the Chamber has a very large stock of cotton seed in its warehouse and it is likely to be a most important item in its equipment if it is required for planting purposes.

A wonderful tour through wild-out Yorkshire, in this exciting rain-through mud, road-tests comprised the grandiose course of the Leeds/Motor Club's recent "Top Trial".

### IGNITION TROUBLE.

**How to Locate It.**

#### FAULTS TO LOOK FOR.

A large proportion of engine trouble is due to the ignition system. The man who knows the theory of the system on the one hand, and the location of trouble here is comparatively easy. Let us see where trouble might develop, and will take up the primary circuit first, and then the secondary.

**Battery and Switch.**

The first test in the primary circuit is the battery. Of course, if the battery be discharged there will be no current to send the spark across to light the engine. If the battery be almost discharged it may be that there is enough juice in it to crank the engine for the indicator, but not enough for the full ignition coil. If the engine be started by hand all of the current will be used by the ignition and the engine will stop. The only remedy by the generator will then keep it going.

It is a good practice when starting the engine at night to put out the headlights while on-going, so the severe drain on the battery which occurs when the starter is used will thus be greatly lessened.

**Out and Interrupter.**

After the switch comes the coil. This addition gives to enable units of the spark. With many systems the switch is let to make the spark, but not to cut the coil off at the end of the spark.

In time the interrupter points may become worn. This will offer a resistance to the current and thus cause a weakening of the secondary. This may be sufficient to cause a failure of the spark. To remedy, get a double flare. This disperses the air and meets it between the two points and so fills them both over. If this does not separate, the points may be uneven and will not meet so well.

**Wiring, Distributor, and Plug.**

The wires are the cause of most ignition trouble than are any other part of the system. They may become loose, broken or short-circuited. The short circuit may be due to the wires being too close to water, and the wires being too close to all wires and, sometimes, to the fact that the wires are broken at the binding points and the insulation has become cracked with the contact of the engine.

Let us see where the secondary may give trouble. Like the primary, the coil may have been loose and the wires have become loose or short-circuited. However, the loss may be because of the high voltage, it is not liable to be broken. It is in the primary the danger of a short circuit is increased, though.

The distributor is the next part to be checked. Water or oil may cause a short across the bars, as in the interrupter, causing the remedy.

It is liable to be short-circuited by oil, to carbon or by the breaking of the spark plug. 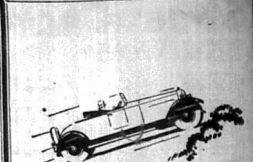

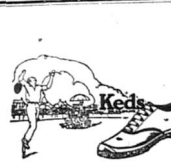
