Ireland's New Coins.

BETTER SILVER THAN IN THE ENGLISH ISSUE.

Details of the new Irish Free State coinage announced under the Irish Coinage Act of 1926 and now available, show that they are actually of greater intrinsic value than the corresponding English coins.
 The silver coin contains 75 per cent. fine silver, whereas the new English issue contains only 50 per cent. The threepenny and sixpenny pieces are of pure nickel. The new coinage was given this greater value to encourage the production of people who might continue to demand English money. Images of poultry, piglets, and, in some cases, fish, will appear on the reverse side of the coins, a token of the fact that Ireland is an agricultural country. The Irish harp will appear on one side.
 A novel feature is that the three penny piece has been made the same size as the sixpence, and to avoid confusion that three penny pieces has not been minted.
 A set of the new coins has been struck for the Royal Mint and submitted for the approval of the Government of the Irish Free State.

Workshops Road.

NAIROBI'S SLAUGHTER HOUSE NEEDS.

OUNCIL DISCUSSION.

Town Engineer Recommends Obtaining Expert Advice.

Councillor Depireux Recommends to "Permissive System."

On the subject of the new Slaughter House for Nairobi, the Municipal Engineer (Mr. C. R. Davidson) recently submitted the following notes for the consideration of the General Purposes Committee.

I request authority from the Council to proceed with the planning and construction of the new slaughter house on the following lines—

Engage the services of a firm in England who have specialised in Slaughter design and installations necessary for the efficient handling of carcasses. It is essential to have the extraction of fats and preparation of fatlines such as the In-kill process plant, and the shift and cold storage arrangements.

I suggest this as the most economical way to hasten forward the erection of a suitable and modern slaughter house, because if we undertake the design it will be necessary to send detailed drawings to all the firms who supply the above-mentioned installations and alterations, that considerable time will be lost before the complete design is such that the whole organisation will operate as one unit.

Councillor Henderson on the Town Council meeting on Tuesday said it looked as though they were intending going in for the permissive system of erecting them. He considered that on principle the designs for larger buildings should be called for from local architects. The failure of employing experts had been referred to by the Deputy Mayor that was important, and as another example he quoted the failure of "Government House" which was the cost of architects' fees etc. amounted to 10 per cent of the total, whereas the required sum was six per cent. He suggested that in future buildings of this nature should be tendered for by local men who have the money.

He considered that before these

requirements were sent home suggestions should be asked for from local architects and engineers. Councillor Yamsell supported Councillor Head's proposal. It might be advisable to refer the matter back to committee. This did not only apply to architects. The architect should be asked to all the particulars required could not be obtained from one firm in England. The information must be obtained from the particular firm that think it could be obtained in this country.

Saving Time.

Councillor Yamsell said the work required was of a highly specialised nature and the great point of sending home for the particular was the saving of time.

Councillor Henderson said he had no objections to the matter being referred back to Committee. He agreed that details could be got from home but he maintained it was entirely wrong to send home to a firm and to ask them to send out a building. When all the details had been obtained he thought tenders should be asked for from local people.

The proposal that the matter be referred back to the committee was adopted.

Britain Physically Fit.

"The British race is still physically sound" said Dr B. Joffe, head of the Canadian Medical Service in Great Britain.

Dr. Joffe, who has examined thousands of incoming immigrants under the Canadian Government's present scheme, added: "Britain is shortly but surely recovering from the effects of the war-time stress on the nation's physique. The physical standard is certainly better than it was five or six years ago."

£1,000,000 Garage.

ACCOMMODATION FOR 3,000 MOTOR-CARS.

Plans have been made for the erection of a super-garage, eight stories high and with accommodation for 3,000 motor-cars, in the heart of London. It will rival in size and efficiency any garage in the world.

The cost of construction of the garage, with the price already paid for the site, will be one million pounds.

It will occupy an island site of 25,000 square feet close to Baker-street. It is bounded by Marylebone-road, Upper Grosvenor-place, New-street, and the new road, which is to be cut between New-street and Marylebone-road. It has already been announced that an adjoining site will be used for the construction of a block of modern "flats" flats.

The site has already been partially cleared and building will begin as soon as the work has been completed. The opportunity is being taken to widen the Marylebone-road by 300.

"Fling" System.

We have bought the rights of a "fling" system of "fling" away motor-cars to the garage, said Mr. Leigh in an interview. This will enable 2,000 vehicles to be stored and taken out without any delay.

It will be possible by this fling system for a driver collecting his motor-car to hand it to the garage and have the vehicle delivered to him on the ground floor in three minutes. This will be accomplished by means of an elaborate signalling system.

Engineer Recommends Tapping Ruiru River.

SUFFICIENT FOR ALL NEEDS.

Scheme Costing £217,000, Which Would Take Three Years to Complete.

The problem of Nairobi's water supply, which has been a matter of some concern during recent years, may be solved by tapping the Ruiru River.

In his report to the Town Council, Mr. W. R. Max well, who was engaged to prepare the plan, guarantees a minimum supply of 50 million gallons of water a day which would not only meet the capital's requirements for many years to come...

The Town Council have decided to approach Government with a view to asking permission to proceed with the Ruiru scheme, or alternatively to ascertain whether in Government's view it would be better first to conduct water boring operations in the immediate neighbourhood of the town.

It is noteworthy that Mr. Maxwell expresses the opinion that a sufficient supply is unlikely to be obtained as a result of boring.

THREE POSSIBLE SCHEMES.

In pursuance of the commission issued as an Report No. 2 that 1,000,000 gallons of water per day could be procured from any source of supply it is proposed to make three different schemes for the water supply. The first scheme involves tapping the Ruiru River...

lower flows to pass down stream undiminished and unimpeded. As a careful gauging of the Ruims at the dam on each 2000 February 1928, only gave a total of 100 million gallons of water. 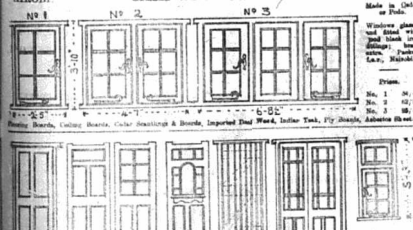

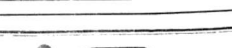

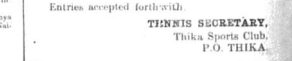

Indians and Legislature.

A QUESTION IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS.

Commons, **Harris Inge** in reply to Mr. **Harrie Skell** (Lab. Workmen) in the House of Commons. He asked the Secretary of State for the Colonies whether he could make any statement with regard to the application of the five Indian members to the Legislative Council of Kenya Colony; whether it was with his approval that a commission of inquiry had been set up for the purpose of investigating the policy of nomination introduced in 1924; whether he was aware that the Indian community as a body had protested against the proposal; had benefited the election, with the result that, with the exception of one Indian elected as an unopposed return, there were now no Indian representatives on the Legislative Council; and whether he would consider the advisability of returning to the policy adopted in 1922 on the recommendation of the Colonial Secretary for the Colonies, and introducing the practice of nomination with regard to the Indian members of the Council? Mr. **Ansley**: The proposal, as approved in the White Paper of 1922, was accepted without prejudice, by the Indian community. They subsequently withdrew their acceptance, and the later events were explained in the reply to the hon. and gallant Member for Central Hull (The Commander Kenworthy) on 26th March. I regret that I am not at present in a position to make any statement as to the future.

There were 328,450 in Central Kavirondo; 257,289 in North Kavirondo; 202,000 in South Kavirondo. The estimated totals were the Taita, with 181,000 and the Masai with 172,000. The numbers in employment at the end of March were Central Kavirondo—17,148; South Kavirondo—10,767; North Kavirondo—10,689; Taita—2,220; Masai—3,374.

Estimated figures are also given as follows—Lambia's herds, total population, 64,254; number employed, 6,584; Masai, total population, 222,800; number employed, 12,872; Fort Hall people, total population, 101,941; number employed, 15,675; Malyi population, 113,256; number employed, 15,613; Rukia-Chuka, population 92,724; employed, 2,563; Machakos, 186,974; employed, 6,830; Kioko population, 125,259; employed, 2,941; coast population, 194,021; employed, 2,267; Kere population, 136,970; employed, 1,100; M'Pori population, 65,370; employed, 2,413; Northern Frontier population, 69,002; employed, 7.

The total number of registered herds and oxen in employment at March 31 was 125,724, while the estimated Kikuyu herds reported on employment numbered 9,773 and the estimated Kavirondo herds and oxen reported on employment numbered 1,200.
