EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT'S REPLY TO THE ULTIMATUM.

Postponement of Vexatious Measure Until Next Session.

A CONCILIATORY NOTE.

Hope Expressed for Better Mutual Relations in the Future.

The Egyptian Government in a Note in reply to the British ultimatum, announces that the Public Assurances Bill which was the immediate cause of the crisis has been postponed.

The hope is expressed that the manner in which the reply is worded will convince Britain of the Egyptian Government's desire to seek a peaceful solution of the difficulty and that the action taken will meet the British demand.

The full text of the British Note reveals the determination of the British Government to insist that the provocative policy of the World Government shall not be continued.

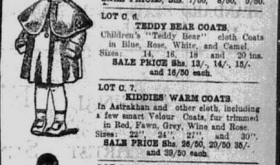

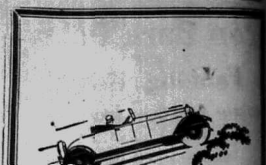

ATLANTIS FOUND AT LAST?

A German Professor's Discovery.

GLASSING RECALLED.

Professor Bernhart, of Munich, has advised the aged-investigator of the Atlantic, the land of mysterious myths and legend once beyond the Atlantic deep beneath the Atlantic.

For some time past, Professor Bernhart has been exploring in the neighbourhood of Tunis, along the coast of Sicily, the island of the Atlantic Sea. As a result of his discoveries he expresses the conviction that he has actually discovered the Atlantis described by Plato in the "Timaeus" and "Critias."

The view he puts forward in a letter to his friend, Dr. Berger, of Berlin, and Dr. Berger has in turn communicated the discovery to the *British Telegraph*:

"The sea was still low," he writes, "and I could see distinctly through my glass a flat island surrounded by a great circle, which the under-ground formed. I immediately set out and in twenty minutes I was standing on the hill. Without doubt this was an ancient settlement, as the old remains of walls which protruded from the earth plainly gave."

"Water Zieg."

The circular depression I have mentioned surrounded me. My when I distinctly noted a second circle, which concentrically surrounded the first. Here, without doubt, was the huge circular excavation mentioned by Plato described."

The next day, Dr. Berger's account meeting the professor set out, accompanied by a French schoolmaster, known well of the existence of this circular formation, signifying, several feet high (the Water Zieg strongly) which compares well with Plato's account of the "Water Stronghold." On the hill they discovered distinct foundations of walls which showed signs of some having formed some great building.

Wherever Bernhart rode he came across new signs of some old civilisation. At one spot he discovered a spring which the natives had ascribed to the Roman One doubt had ever been named by the natives "Palms, oak Claps." The Hill of Fragments, because

of the quantity of remains, debris and fragments. The professor was quite convinced that all this had been found, but that it was evidence that the discovery had been the site of some ancient settlement. And while historical times there is no evidence of the district having been known.

To be Revisited.

All tended to convince Professor Bernhart on this circular formation, about three miles in circumference, of some sort of great Atlantis.

The last sentence of Professor Bernhart's letter refers to the account shows how certain he is of the discovery. "The Atlantis was no fable," declares the professor. "The account did not refer to Southern Spain, but to the Atlantic Sea, the now almost dead or Short of Sicily."

Dr. Berger has interested Professor Farnard, Director of the Archaeological Board in Tunis, in Professor Bernhart's theory and he has now sanctioned excavation work which will be begun in the autumn of the year.

A noteworthy feature of the new sport, which already has been demonstrated at Longdon, Essex, is that betting is forbidden. Book-makers are not allowed to accept bets on the results of the races without the ground.

Negotiations are in progress with the "Woolley, Harringay, and White City" grandstand racing authorities, with a view to holding meetings on these grounds on different Sundays throughout the summer. The promoters are certain that the thrill of the sport itself will be more than sufficient to attract the crowd without the added excitement of betting. At some of the evening meetings the track will be lit up by floodlighting. The riders will wear goggles and helmets, and the spectators will be in white coats. The promoters are confident events will attract 20,000 to 30,000 will be attracted to watch the 16 races which usually constitute an evening's entertainment.

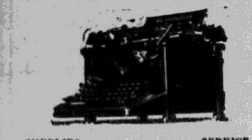

PETROL SYSTEMS.

Fully Described and Explained.

CAUSE OF FAILURE
