INDUSTRIAL ALCOHOL FROM WASTE SISA.

Big Claims for French Chemist's Discovery.

CHEAP AND EFFECTIVE.

Success of Experiments in Algeria and on the West Coast.

A method for extracting alcohol from waste sisa that has been discovered by a French chemist is being advertised in the technical details of the process. It is claimed that experiments on wind plantations in French Africa have demonstrated conclusively the practicability of the process as a result of which an annual yield of 400 tons of alcohol per hectare has been obtained at very little cost.

Following is the translation of an article which recently appeared in the "Petit Matin" newspaper to take up the question of the utilization of certain of our colonial plants for the production of an industrial alcohol which manufactured on the spot would cost very much less than petrol which has to be imported, and would be utilized readily for auto transport and workshop power.

It is no new idea. Already at the Matricule Experiment in the pavilion of the "Afrique Occidentale Française" similar machines have been shown actually doing the work by means of a similar type of fuel, but manufactured from the waste oil of fruit, such as banana. This was evidently a step in the right direction, but we must not lose sight here of other economic uses of the greater utility and are therefore necessarily very expensive, so that the economy said to have been effected is not very great. To obviate this heavy expense it was necessary to find a means of producing fuel with a plant that apart from this product had other value, one which grew in the French Colonial Possessions, and could easily be produced and handled.

Now this plant actually existing in the land, the utilization of which is prodigiously developed in the Congo. It produces fine strong and supple from which a number of valuable medicinal plants of the plant surrounding the fibre (the leaves) can be distilled

and provides a fuel of great power at a price remarkably cheap.

Great Difficulties.

It is an officer, an old pupil of the Polytechnic who has succeeded in solving this difficult problem. M. Fougere, (such is his name) had one a few years ago to interest him in the subject, and he has since then dreamed. There were great difficulties to be overcome. The first experiments were made under adverse conditions and did not give very satisfactory results and the inventor had to wait for the assistance to whom he applied. Nevertheless he was not discouraged and he continued his work until he had secured a preliminary report from the French Government.

OVERSEAS SETTLEMENT OF BRITISH WOMEN

Extending Scope of Work in Kenya.

COMMITTEE FORMED.

The Society for the Overseas Settlement of British Women has now entered on a new stage of its activities in Kenya. Until 1926 the work of the Society had been carried out by representatives in the three largest cities, Nairobi, Nakuru and Mombasa. In 1926 the Overseas Society's houses all listed with the V. W. C. A. and working in close harmony with that institution, newcomers to the Colony being, when necessary, housed there and given every assistance in the matter of obtaining suitable employment. In 1926 the League extended its sphere of protection to every district of the Colony by affiliation with the East African Women's League, the District Vice Presidents of the League consenting to represent the Overseas Society in their respective Districts.

The benefits of such affiliation are very obvious, since a young woman coming out to employment in Kenya can be introduced to the Society, come with an introduction to the District Vice President of the district to whom she is going, who will be prepared to inform the girl, and help her in any difficulty that might arise. Also this closer cooperation makes it possible for the Society to receive reliable information as to the desirability of employers seeking women or government through its agency, a most important factor, when it is recalled that in the most sparsely populated districts a woman or thirty miles from other European centres.

The growth of the work during the past few years has been such that it has been felt desirable to develop still further its scope in similar lines as in other parts of the world, by forming a committee. Lady Cecil C.B.E. vice chairman of the Society in London addressed the following letter to the Nairobi representative—

Outline of Policy.

My committee have been consid-

ering the situation in Kenya, and have had to study on the work of the Society for the Overseas Settlement of British Women there. First, we are anxious to widen it to cover you to our thanks and our sincere appreciation of all you have done, and we would hope the following outline of our policy for the future will meet with your approval.

We agree with you that extending its usefulness, as the work increases, we feel sure that by the most be accomplished, even if it means the sacrifice of some live, single-handed. We would like to develop the scope of our work on the same lines as we have done in other parts of the world, by forming a small Committee. We would suggest that you would be the Chairman or Hon. Secretary, whichever you think most suitable, and get the help of say three or four other people.

This Committee would be the Kenya Branch of the Society for the Overseas Settlement of British Women with its headquarters in Nairobi. The Representative to your country would be ex-officio members, so that they could attend the—say monthly—meetings of the committee, if any of them happened to be in Nairobi. They would be able to inform you and your Committee of possible openings and help you in touch with the Settlers, and those who live in the more remote places. You, and your House, would be in direct communication with the London headquarters, and the letters collected would be paid through you. It would be likely that all the members would be about the same time as you are being done when you were on leave, and could make your own arrangements for a vice Chairman. We would propose that Lady Cecil be asked to be Patroness. We have referred to this in other places as our work increased and feel sure that in a growing place like Kenya, it is the only way to keep pace with the needs of the Community.
