### "The Condoilers".

ONE OF THE BRIGHTEST OF A FAMOUS SERIES.

FROM A CORRESPONDENT.

"The Condoilers" which is shortly to be played at the Theatre Royal, was first produced at the Palace on December 7, 1905, and by 48 years ago. Opinions may differ as to the merits or demerits of this Opera, but it undoubtedly is popular all containing numbers the times which are familiar to everybody; for instance—Take a pair of spades—The Royal Quene's—the dainty Gavotte and brilliant Gabastra.

Storage to say, it was during the first run of nearly two years of "The Condoilers" that differences began to arise between Gilbert and Sullivan which culminated in the latter and composer has never again. Indeed, Savoy Opera has never been approached by one of the nobles, experiments by other hands which have followed. ### CALL FOR REDUCED INLAND LETTER RATE.

#### Convention Criticism of the Post Office.

#### MUTILATED TELEGRAMS

Post and Telegraph Services were discussed in the Convention of the Post Office on Wednesday morning arising out of a resolution put forward by the London, Eastern and Metropolitan Division. The motion was proposed by Mr. Curiale, was as follows:—

That in the opinion of the Convention the present rate of inland letter postage of twenty cents of a shilling is greatly in excess of present day requirements, and further that a better rate should be introduced forthwith.

Speaking to the motion Mr. Curiale said that the present cost of postage was a great drain on the resources of those who had a large correspondence, and materially affected the cost of living. In view of the considerable revenue which might be obtained from the much reduced advertisements on the back of telegraph forms he thought the rate should be reconsidered.

London, Coker (Kurdish and Hindi) seconded the motion. He believed that last year the Post and Telegraph Department had saved a surplus of £40,000. He considered the Department to be a backward one, and in addition to the fact that it was a loss-making business. If such a profit were made the Department should either be suppressed or the rate charged should be reduced. The Post Office could not have it both ways. That was a definite fact. It should be the cheapest to collect—and the more of it should be given the credit for this taxation.

Mr. Purvis Cobb (Nairobi District) said he supported the motion very strongly and he agreed that the present charges were a serious tax on the whole community. At the same time he thought it should be borne in mind that a reduction of the postage from 20 cents to 10

cents would mean a loss of £20,000 to the Post Office.

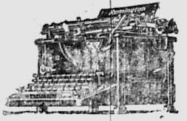

**WHEAT DECLARED TO BE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCT!**

**Rules Governing Export from Kenya.**

**GRADING REGULATIONS.**

"Wheat" had been declared a Proclamation contained in the Official Gazette to be an agricultural product for the purposes of the Agricultural Produce Export Ordinance.

Under the Grading Regulations, wheat has been brought under the Agricultural Produce Export Ordinance, which means that it shall be treated as any other agricultural produce for the purposes of the said Ordinance. It is pointed out in the Regulations at Nairobi that in the case of wheat, the same rules apply as in the case of other agricultural produce.

The purpose of the Regulations is to ensure that the quality of wheat exported from Kenya shall be of a standard which will be acceptable to the foreign market.

The Regulations provide that wheat shall be graded into three classes, namely, Grade A, Grade B, and Grade C. The quality of wheat in each grade is defined in the Regulations.

It is further provided that wheat shall be stored in a manner which will ensure its purity and quality. The Regulations also provide for the inspection of wheat at the time of export.

Mr. Percy Cook said he thought he had been put in charge of the motion as it was a fairly serious one. He had spoken on the subject brought up before the Public Commission and the East African House and had been turned down. It had now been considered by the Executive of the Convention. Members were seeking for the delivery of telegrams throughout the 24 hours. At the present time the Post Office opened at 7.30 a.m. and he did not think there were many other offices open before that hour. The reception of cables were sent from the line from Zanzibar was slow, generally 6.00 to 7.00 p.m. He submitted that work was not done late enough to work and he did not think that many offices should be open after that hour.

On the subject of allowing the principal complaint seemed to be that some of the business offices were nearer to Kilindi than was the Post Office. He had been submitted that the saving of time was not a serious matter. It had been said that if the alteration were made that the volume of cable work would increase. He understood that the daily average of cablegrams coming in was 25 and the daily average going out was the same. "KENYA FROM WITHIN"

A Gesticulating Figure on a Pedestal: A Historian Who Missed His Opportunity.

Among recent books which have attracted attention, is Mr. W. McGregor Ross' "Kenya from Within."

Had the author confined himself to the facts of history, his indictment would have been in many respects unanswerable when judged by worthy ideals and principles.

But the impression remains of a missed opportunity, an unqualified historian and a gesticulating little figure insecurely perched on the enormous pedestal of the vast Imperial experiment of Kenya colonisation.

The belated tributes in the first article in some of the recent additions to the East African bookshelf will serve perhaps as an introduction to five new books which have appeared within the last year. Books which should not pass unnoticed in East Africa and have a special value in our variety and in the qualifications of their authors for the work they have undertaken. Our book which has been the subject of much criticism is from the pen of an ex-official in the Kenya Service; another prominent figure in the life of a romantic figure whose life was lived in conditions which led to a rather useful and unpretentious picture of the man who finds a new interest in the fauna of the Territory; the last, covering a wider country, is the work of a serious-minded man who has had an example opportunity as a missionary agent in studying the problems of Christianity in Africa. East Africa has some reason for gratitude that within the short space of a year five people so diverse in their interests and their outlook have been induced to give to the great public here and overseas the fruits of their knowledge at a time when East African affairs bulk so prominently in the minds of people of all shades of opinion and colour.

"Kenya From Within" by W. McGregor Ross (London: George Allen & Unwin, Ltd.) is in a sense a companion volume to Dr. Newman Leys' "Kenya." Both authors

had the peculiar advantage of acquaintance with their subject through service in the Kenya Government but whereas the latter presented his problems in the abstract and forcible style which was to be expected by those who know him and look after the student of psychology a remarkable opportunity for consideration of personal qualities and differences in mental outlook. But both have one or two qualities in common— an optimism amounting to a self-illusion, and an unqualified admiration for those admirable qualities a less pleasant personal acquaintance to his life-work, much derived from his many good points as a political historian, they deal with their subject personally and although not explored by the ex-Inspector of Public Works is too restricted to norms of impartial treatment by one who played a part in its exploration during a period of years not yet sufficiently remote to permit of free examination in perspective. There is every evidence in the book that the author deliberately brought himself into the forefront in an attitude of martyrdom with out justification. The pedestal of Imperial experiment is almost large for so small a figure and the absence of proper proportions tends to incongruity, heightening the value of the book and attracting a wide doing attention to the personal ele-

ment when so great reason could be found for concentration on "imperial" fact. The defect is exaggerated in a sense of style character and explanation, somewhat unconvincing, why the author should have indulged in the bluntness of the bluntness. There is, too, an unhelpful tendency to personal comment where, not infrequently, the plain statement of fact is sufficiently telling.

A Missed Opportunity.

Had Mr. McGregor Ross been more experienced in the abstract of historical writing, even so, he would have been more successful in his endeavour to make his work as a whole more convincing. It is possible to imagine the greatest of historians thought on the problems of East Africa and the impressions which occurred to him as he read the accounts of the past. He has missed the opportunity of controlling his style to make a book which would have added the value of time and labor a place beside many other volumes as a handbook and work of reference reliable and trustworthy, an accessible storehouse of knowledge of a profitable kind of the greatest interest to a measure of progress towards sound political development in Kenya. But Mr. Ross has shown instead a little more of its own life, a passing matter which will read him reading and is already fading. Good history should not attempt to write history. It would have been better to have preserved the spirit of the greater limiting explicit in the book's healthy fiction as far as with such apparent success in the history of Kenya and the whole of the Empire. "Kenya from Within" is divided into three main parts of which the first is entitled "Old History." That there is much history in it is admitted, that the "subject-matter" is "doubtful." But it is, in fact, one of the most valuable parts of the volume. It sets out as a background the familiar outline of the history of the continent to the East African and the various civilisations which preceded British dominion. The very first chapter is marred by one of those unnecessary additions to fact which cause the book to get on the reader's (Continued on page 11.)

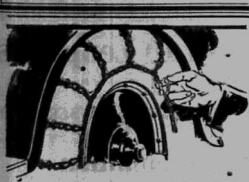

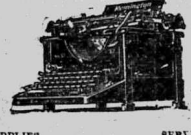
