POULTRY NOTES.

Renewing the Stock.

There are many breeders who do not realize the necessity of renewing the stock from year to year, and neglecting this necessity, which why eggs are not fertile, and chicks do not hatch healthily and strong. It is impossible to go on from year to year within the same strain of fresh stock, as it is inevitable in breeding that the best lead to disaster. Line-breeding is the best method of renewing the stock of a poultry farmer, it requires such characteristics as fertility and vigor, and the character of the stock should be maintained. The ordinary poultry farmer has neither the skill nor the time for such work.

The subject of breeding and reproducing of species is the most important matter a poultry breeder has to tackle, but if it is faced in a commonplace manner and with no effort an intricate line-breeding of stock is no need for fear. Most breeders have their own methods of getting a result, but where an old hand will not expect to blame poultry breeders in general for a failure, but endeavor to find out the source of failure and remedy it.

In England, where breeding is more or less confined to certain models, it is usual to use pullets for the earliest breeding pens; in fact, they are more suitable, but because they come on to lay earlier, and their eggs are larger than the old birds. In this country, where breeding can be carried on throughout the year, the best system will be bred from second season females. These have the best chance of producing the best chicks. To use immature on both sides will be the best way to get a large number of chicks, and these will be hatch first and rear first, than to rear first, and then hatch.

The best stock will be reared from one, or even two, years of age. As long as it is cooked, is used. As long as the male laid a fertile egg.

The following matters were dealt with and the intermediate positions of view arrived at—

Position of Northern Rhodesia

The Northern Rhodesians expressed themselves definitely in favour of amalgamation with Southern Rhodesia. The Colonial Office and the Dominion Caid Group are most anxious to see the amalgamation carried out as soon as possible.

Law

Ministers were of opinion that the existence of two different systems of law is no obstacle to amalgamation as such a system could be altered by Act.

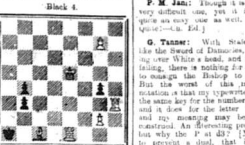

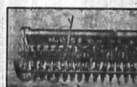

CAPE TOWN TO SCOTLAND
BY AIR.

Plan for a Great Non-Stop Flight.

OFFICIAL ADVISORY.

The air correspondent of the London Star states that a long distance non-stop flight from Cape Town to Scotland is contemplated by the Air Ministry, and that arrangements in that connection which have been proceeding for months past are now advanced to the utmost urgency.

The correspondent states that experts are aiming at the production of an aeroplane with a low petrol consumption, which will be able to remain in the air without refueling for at least 20 hours.

It is anticipated that the pilot will have a cruising speed capable of reaching a range of 7,000 miles and, as the distance from the Cape to the Northern Isles is 10,000 miles, there will be a reasonable margin for adverse winds.

The pilot has not yet been chosen, but at least two and a navigator will be necessary. They will be specially trained.
