SEPARATE PLANS FOR ROYAL VISITORS.

Duke of Gloucester's Private Shooting Trip.

ARRIVAL ON SEPTEMBER 28.

Rail and Cars for Journey to the Cape.

London, June 19. It is officially announced that the Prince of Wales and the Duke of Gloucester will proceed to Africa during the first week in September and will arrive at Mombasa on September 28.

Shortly after their arrival the Duke of Gloucester contemplates joining a shooting trip for a few weeks but the Prince of Wales will not be affected by this arrangement.

The Princes will travel by train from Mombasa to Nairobi and later will use cars on route to the Cape only where there are no railways.

COUNCIL AND REDUCED RATES PRIVILEGE.

A letter was recently submitted from the General Manager of the Railway to the Finance Committee of the Town Council with reference to the reduced charges now in being for the Railway subsidize quarters between Eldoret and Kisumu.

After consideration of the letter and discussion it was resolved to recommend that in view of the small amount available and in order to meet in every possible way in clearing the present area to meet for long planning money the Council should continue the present reduced rate of charges for these Railway houses for a period of three years.

THREE CASES WITHIN A FOURTEEN.

After an interval of three months since the last case, three cases of plague have occurred, while the number of cases recorded in the past two months has been ten.

On June 6 a native boy was found dead of a venereal pest near Victoria Street. Post Mortem examination suggested the cause of death to be plague. This was confirmed by the Health Officer of Nairobi.

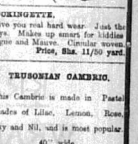

Tanganyika Crops. Church Enterprise.

OFFICIAL REPORTS FOR FIRST HALF OF MAY

Crop reports for the first half of May have been issued by the Department of Agriculture, Tanganyika Territory, as follows:

Coastal Area—North—Dawid—Cotton continues. Drying favourable conditions record crops are expected. Cotton—A drying week. Pango—No change since last report. Right inches for rain during first half of the month. Tanganyika—12 inches for first half of month. Crops may suffer if rain continues heavy.

Coastal Area—South—Budi—Weather dull with slight rain. Crops have recovered. Barley and wheat do not as crop except millet, but little below normal. Rice harvest has begun. Cotton prospects are good. Erythrina—Intensified rains still falling. Prospects optimistic. Favorably throughout the district. Lindi—Rainfall slight. Food crops doing well, with localized failures. Inland—Prospects for cotton good. Good conditions and reported to be doing well.

Coastal Area—East—Dar-es-Salaam—Rain continues. Crop in condition improved since last report. Cotton reported to have their study with occasional shower. Crop prospects remain good. Cotton flowering generally. Lindi—Crops very good. Growing to floods in certain river areas. Rice crop destroyed. Cotton crops outlook excellent. Tabora—In some areas the crops are better than anticipated. Considering the season the harvesting of grain has commenced. Uru—Harvest is almost ready. Tabora—Rain has not been adequate, but economic prospects are good. Uru—No rain for half of month. 1 inch. Kibaha—No rain has fallen in the first half of month. The groundnuts and cotton harvest is above the average. Kilimanjaro—Good rains are still falling almost every other day. Food crops looking well. Little agricultural activity. Harvesting of rice has commenced. Lake Victoria Area—Mwanza—Cotton prospects favorable throughout the province. The crop conditions are unchanged since last report. Bukoba—Thirteen inches of rain during the first half of month. The harvesting of Arabica coffee is well advanced and heavy sales of this variety. The harvesting of Hibiscus is becoming more general. 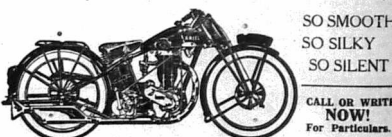

CONTROL OF ELEPHANTS IN UGANDA.

Success of Measures Introduced by Game Department.

FEWER COMPLAINTS.

As a result of vigorous control measures under taken by the Game Department there was considerable reduction in the amount of damage done by elephants in Uganda last year.

The section of the Game Warden's report dealing with this matter makes interesting reading and provides useful information on the habits of the animals.

The suggestion is put forward that there is some connection with quality and growth of ivory and the food elephants eat.

FOOD AND IVORY.

A section of the annual report of the Uganda Game Department is devoted to a review of the general position in regard to elephant control which indicates marked progress. From all control areas some smaller reports of a diminution of damage done by elephants and a falling off in the number of complaints. The large Bushoga herd once again distinguished itself by concentrating its attacks on the first section covered by the reserve boundary into May. This, an oddity many see as a small section of the herd and one, incidentally, which has not happened previously, it crossed successively the roads from Masindi to Atrop, Port, and Masindi to Atrop, and without making any attempt to enter or damage cultivation, finally coming to rest on the River Kaka. Each subsequent section of the herd which emerged during the months of May, June, and part of July, did exactly the same. 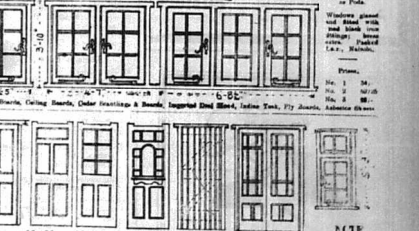

EARTH TREMORS IN THE SUBUKIA VALLEY.

Two Hundred Shocks Since January.

CROP PROSPECTS

["MOMBASA" CORRESPONDENT] Subukia June 16. For six weeks now we have had no earthquake shocks in the valley, and a great relief it is. From 31st January to 27th April we had, apart from minor tremors, some thirty-two hundred shocks of varying intensity, and some fairly substantial houses as were left standing after the disastrous experience of 5th January. Now that Mother Earth seems to have settled down again we hope that neither she nor we will be troubled in the manner again. Coming as it did on top of a poor harvest, the earthquake was, in that respect, a matter for many in this district.

Disasters of this nature in the Lower or Northern end of the Valley who would most damage from the earthquake, the poor crops of the district have this year a consolation, and a bright. The loss of 1928 of last year cannot yet be said to have broken, the rainfall for 1929 being only about a inches to date. This means is a relief, and unless better rain come very early, the crops there will be a failure.

In a shakedown of about 7,000 feet and more, however, prospects are much better, the average rainfall being 26.1 inches. About two inches fell during the first few days of March and some more showers followed. The more persistent showers which started in the first week of the month, and which in some cases the rain is already in flower. A whole month went by without another shower, and some earlier "drying" in April. May brought very heavy rain, and some earlier "drying" in April. The growth was slow, but with the warmer June days the crops are growing rapidly.

Every year we see the same scene, disconcerting. Early planted maize, sown in well tilled soil, withstands both drought and excessive rain better than later plantings, and grows a higher yield.

HIDES AND SKINS.

Re-publication of a Memorandum.

Request for Advice on How to Treat the Process.

STANDARD CORRESPONDENT.

Mombasa, June 18. The Chamber of Farmers, and the other farming and discussant interest in the hides and skins trade, the price of butter, weights and measures, and the Process to Kenya.

It also contained a very short statement by an American firm which had had Mombasa skins of the methods now in use. It appeared to have a large proportion of the skins and hides still away from Mombasa.

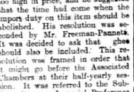

It is the fact that the hides will pay for 1/2- the fat is melted out, and the more the layers of fat on the skin, the more the best of the skin, and wherever that occurs, the subsequent application of lime causes the skin to be very sticky.

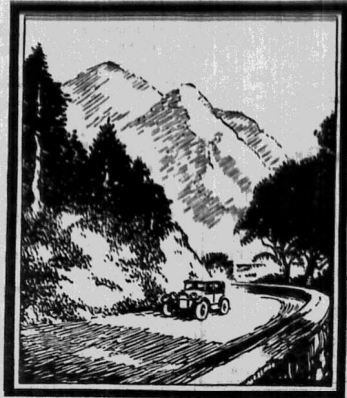

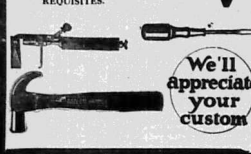
