PRINCE OF WALES TO ARRIVE TOWARDS THE END OF OCTOBER.

Heir to the Throne may be Accompanied by T. R. H. the Dukes of York and Gloucester.

A PRIVATE TRIP.

Motor Tour Which Will Embrace Egypt, East Africa, Northern Rhodesia and the Union.

One of the most interesting items of news ever received in Kenya came to hand yesterday when there was flashed over the cables the announcement that His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales will visit East Africa towards the end of the present year.

It was a possibility, although there is as yet no official announcement, that the Prince will be accompanied by His Royal Highness the Duke of York and His Royal Highness the Duke of Gloucester, better known as Prince Henry.

The Royal tour, which it is stated will be of an unofficial character is likely to include a great deal of motoring and there is a possibility that the Prince of Wales will attempt something in the nature of a Cairo to Cape journey by road.

His Excellency the Governor has sent a message to the Secretary of State for the Colonies welcoming the announcement which he says will be received by the Colony with enthusiasm.

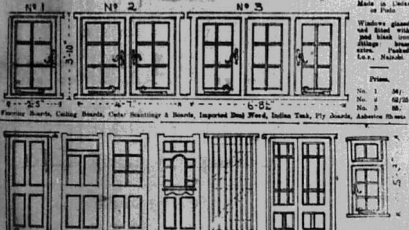

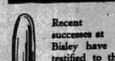

A DEMONSTRATION AGAINST ATTEMPT.

The native, who previously reported in the Standard, was sent by the Resident Magistrate to have the state of his mind ascertained by a Medical Officer, again appeared in Court on Friday, and the Magistrate, who had the native, who was charged with committing a public nuisance in the case of his duty, had been sent by Dr. Sanghani who had found him to be sane.

It will be recalled that in Thursday's evidence, Mr. Fisher stated that whilst on duty at the station, he saw a Medical Officer and said that he wanted to take his number, and then struck him, knocking him down.

A native woman yesterday gave evidence to the effect that accused hired a room in her house in Punjori for one night. On May 2, she saw accused coming from work and she saw him call for an order. She commented the evidence given by the complainant as to accused knocking the lady down.

Another native who was at Punjori on the day in question said that he heard accused make a statement and went to the assistance of the complainant who was struggling on the ground with the woman.

In his defence accused made a long and rambling statement, in which he said that he had been assaulted first, and that the woman had hit and bitten him.

A native woman, when he called to give evidence on his behalf and who was present when the fight started, in reply to Inspector Barrow, who said she did not like the order.

The Magistrate in his judgment said that the complainant's evidence was clear and was corroborated in all material particulars by the first witness witness. The defence was that the complainant was the aggressor. The second had shown a scar on his shoulder which could not have been caused by force or a blow with a fist, on account had stated it had been knocked off, and did not admit on what was not there at the time.

"Accused is a considerably tall man," said the Magistrate, "and I think could not quite reach" during one of his rambling statements he had the opportunity of being a witness and was a witness and if this was so, I cannot see how the Police were watching him carefully, and accused may have harboured a grudge against the witness.

This would explain what appeared to be an entirely unprovoked assault. The Magistrate, on being asked why he ordered him to the Crown evidence and found him to be sane, he said:

MUST A BROKER KEEP BOOKS?

Arguments in the Bankruptcy Court.

"A VERY BAD CASE."

In the course of the continued hearing of a bankruptcy case before His Honour Judge Shand at Nairobi, the Official Receiver asked the Hon. Mr. Keating, the Official Receiver at Nairobi, to frame a charge against the bankrupt under Section 79 of the Bankruptcy Ordinance.

The Official Receiver contended that this was the fourth adjudgment in the case of the bankruptcy of Karamal Saldhana.

His Honour stated that at the last hearing an order was made in connection with a release of content.

The Official Receiver—He has never prepared it. It has never been submitted.

Mr. V. V. Phelan, for debtor—Unfortunately that could not go through as there was no one here to stand surety.

His Honour—There was a question of someone coming up from Mombasa.

Mr. Phelan—That is so, but that gentleman did not turn up.

On being asked by the Official Receiver what the Commission, His Honour stated that a composition scheme may come in at any time and supersedes the adjudication.

The Official Receiver then asked His Honour to frame a charge, remarking that this was a very bad case indeed.

The Section under which the Official Receiver asked that the charge should be framed lays down that any person who has on any previous occasion been adjudged bankrupt or has made a scheme of composition or arrangement with his creditors is adjudged bankrupt or if a receiving order is made in respect of his estate, he shall be guilty of an offence if having done the whole or any part of two years immediately preceding the presentation of the bankruptcy petition being engaged in any trade or business, he has not kept proper books of accounts.

Mr. Phelan referred to section 8 of the section mentioned by the Official Receiver. The sub-section, Mr. Phelan added, made particular reference to "Where the trader or business has involved dealings in goods also"

counts of all goods sold and purchased and a statement of annual stocktakings."

Merely a Broker.

Continuing, Mr. Phelan stated that the debtor had never dealt in goods and that he was merely a broker and never sold or purchased goods in the same position as a trader. He did not say that a charge might not be laid against a broker that further inquiries should be conducted before a charge was framed.

His Honour said he did not know what, according to the evidence, the books in question were supposed to keep.

The Official Receiver—I have made inquiries and it has transpired that the bankrupt had a shop in Government Road and a shop in the station.

His Honour—Were there any goods?

The Official Receiver—Yes.

When questioned by His Honour regarding the business, the debtor stated that he had rented a shop, and in another person's name and paid rent for it.

Debtors—No.

When further questioned by His Honour on this point, the debtor stated that he had worked in a shop in Sixth Avenue. He did not pay the rent of the shop.

The Official Receiver—While you were carrying on the broker's business did you keep any books?

Mr. Phelan—the bank book books.

The Official Receiver (to his Honour)—He was buying and selling on behalf of the bankrupt, is particularly laid in that respect.

His Honour stated that until such time as there was further evidence regarding the debtor carrying on business and so on, the custom of the keeping of books by brokers, he would not make an order for the debtor's prosecution. He would require to have such full particulars as a magistrate should have in a preliminary inquiry. He would leave the matter open.

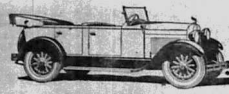
