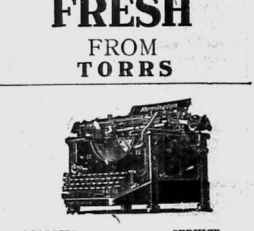

**We Hear from LONDON**

(STANDARD SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT)

We can expect a fierce General Election in May of next year—I am told by one who certainly is not to be taken for granted—our industries, nationalisation, and what the Liberals call the "Nationalisation" versus the "Form." Mr. Churchill's Budget marks another very definite step in his career. It does not deal with the problem of making the nation's income and expenditure balance for the next twelve months, but it envisages a new financial relationship for the future between the State and our big industries. Both the Labour Party and the Liberals have definite programmes on this subject. The Labour Party of course demands nationalisation for our industries in nationalisation. The Liberal policy is contained in a huge yellow-bound volume of nearly hundred pages comprising considerable proposals. Mr. Churchill challenges both Parties to make his own scheme of raising relief. I find criticism is concentrated on the postponement of the operation of his plan to October 1929. The reason given is that the machinery cannot be ready before that date, but the general opinion is well-founded and it is clear that Mr. Churchill is deliberately postponing the other Parties to fight the General Election on this issue.

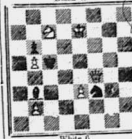

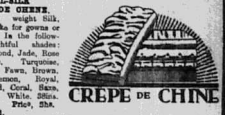

## THE GREAT PROBLEM OF SOUTH AFRICA.

### Native's Big Part in the Economic Scheme.

#### THE JUNIOR PARTNER.

#### Impossibility of Having Two Brands of Civilisation.

The absolute necessity of taking the native into the economic scheme of things in South Africa was emphasised by Dr. C. T. Loran, a member of the South African Native Affairs Commission, in a recent address.

If we can ascertain ourselves regarding the native as a junior partner," said Dr. Loran, "all will be well with South Africa, but the solution of the problem will require the idealism of youth, the wisdom and experience of age, and withal the courage to face the realities of the situation."

There was, room, he maintained, for two races, but not for two civilisations in South Africa, and the life and interests of white and black were so inextricably bound together that complete segregation was impossible and fraught with all the inexorable fatality which the native had pictured when he said that God had attempted by surrounding Africa with all the biggest oceans, to keep the black man in and the white man out, but even He had failed.

#### GREATEST POTENTIAL CONSUMER.

Dr. Loran said: "I have come here to consider with you some fundamentals of the Native Question. There has never been a time in the history of this country when the native question has been of more vital importance. General Hertzog had the rare courage and vision to put this matter in the forefront and it is now receiving more attention in Parliament and in the Press, and it has long since replaced Nationalism and the flag as topics for possible idealism. All this is to the good. Out of this saving and thinking and planning comes a whole new appreciation of one's ignorance, low faith in catch words and quick remedies generally, and a growing tolerance and broad-mindedness towards our black fellow-subjects. The time seems opportune to put before us some fundamental considerations which, if not new, may bear repeating. I repeat them as a private citizen and not in any official capacity."

#### Wild Scheme.

"Let us remind ourselves, in the first place, that the native is here in number nearly six million, that he has at least as much right to be here as we ourselves, and that he intends to remain here. One would not need to argue this did not wild scheme for getting the native out of South Africa take our thoughts away from time to time from the realities of the situation. Yesterday it was 'Put him north of the Zambesi,' today it is 'Find a place for him in South-West Africa.' What it will be tomorrow, no one knows. Mean time, our native life still grows more and more complex of us and our intentions. So suspicious does he become that when a real friend of his, like Dr. Hendon, of Lovedale, comes along with a scheme of emigration from a congested area like Victoria West to a comparatively open area in the Transvaal or Rhodesia, he is deterred. He will not believe that it was just this form of emigration that saved the congested areas of Scotland and gave the British Empire overseas some of its best citizens. The danger of the deportation scheme is that it takes our thoughts away from the

real problem of the adjustment of the six million blacks with the one and a half million whites. The sooner we realise that the black man is here and means to remain here and cannot be removed, the better for us and for him.

#### What Segregation Means.

"If deportation is impossible, let us at least have segregation," says the ordinary white man without inquiring too closely what the blessed word connotes. Territorial segregation to such a people is a wild scheme. The average native to live in a place apart, but not so far away that he cannot contact us and work for us, and not so far away that we cannot contact him to give him the earnings aimed at, is impossible.

Economic segregation apparently means keeping the native out of certain skilled and semi-skilled work but allowing him to work on the mines or on the farms at a very low wage in order that the white employer or employer may receive a larger income than he otherwise would.

Political segregation means separating the native voter in the Cape from his white co-voter, and preventing the native in the other Provinces from securing any franchise at all. Social segregation means the 'Jim Crow' on the railway, the separate entrance counter at the Post Office, and in the Transvaal and Orange Free State the impossibility of a native riding on a tramcar. Of all these forms of segregation it seems that only the last-mentioned has any possibility of permanency and that only in a much modified form.

While the white and native desire territorial segregation, they are not prepared to pay the price of setting aside all selected areas of land for native occupation, and of doing without native labour on the farms and factories. Economic segregation will break down and restrictive legislation on native employment must disappear just as surely as native wages must rise.

#### Capo Franchise.

The present agitation against any alteration of the Capto native franchise indicates that the Boerpeasants themselves are divided on the question of political segregation. The natives are opposed to any such restriction except the natural segregation which springs from conditions of life and work which they regard and who shall say they are not? It is a fact that the land or wages or political power of the native will be reduced to a valuable share. Segregation must hold, and a native on one day with his cheerful laugh "God bless Him and He. God bless the biggest ocean he had come to."

Advises to keep the native in and the white man out, and you see what has happened." I believe that it should be the basis of our native policy, but let us realise that anything like a complete segregation cannot be achieved in South Africa. It is too late. It might have been possible in South Africa 20 years ago. It may be possible in Rhodesia today, but in the Union of South Africa, the life and the interests of both white and black are so bound together that anything like complete segregation is impossible. The average white man who has a few acres of land, even though fundamental truth and not so far away that he cannot contact us and work for us, and not so far away that we cannot contact him to give him the earnings aimed at, is impossible.

#### Tribal System Doomed.

One third fundamental is that in South Africa the trial of systems of government is doomed. Both from the point of view of efficiency and of practical value, much can be said for the tribal system. Blood friends of the native who see the defects of our European forms of social structure, with its failure to combine efficiency with the sense of honour in the twentieth century and see in its application to keep the native down, desire abolition to continue. LABOUR IN UGANDA.

Efforts to Create a Voluntary Flow: the Influence of Cotton Cultivation.

Intimately connected with the Native policy is the question of labour. In Uganda there was no placed on compulsory labour, for Government requirements.

The history of the successful attempt to replace this by a voluntary labour and the inter-relationship between the workers from the distant non-productive areas and the highly developed areas is explained in this, the first of the articles on the Native Policy of Uganda.

INCEPTION OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT.

The policy of making the labour force in Uganda to increase, the local labour force did not seem to work and the second source of expert value which was now being cultivated by the Government was not adequate. Thereafter a Labour Department was set up under a Senior Commissioned Officer to study and improve the conditions of labour and the facilities for travel for those seeking work. In recent labour for Government work only, bring it to work and send it back at the end of the contract.

There has not been established yet, however, a steady and adequate labour force. When cotton was introduced into the country, the natives were not so much attracted to it as to the other crops.

The Labouring Class. Uganda, like other East African territories, has its labour 'problem' which is the result of the fact that the natives seem to employ labour to live and therefore to labouring class is largely dependent on voluntary workers. In that year a Labouring Class was established under the Government and following the publication of regulations governing the employment of labour.

It is a difficulty which has been met in other parts of the Empire. The Government has been trying to encourage the natives to work in the cotton industry. This again has been followed by the decline of cotton values and has been shown in the fact that the supply of cotton labour for railway works in the districts has not been sufficient.
