REVIEW OF CROPS POSITION IN 1927.

Increases in Barley and Coffee.

RISAL PRICES.

In a further instalment of the Report of the Department of Agriculture for the year 1927, estimates are made on the development and progress during the period under review of the various crops grown in the section.

Increases in barley and coffee are recorded in the section. The accounts for the decrease in the value of coal reported, although the actual output was increased. Special attention is paid to miscellaneous crops, regarding which it is suggested that more attention might be paid to the keeping of records.

Wheat Mills.
 A census of wheat mills and wheat milling was again taken during 1927 and furnished the following information:
 There were some wheat mills operating during the year. The nine mills were capable of milling a total of 60,5 bags (249 3/4) a week hourly. When milled during the year amounted to 67,802 bags, valuing 19,000, the 1926 figure for the same floor was 31,311 bags (126 1/2) a week floor.

The wastage in milling (including bran) was 17,449 bags of 500 lbs. or 22.1 per centum of the total quantity milled.

Barley.
 Interest is increasing in this crop and farmers are advised to try a small acreage each year until they understand its culture. It is expected that in the future barley will become one of the more important crops and particularly so when farming schemes. In 1927, 4,005 acres of barley were planted as against 2,644 acres in 1926.

Coffee.
 The season has been droughty but the quantity of coffee exported is up to 70,000 cwt. The export value shows a corresponding increase from £711,138 in 1926 to £1,180,549 in 1927. The total area under coffee in 11,926 acres or a per cent more than for 1926 and the average is lowering to approximately 8,000 acres at 53,200 cwt. The estimate of production in July, 1927, was 215,000 cwt. whereas 200,000 cwt. were exported of equivalent in value to 42 per cent of the total. There are 749 coffee plantations in the Colony. The Chief Officer states that the production of coffee per acre planted is only about 2/6 lb.

The Coffee Commission.
 During the year a Coffee Commission, that is a committee of representatives from various Farmers' Associations and other bodies interested in coffee, was organized by the Government. A full report of the Commission's work is published in the annual report. The Commission showed great business and practical sense in its handling of the coffee trade. It is a very regular inspection of plantations and the Commission also the Coffee Plantations. Also the Government members of the Commission was carefully considered with a view to more research and investigation work being undertaken.

It would be most interesting and the greatest benefit to the industry were an experimental station established at which the details of plantation treatment and management, together with factory methods, could be exhaustively studied. At the same time the breeding of coffee for yield could be regularly undertaken there. When it is considered that the industry has not yet evolved a definite system of management and will do so only specific and accurate data and information is required from trials, it would be wise to have an experimental station at which at least a much smaller field the country could be producing with its coffee work on an experimental basis.

The experiments on coffee in the past few years in the various stations at the coast are promising. Tobacco, appears to be valued in the country.

Rubber.
 The output of rubber was much increased last year, owing to the fall in prices, the value of the crop exported in 1927 to only £406,974 as against £729,600 in 1926. The total area planted in 1927 was 40,721 acres or was over three years old and therefore ready for cutting. The increase in area for 1927 is 11,016 acres or 18.30 per cent over the previous year. The people interested in this industry are as heretofore contentedly making investigations into methods and systems with a view to lowering working costs and increasing area output.

Cocoa.
 There was a decrease in the export of Cocoa from 22,085 cwt. valued at £25,750 in 1926 to 14,725 cwt. valued at £14,070 in

The production of sugar to home use, increasing all the export of 23,500 cwt. took place during the year. One of the most important crops in which the agriculture of the Colony can be made more diversified is by the culture of these crops which today we class as miscellaneous. 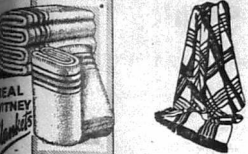

DROUKE TAX

To the Editor, "E.A. Standard." Sir—Your correspondent X. Y. Z. writes, "I have been told that no man, obviously foreign, by the letters 'W' in reply to 'United Consulate' (I wonder why they don't say their names)." In the first paragraph he states that Income Tax is advanced as the only method of taxation by which the equality of taxation which we all desire, can be attained. I need not say that he is right, but it is on the flat and on the steeply rising slopes.

It is very strange that X. Y. Z. should be ignorant of taxation. My objection is that the Government should by legislation and administration, through all the various departments, create the facilities and maintain possible means for the employment of those who are unable to trade and should be no taxation of the means of those who are accepting the benefits and protection of the State.

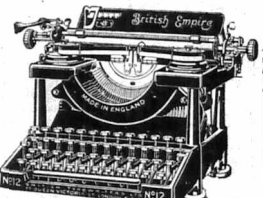

PROPOSED NEW SYSTEM OF TRAFFIC TAXES & CONTROL.

Committee's Recommendations to Legislative Council.

NEW LEGISLATION.

To Take the Place of the Present Motor Ordinance.

Recommendations for legislation dealing with traffic and the licensing and taxation of vehicles are made by the Roads and Traffic Committee, appointed by Government, in their third report which was laid on the table of the Legislative Council last week.

The report includes the draft of a Bill "To provide for the control of traffic on roads and for the licensing and taxation of vehicles" which the Committee advises should be enacted forthwith.

A FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE.

The fundamental principle that the rates of taxation of vehicles should bear relation to the destructive effect of vehicles on roads is well established in most countries, states the report. Its adoption in this Colony was recommended in the second interim report of this Committee. It was approved by the Select Committee on the taxation of vehicles and is now reiterated by the Committee.

In their second interim report, this Committee advised fees for motor vehicles based on the Motor Vehicles Ordinances of the Transvaal (1914-1925) under which the scale of fees was dependent on both load weight and horse power. After considerable examination of this matter, the Committee has formed the opinion, which our Committee, that it would be better to follow the practice which is established in Natal, the Cape Province, the Gold Coast and Nigeria, namely, to base the scale of fees on load weight alone.

Reverts to Local Authorities.
 The scale of fees for motor vehicles, proposed in practically the same form as that in force in Natal and correlates closely with those of the Cape Province and Nigeria. With regard to the proposal for the taxation of vehicles other than motor vehicles, the Committee has

ing for low both as tax and as control, the Committee has felt it desirable to base fees on load weight, rather than on horse power, by making special provision for the class of motor vehicles. The public and factory from other countries have a right to expect that reasonable measures are being taken by the local authority to safeguard the security and convenience of passengers travelling by such vehicles in the same way as the safety and convenience of those who are transported by low and independent motor vehicles. It is accordingly proposed that a system of the Bill is designed to meet the various purposes in this connection and three distinct classes of motor vehicles are provided for:—(1) Buses, (2) Identification plates, and (3) Motor cycles. Provision is also made for compulsory insurance of public service vehicles and for motor cycles. The Committee in Nigeria recommended that the same system of motor vehicle parts shall be made compulsory for all motor vehicles in this Colony.

Negligent Driving.

Following the recommendations of the Department (Ministry of Transport) Committee regarding differentiation in respect of penalty between driving, to the common danger and careless driving the Committee proposes a similar application of the two offences. In this Colony so far as motor vehicles are concerned.

The Committee proposes that the offence of dangerousness which driver or being in charge of a vehicle should be extended so as to include the case of a driver which the offence is imposed by driving.

It has been thought best that the vehicles, namely, maximum dimensions of vehicles and forms for use in connection with licensing and taxation of vehicles and similar matters should be prescribed by rules and not included in the Ordinance.

As foreshadowed by the Committee in their second interim report, the bill as now presented will repeal the Motor Traffic Ordinance when enacted.

The Rules which would be required under Clause 49 of this Draft Bill, if enacted, have not yet been fully considered. These which are at present in force under the Motor Traffic Ordinance (Chapter 106 of the Revised Edition) can be amended with modification and supplemented to include the necessary provisions for traffic other than motor vehicles. It is suggested that if this draft bill is approved by Government and Legislative Council the Rules under the Ordinance should be amended by the Committee and have effect from the date when the Ordinance comes into force. The Committee wishes to be understood that all road traffic should be available to the public in pamphlet form.

Rural Cultivation.
 Applications are invited from the "official classes" of the Crown grants of land not made within the boundaries of any Native Reserve for the cultivation of land. Applicants should be accompanied by a sketch plan showing clearly the land required and its approximate area, and should state the proposed scheme of development, and all such other particulars as to financial resources, etc., as would assist Government in making a final decision. Grants, when made, will be for 100 years, and subject to the usual conditions of the Crown Lands Ordinance or regulations made thereunder. Applications should be submitted to the Commissioner for Local Government Lands and Settlements on or before the July 31, 1926, and should be enclosed in sealed envelopes addressed: "Application for Rural Land." Government does not hold itself to answer, either by direct grant or otherwise, any particular block of land for which application is made, if it be considered desirable areas applied for may be offered for sale by auction.

GENERAL MOTORS IN SOUTH AFRICA.

Investments Reach A Total of £3,000,000.

THE PORT ELIZABETH FACTORY.

This week says a South African paper, the investments of General Motors in the Union reached the sum of £3,000,000. This sum represents the capital invested in the space of the 12 months the company has been in operation. The total amount now placed in plant, equipment and material at the Port Elizabeth factory alone for building operations in South Africa is just over £900,000.

ARCHITECTS ASKED TO USE EMPIRE TIMBER.

Only 10 per cent. Imported into Britain.

VALUE OF EXHIBITIONS.

With the object of directing attention to the possible uses of timber from Empire sources, the government of the Imperial Forests recently entertained at luncheon members of the Royal Institute of British Architects.

Mr. Douglas Mackay, Director-General, presided. He stated that there was a growing movement throughout the whole of Great Britain to use more and more the products of the Empire. The industries of the country utilized annually enormous quantities of structures and ornamental woods, and practically the whole of the supplies was imported. To a great extent, import of the required material was avoidable. It was a great loss to the Empire, but a less satisfactory feature was the relatively low proportion of the import derived from Empire sources.

The average value of the total imports of timber of all kinds into the United Kingdom during the past five years had amounted to only £46,000,000 per annum, only 10 per cent. of which represented wood of British origin. It might be some time, he stated, before such a large amount could be supplied from Empire sources, but it was a great deal more than 10 per cent.

The ultimate solution of the problem—reason why the Empire timber import was so small was that architects did not specify Empire woods in their professional practice. They were the first to purchase nearly always, they could recommend the woods to their clients and send them from their timber merchants. In most cases they did not do so because the woods in question had not been brought adequately to their notice. It was for that reason that they had been invited to inspect the Exhibition of Empire Timber at the Royal Albert Hall on May 30. There was good evidence that the exhibition had done much to bring the Empire timber to the notice of the public and the architects. Numerous inquiries had been received from all classes of the public and from a number of the best timber merchants had decided to embark definitely on the manufacture of Empire timber.

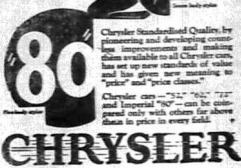
