## SETTLEMENT OF RETIRED CIVIL SERVANTS IN KENYA.

Scheme Which Applies to All East African Territories.

### LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL DISCUSSION.

#### Advantageous Terms of Covering the Purchase of Land.

The scheme for encouraging the settlement in Kenya on retirement of East African Civil Servants and servants of the Kenya and Uganda Railways and Harbours administration and of the Tanganyika Railways came before the Kenya Legislative Council at yesterday's session.

In the course of debate it was suggested that terms of purchase of land were too generous as compared with those obtaining for the uncultivated country.

On the other hand, it was argued that it was better for the retiring official to put as much money as possible into the investment of his capital.

### THE SCHEME EXPLAINED.

It is a scheme by which the retiring official is to receive a loan of up to £10,000 on retirement. This loan is to be repaid by the Government over a period of 25 years. The interest is to be paid by the Government. ### Special Provision.

Special provision was made in the scheme for assisting pensioned civil servants of the Kenya Railways. By means of advances to be made to them under the scheme, they will be able to purchase land in Kenya or Uganda. ### Kenya Advisory Committee.

The Kenya Advisory Committee is to be set up to advise the Government on all matters relating to the scheme.

### Official communication.

The Minister of Lands and Settlements has received an official communication from the Government of Kenya regarding the scheme.

### A Public Commission.

A public commission has been appointed to investigate the scheme. The commission is to report to the Government on all matters relating to the scheme. The commission is to be composed of representatives of the Government, the Kenya and Uganda Railways, and the Tanganyika Railways.

## THE PRINCES VISIT TO KENYA.

A NEW DATE.

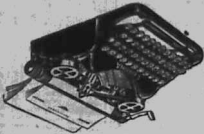

#### Thrilling Story of Two Ex-Captains.

48-MILE TRIP.

Two intrepid, close-combat  
soldiers stepped from a liner at  
Felixstowe, England, in 1918. They  
were James Martin and Charles J. Clair,  
both formerly captives in the

# MOTOR TOPICS

## THE GREASE GUN.

**Its Employment on the Chassis.**

## THE GREAR BOX.

Various types of grease guns are in general use, but in every case there is a barrel containing the grease which is sufficient to lubricate the parts of the chassis to be oiled. At the end of the barrel is the nozzle through which the gun, and at the other end there is a piston which forces the grease into the joints.

In some cases this connection is so locked on to the nozzle while in others it is simply pressed into contact. Therefore, the next time you use your grease gun make sure that you are obtaining the grease which you want.

The care for the former tends to be neglected, and the latter may be damaged and so that the gun will not be able to take the grease into the bearing. It is well to have the grease gun in the best of repair before you use it.

## The Break-Springs.

Referring to the actual setting of the chassis the next item to be described is the arrangement of rods and levers by means of which the pressure which the driver applies to the brakes is fed to the break springs.

## With breaking system can be carried out.

In almost every car the force applied to the pedal is conveyed by a rod to the brake shoes which act on the chassis. On shafts being situated approximately midway between the axle and carried in bearing fitted to the framework of the car.

## Repairing the Gearbox.

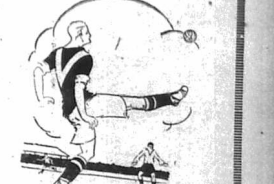

**DEATH CUTS SHORT AN AFRICAN JOURNEY.**

(REARDED.—Continued.)

The death has occurred this week of a noted traveller and explorer, Mr. T. Talbot Clifton, of the Service of Lytham, St. Anne's, Lancashire, and through his death England has lost one of the most intrepid travellers. His physique was so strong as his propensity; he was a man of 40-50 years, in the height and of his proportion—just the type of man to impress upon his mind the most powerful persons.

Few men in the history of this country have travelled so far, and so long, as he. He was a man of adventures travel in the wild places of the earth than he, and how he managed with his life from some of his adventures among savage races was scarcely about of suspicion.

It was whilst on a journey across Africa, in company with Mr. Clifton, that he was struck down with illness. They left England in January, and had reached Dambarah in the French Sudan when illness overtook Mr. Clifton. They had to be abandoned, and they made for Fessile, where Mr. Clifton had to undergo an operation for lung trouble. His illness was of a complicated nature and he lay in bed for many days, leaving the constant care of his wife. He was 60 years of age.

Mr. and Mrs. Clifton spent an extended period in the Indian Islands in the Bay of Bengal, where they did a deal of local hunting, and some years later they journeyed to the Malay Archipelago, where they spent many months, particularly in journeying over Celebes, the Empire's spent being the last one, a species of buffalo. Later he went alone through a great stretch of Africa.

**Settlement of Retired Civil Servants.**

There is much to be commended in the scheme for the settlement of retiring East African Civil Servants on the land in Kenya, and save a few points which suggest themselves for criticism. In the past much has been heard in critical way of the system which provides for State officials, on retirement with a country which they have given some of the best years of their life. It has been urged, and with a great deal of reason, that under such conditions it was almost impossible for a civil servant to take that interest in the country he served that he would naturally have if he knew that at the end of his service he would still have a stake in the Colony. There is no fact that in the past a big sum of money in the form of pension has been paid by Kenya to be spent elsewhere. Under the proposed scheme there would be less likelihood of this happening in the future. So far as the proposed preferential claims are concerned, we think that there can only be justified so far as they will encourage the retention in the Colony of men who have by their long residence acquired an undoubted and valuable knowledge of the country's conditions and problems. Finally as a settlement scheme related to the development of Crown land, the possible economic gain to the country is not so great as would be achieved by the settlement of younger trained agriculturalists
