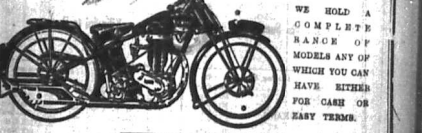

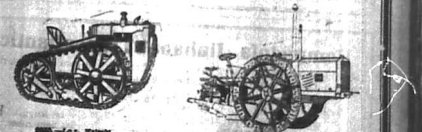

LONDON DEBATE ON KENYA NATIVE LANDS TRUST BILL.

"Good Intentions But Imperfect Machinery."

EX-CHIEF JUSTICES VIEWS.

African Representation on the Central Board.

Whilst it was admitted generally at the meeting held recently under the auspices of the Anti-Slavery and Aborigines Protection Society that the objects of the Kenya Native Lands Trust Bill are good, doubt was expressed as to the ability of the proposed machinery to carry out the good intentions.

Main criticism centred round the leasehold clauses of the Bill and in this connection the view was expressed that the Government seemed to be giving with one hand and taking away with the other.

Coffee Bean Barer.
IDENTIFICATION HINTS FROM TANANYIKA.
For the assistance of TANANYIKA coffee planters the Entomological Laboratory Department of Agriculture (Mr. A. H. Jones) has issued the following identification hints for the identification of coffee pests.
1. The coffee leaf-miner (Lissonota coffea) is a small, pale, moth-like insect with a wingspan of about 1.5 cm. It is found on the underside of coffee leaves and causes a characteristic 'S' shaped mine.
2. The coffee berry borer (Hypothenemus hampei) is a small, dark, cylindrical beetle with a length of about 2 mm. It is found in coffee berries and causes a characteristic 'shot-hole' in the berry.
3. The coffee scale (Aspidiotus perniciosus) is a small, oval, scale-like insect with a diameter of about 1 mm. It is found on the stems and leaves of coffee plants and causes a characteristic 'woolly' growth.
