**FISHING NET CONTROL
FOR THE LAKE.**

Methods Proposed by
the Expert.

LICENSE LABELS.

In a further part of his report on the fishing survey of Lake Victoria, Mr. Michael Graham M.A. deals with Government's position in connection with the proposed monopoly over the sale of fishing nets.

He says: "The prohibition of import of fishing nets to private persons should be comparatively easy to enforce at the present time. The prohibition should include a provision for private persons acting through a factor for use on the term 'net', but that is an extremely unlikely event. The effect will be to put Government in a position to see that no nets of less than 2½ mesh are introduced into the Lake, and, in case of its being necessary in the future, Government will be able to enforce any restriction on the fishing power whether by means of a licence or otherwise, as Mr W. P. Fido suggested in his memorandum of the 10th inst. I should think that if this step is now taken, experience, elsewhere, enables us to propose that a licence of a smaller mesh to catch fish which at present go free, a measure which barely halves the livelihood of a fisher."

Control of the Hand Made Net.
The control of the manufacturer of the hand-made net requires special methods. At one time it was the opinion that the difficulty should be met by total prohibition of the hand made nets. In view of the fact that the community through Government would benefit, benefit in the marketing increased sale of the manufacturer net, this policy is not so harsh as it would at first appear. At the same time I should not desire to discourage the enterprise which has been shown by the natives in acquiring the machine-made net. Licensing Nets.

It is probable that the label will be detailed from its original net and attached to others carelessly during. These are essential, but the form of labels is not likely to be very serious, since the fishermen would only be using one net at a time. The construction of a net of smaller mesh would have to be restricted and officers might therefore make a practice of issuing the small mesh nets of the net carrying labels that are made by the manufacturer. 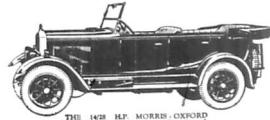
Special Labels.

The material of which the labels are to be made is a piece of soap paper. Before these labels are used, frequent samples are sent to the Government office, and the material is made of rubber boots and labels, which, compared with the material of the net, are much heavier than the material of the net. The labels should not be larger than 2½ by 1½, and should be made of a material which is not likely to be damaged by the water in which they are used. They should be attached to the net by a piece of string.

Importation Regulations.

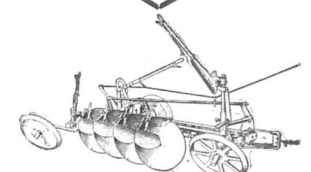

MOTORS TOPICS

DIESEL ENGINES.

Potentials for Road Transport.

FOR MOTOR VEHICLES.

From time to time we hear of developments in the construction and design of Diesel type engines for transport motor, and opinions are expressed that marked improvement in certain respects will soon lead to the more or less widespread adoption of this type of engine to cover motor vehicles of all kinds, even light touring cars, and many industrial motors for goods-carrying and passenger work, writes M. W. Houston, in Motor Transport.

It seems to me, however, that Diesel engine practitioners in wanting enthusiastic as to the prospects of the type for motor vehicles, although admittedly marked improvement and development have occurred of late in the direction in which they intrude in the petrol engine has also advanced during the same period and continues to advance. In their comparisons they seem to have missed the certain opinion as to the possibilities of the "oil engine" for automobile service, and propose to act on them here. In fact, it appears to me that the Diesel side of the argument is fairly stated in any event for I am sure that everyone interested in the automotive industry, whether auto manufacturers or users, would agree that it can be thrown on its side.

As I see it there are several reasons why the use of Diesel type engines is never likely to be as widespread as the petrol engine work, and in saying that I am not overlooking the reports made by unbiassed authorities who have tested some of the latest German trucks with Diesel engines, reports which have come to my ears precisely as a rule, which have been decidedly favourable, but which, nevertheless, seem to have

out-of-date petrol engines as the basis of comparison. In the Diesel, the Diesel engine, although some examples have been made, are not so comparable in weight with petrol engines for trucks, and most inevitably be a low speed type for a given size and piston displacement is above its normal speed, approaching the petrol engine in power output, with only low speeds. The reason for this was made evident on a result of an investigation into the nature of the combustion in Diesel engines. I was found that there is a serious equal to form in the Diesel engine, the duration of combustion being long. Moreover, until the conventional though less extensive timing in the petrol engine, it cannot be the nature of the Diesel cycle, but constructed by "over-boosting" the injection point. Such a timing is that enough on an engine running at 1,800 r.p.m. for speeds such as those at which private and industrial motor engines run under its operation, and the Diesel principle out of court.

This implies that the Diesel cycle, whether in the two-stroke or four-stroke rendering, cannot fail to result in a lower power unit, owing to the higher internal pressure and necessarily stronger construction on that account. Theoretically, it would seem, it is possible to secure a higher r.p.m. from a Diesel engine with a given maximum pressure than with the same maximum pressure at a petrol engine. It is 145 lb. and 125 lb. per sq. in. respectively were quoted recently by an automotive designer as the maximum pressure for the Diesel engine. But I note that on the same occasion a manufacturer of Diesel engines, discussing the latter from an automobile standpoint, asserted that 80 lb. per sq. in. is a possible to obtain from this type of engine up to the present. Moreover, in almost the same breath, speaking of the factors that limit the speed of Diesel engines, he said that, owing to the necessary construction, it was necessary to design for maximum pressures as high as 1,800 lb. per sq. in. at that point, he said, quite rightly, the whole structure of the engine and the reciprocating parts must be consequently heavy. He quoted an engine built on automobile lines

that, with aluminum cylinder heads and pistons, weighed 20 lb. per h.p.; that in far below current petrol engine practice on a similar basis of comparison.

Feasibility. The whole trend of automobile engine design nowadays, as far as the past, is towards the design of engines that will run at higher and ever higher speeds of rotation without drop in their power and torque curves. To compete with the petrol engine, the Diesel type engine practice on the speeded up, without loss of efficiency, for that which is possible at present and higher than any Diesel engine built ever suggested, by my knowledge, is likely to be possible in the future.

Increased flexibility. Certainly he is no less in demand in time to come, for it implies a great deal more than the low speed gear for changing gear. It is easier to make a smaller engine for a given power, increased fuel efficiency, reduction of weight of chassis and of engine, and lighter gear—intended to run in "slave-hoped" areas. It may appear in certain cases very restricted classes of use; it may even displace the petrol engine, in some spheres of aeronomics (e.g. in lighter-than-air machines) where flexibility is relatively unimportant and a "safe" fuel tank might be desirable. But its prospects in connection with road transport are not attractive, in my opinion, in any very broad sense.

Even so, had some of its advantages may be realised, the Diesel engine is a representative of one of the oil companies and several of the fuel oil manufacturers of Diesel engines, who are now "lighting the gas oil" and that they were "ready" to obtain it in future at a very low price, as they expected, because this oil was so easily "cracked" to produce petrol, oil refineries, he added, naturally preferred to sell petrol, as the higher price of oil containing a fairly large proportion of residual. It need hardly be said that, in that event, the difficulties associated already from existing with it, the value will be considerably increased.

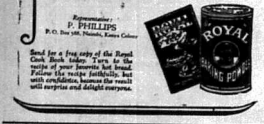

Committee's Recommendations as to Future Organisation and COMPULSORY TRAINING.

Scheme for European Instructors Supplemented by Native Teachers.

The organisation of agricultural education for Africans was the subject of a report laid on the table at the recent session of the Kenya Legislative Council. The report was submitted by the Committee appointed to consider and advise as to the lines to be pursued for the better organisation of agricultural education for Africans and the funds from which such assistance should be given.

The committee stresses the need for teaching Africans to realise that there is nothing derogatory attaching to agricultural work, and that the contrary offers much greater scope to natives than the very limited field of clerical work.

GETTING RID OF FALSE IDEAS.

One of the main objects of the committee was to remove from the minds of the natives the false ideas which have been inculcated in their minds by the missionaries and the Government. The committee is of the opinion that the only way to do this is to teach the natives that agriculture is a noble and profitable occupation, and that it is the only way to improve their condition.

After the age of 14 should not only be appreciated, but should be made pay fees. If the parent of a boy over 14 years of age, or if a mother for her son's education, it is the duty of the parent to see that the boy is going to attach real value to his schooling, and the Government labour awarded by the school authorities to such boys will be valued. It may be that Local Native Councils will be willing to vote money either for scholarships or for contributions to schools which will enable the fee payable by the pupil himself to be reduced to a small sum, but we are definitely of the opinion that the pupil himself or his parent must pay a specific sum, however small.

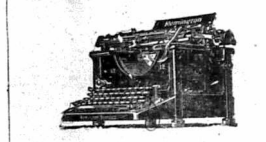

How the Present System Limits Choice of Candidates.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE.

A Suggestion That Cost Should be Met by Poll Tax for Women.

The financial responsibilities incurred by Elected Members of the Legislative Council in the course of their public duties and the consequent difficulty in securing candidates for election were stressed in the course of a lengthy debate in the Convention of Associations yesterday when a resolution advancing the opinion that unofficial members should be paid was adopted.

While there was no opposition to the allowances granted to official members being increased, delegates expressed disapproval of the present system of payment in support of which view evils in the professional politician and the straddling of interests of the farming community in Council were emphasised.

Supporters of the resolution urged the adoption of a system of payment in view of the possibility of increased municipal representation on the Legislative Council in the future.

CONVENTION DEBATE.

The resolution which was introduced by Commander A. I. Cole (Kenya and Nyeri) was as follows: "That in view of the evils of increasing political aspirations of the Colonial community and in consideration of the fact that the number of members of the Council is increasing, it is a constituency suitable for election, be limited to the number of members of the Council who are in receipt of salaries or wages from the Government."

Turning to the question of a tax rate of payment, which, he said was greatly unfair, Commander Cole suggested that the members of the Council should be paid on a scale of £100 per annum, though he proposed that the rate should be £50 per annum for the first year, and £100 per annum for the second year.

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT. His Excellency the Governor of the Seychelles, Mr. de Souza M. G. Hoare, C.M.G., and Mr. Hoare, gave a garden party at Government House on Sunday. 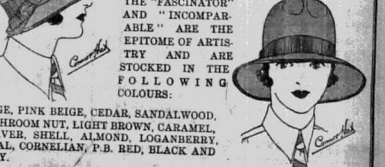

BOOKS AND THEIR AUTHORS.

A New Phase in the Literature of the Territories.

The output of the publishing houses on East African affairs is astonishingly large. Each year produces an increasing number of books on a wide variety of subjects and the collection of an East African library is not a matter of a little difficulty unless taste is catholic in its quality.
