THE FERTILISATION OF THE SOIL.

Types of Manures Which are of Advantage.

SYNTHETIC GUANO.

(By S. H. C. HAWKINS.)

Phosphorus, in the shape of phosphate manure, is the second element necessary to the life of plants. A certain small amount, about the same as in the case of Nitrogenous food in the soil actually. The effect of phosphorus on plants is to make them firm and to cause a more rapid growth, and also to delay their ripening, so that they can stand the winter months, and thus the ripening of the crop.

Manure, phosphorus, in proportion to the other elements, are required to form a balanced ration for plants, and therefore the requirement has been explained since 1855 to discover fresh sources of pure phosphate materials, to know the best of the artificial manures of the present day.

Phosphates are found, in rock, in Tunis, Algeria, and Florida, while Nature is a well-known example in the Pacific, as well as other islands. Even in the Red Sea there are islands containing this mineral. Another natural source of supply in Guano, such as Sepech's Guano, which contains 67 per cent of phosphate.

Two fertilizers are well known in Guano, namely Superphosphate and Basic Guano.

Synthetic Guano.

Synthetic guano is a natural product, and is obtained from animals whose manure has been collected for some years. A substance having little if any value to plants while the other grows of these things can be used if it will all of their phosphate in the effective form of soluble phosphate which is of very considerable value to plants. Potash, the third of the requisite elements for plant food under consideration, comes primarily from the potash mines in the north of Germany. It is an essential part of potash rock, and contains 18% of potash, equal to £2.10 per ton in London. It is similar to potash in the fertilising Sulphate of potash. 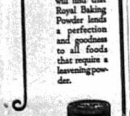

LAND AND AGRICULTURAL BANK.

Text of Bill to Come Before Council.

WORKSHE EXPLAINED

Part I of the Bill deals with the registration of mortgages and the management and control of the Land and Agricultural Bank. The Council of the Bank is given in the current issue of the Official Gazette for information and criticism. The Bill is in seven parts, the first being in all 67 paragraphs.

The chief object of the introduction into Legislative Council of the Bill is to secure a more whereby farmers and other cultivators of land may secure long-term advances at a reasonable rate of interest for the

purpose of approved development of their lands. This Bill is designed to be a combination of the Land Bank Act in force in the Union of South Africa and Southern Rhodesia. A Special provision is made for loans for the purpose of the construction of houses and dipping tanks, water supplies and irrigation works which apply to Native Reserves, Townships, Subdivisions, and farmers. In addition, a special part of the Bill deals with the needs of co-operative agricultural organisations.

Part I of the Bill deals with the registration of mortgages and the management and control of the Bank. The Council of the Bank is given in the current issue of the Official Gazette for information and criticism. The Bill is in seven parts, the first being in all 67 paragraphs.

Part IV is framed to cover the demands of farmers and others which will arise mainly from the "Cattle Clearing" Bill which are being introduced in the House. Also the relation of the Bank in regard to advances to native cultivators and Township Authorities is dealt with.

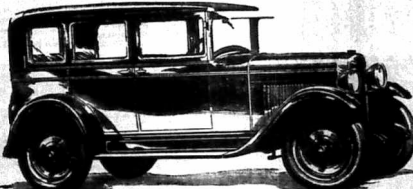

Civic pride is abundantly shown in Great Britain with length of years, but on the American continent it is a characteristic expression (and a more aggressive one) of young communities and a "Civic or American" city of the province will keep its twentieth birthday with much enthusiasm. In Kenya the movement has been utilized not only for the advertisement of the products of individual firms, but under the auspices of the enterprising Empire Marketing Board has developed partly into a propaganda campaign in favour of Empire goods. week. Actually the town is not sufficiently comprehensive, because whereas shopping would necessarily enter very largely into such a programme, there would be other means to attract the visitor. In order for such a scheme to be completely successful it would be necessary to have a suitable committee representative of the various interests which would contribute to the general scheme, such for example as the Agricultural Society, the Chamber of Commerce, the Agricultural Society, the Jockey Club and entertainment societies. 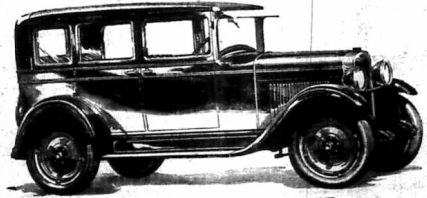

Aerial Surveying.

One of the most important and certainly the least interesting phases of the development of civil aviation is that which has to do with survey work. It requires very little technical knowledge and not a great deal of imagination to be able to appreciate that this method of mapping from the air is a great improvement on the system which still is in more or less general use. Because of its obvious superiority to ground methods of making surveys it is quicker, more comprehensive and can be carried out much more cheaply than is possible with the older system—the time will cease, and it will not be long delayed, when aeroplanes will be regarded as indispensable to all official surveys as a means of filling in detail even when a particular close check by means of ground measurements is required. From the interesting article appearing on other pages this morning something of what has been done in various parts of the world by aerial surveying of the kind to which we are referring may be gathered, as well as an indication of the part this comparatively new development is bound to play in the future. Especially interesting is the information regarding the steady and rapid progress which is being made in the survey work in Africa where so much remains to be done. Here is a big field for work of this nature, indeed a little reflection suggests that the possibilities are practically limitless. As an example of the importance attached by commercial firms to this most modern form of surveying it is only necessary to

THE PRICE LEVEL OF KENYA BUTTER.

Steady Rise from 1924 to the Present Day.

OFFICIAL ANALYSIS.

Following is the second of the series of articles dealing with the cost of living which are being prepared by the Statistical Department of the Government of East Africa Governors.—

Retrospect. The retail price of butter has been secured from 1924 to date from the collection in Nairobi. Butter imports and production price lists and notes kindly prepared by the Statistical Department by Mr. Gouvey Harrier.
